OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** played their longest extra inning game since a 7-8 loss in 14 innings to Chicago-AL on Sept. 14, 2015...have won consecutive extra inning games to snap a three-game losing streak in extra innings and are now 4-3 (.571) in extra inning games this season...won their fifth walk-off game this season to improve to 5-5 (.500) in walk-off games and are now 10-9 (.526) in games decided in the last at bat...snapped their two-game losing streak, and are now 5-3 since the All-Star Break to improve to 8-10 (.444) in July...are 5-3 in their last eight home games to improve to 22-29 (.431) at home...are now 14-15 (.483) in one-run games...lead the season series with the Rays 3-2 and are now 99-63 (.611) all-time against Tampa Bay...are 5-3 on this current 10-game homestand against Toronto (2-1), Houston (2-1) and Tampa Bay (1-1).
- Sean Manaea tossed a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings...it is the longest start by an A's pitcher this season since Kendall Graveman also threw 8.0 innings on July 9 at Houston (also: Hill, May 23 at Seattle)...has thrown 15.0 consecutive scoreless innings as a starter...is 1-1 with a 2.35 ERA (8 er in 30.2 ip) in five games since he was reinstated from the 15-day DL June 29...is 3-2 with a 3.39 ERA (22 er in 58.1 ip) in 10 games at home...is 1-1 with a 2.76 ERA (10 er in 32.2 ip) in five starts on four days rest...is 0-1 with a 2.88 ERA (8 er in 25.0 ip) in four starts in July.
- Ryan Dull has a 0.69 ERA (2 er in 26.0 ip) over his last 25 games dating back to May 25.
- . Coco Crisp (1-for-5, rbi) collected his eighth career game-ending RBI, the sixth with the A's.
- Khris Davis (1-for-5, 2 so) snapped an 0-for-13 hitless streak with a single in the fourth inning.
- Ryon Healy (2-for-4, r, 2b, so, sac) has started each of the A's eight games at third base since being selected from Triple-A Nashville...is 8-for-28 (.286) over
 that span.
- Jake Smolinski (3-for-5) has started seven of the A's eight games since the All-Star Break and is 8-for-21 (.381) with three walks...collected his third three-hit game and fifth multi-hit game.

TAMPA BAY NOTES

- The **Tampa Bay Rays** had their three-game winning streak snapped and are 4-4 since the All-Star Break...fell to 19-28 (.404) on the road...dropped to 23-36 (.390) at night...fell to 5-14 (.263) in July...trail the season series with the A's 2-3 and 17-19 (.472) in Oakland since becoming the Rays in 2008...are 3-2 on this nine-game road trip to Colorado (2-1), Oakland (1-1), and Los Angeles-NL (two games).
- Jake Odorizzi tossed a season-high 8.0 innings for just the second time in his career (also: April 13, 2015 at Toronto)...has made 14 scoreless starts since the start of the 2014 season...is 1-2 with a 4.81 ERA (13 er in 24.1 ip) in four starts in July...is 3-2 with a 4.42 ERA (27 er in 55.0 ip) in 10 starts on the road...is 0-2 with a 3.97 ERA (10 er in 22.2 ip) in four career starts against Oakland.
- Tim Beckham (1-for-5, so) is batting 9-for-17 (.529) with one walk in four games since the All-Star Break.
- Corey Dickerson (1-for-4, bb, so) is 9 for his last 16 (.563) at-bats...is 18-for-47 (.383) over his last 13 games.
- Brandon Guyer (2-for-6, so) collected his 15th multi-hit game this season.
- Steve Pearce (1-for-5, so, gidp) is 4-for-14 (.286) with two runs and four RBI in three games since being reinstated from the DL on Tuesday.
