#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** won their sixth walk-off game of the season, the third in the last five games...won their second straight game to snap a two-game losing streak and are 6-3 since the All-Star Break...improved to 9-10 in July and 23-29 at home...are now 4-2 against the Rays this season and clinched the season series with one game remaining Sunday...are 51-46 against Tampa Bay dating back to 2005 after going 49-17 over the first seven years...are 55-25 in Oakland against the Rays...are 6-3 on this current 10-game homestand against Toronto (2-1), Houston (2-1) and Tampa Bay (2-1).
- Josh Reddick was a late scratch from today's lineup with back soreness.
- Kendall Graveman tossed his second career complete game (June 13, 2015 at LAA) but it was his first complete game win...allowed three earned runs in nine innings to extend his winning streak to a career-high six straight...has not been charged with a loss in his last 11 starts...improves to 6-0 with a 3.25 ERA (23 er in 63.2 ip) over his last 10 starts...the six-game winning streak is a career high (previous: 3, June 24-July 4, 2015) and matches the longest by an A's pitcher this year (Hill).
- Khris Davis (1-for-3, rbi, bb) has hit safely in back-to-back games...is hitting .286 (63-for-220) with 18 of his 23 home runs at night compared to .174 (21-for-121) during the day.
- Ryon Healy (1-for-4, hr, rbi, r) hit his first career walk-off homer and his second home run since being selected from Triple-A Nashville July 15.
- Jed Lowrie (2-for-4, r) improved his average in July to .232 (16-for-69) with his 24th multi-hit game of the seaosn.
- Jake Smolinski (2-for-4, hr, 2 rbi) extended his hitting streak to six games ... is 9-for-20 (.450) during that stretch...has started eight of the A's nine games since the All-Star Break and is 10-for-25 (.400).

- The **Tampa Bay Rays** have lost two consecutive games to snap their three-game winning streak and are now 4-5 since the All-Star Break...dropped to 19-29 on the road and 25-55 at Oakland...lost the season series against the A's at 2-4 with the final game of the series scheduled Sunday...are 3-3 on this nine-game road trip to Colorado (2-1), Oakland (1-2), and Los Angeles-NL (two games).
- Drew Smyly gave up one earned run over six innings and earned his sixth no-decision of the season...has not recorded a win since May 16 at Toronto... brought his record to 2-11 with a 5.42 ERA (67 er in 111.1 ip).
- Oswaldo Arcia (2-for-3, rbi, 2b, so) is batting .265 (13-for-49) with two homers and seven RBI in 19 games (15 starts) with the Rays.
- Corey Dickerson (1-for-4, r, 2b) extended his hitting streak to five games...is 10-for-22 (.455) on the current road trip...is batting .345 (29-for-84) over his last 24 games.
- Logan Forsythe (1-for-4, rbi) has hit safely in his last five games and is batting .333 (8-for-24) during that span.
