OAKLAND ATHLETICS (45-55) VS. TEXAS RANGERS (58-42)

TUESDAY, JULY 26, 2016 — GLOBE LIFE PARK — 7:05 P.M. CDT RHP SONNY GRAY (4-9, 5.49) VS. RHP NICK MARTINEZ (1-2, 6.45) CSNCA — A'S RADIO NETWORK (95.7 FM THE GAME)

ABOUT THE A'S: Had their three-game winning streak snapped last night and are now 7-4 since the All-Star Break, which is tied for the second best record in the American League (Los Angeles, 7-3)...are 10-11 in July... went 13-12 (.520) in April, 15-29 (.341) over a 44-game stretch from May 1 to June 19 and are 17-14 (.548) since then...are 45-55 (.450) overall, which is the fourth worst record in the American League...are in fourth place in the AL West and have been in fourth or worse every day since June 3...have spent one day in sole possession of first place, five days tied for first, four days in second, four days tied for second, 15 days in third, eight days tied for third, 36 days in fourth, 13 days tied for fourth and 23 days in fifth.

CLOSE CALLS: Each of the A's last three road losses and four of the last six have been walk-off losses...three of the A's last four home wins have been walk-off wins...the A's are 6-6 in walk-off games and the 12 walk-off games are tied with Houston, Los Angeles (NL) and Texas for the most in the majors...each of the A's last four games have been decided in the last at bat and the A's are 3-1 in those games...are 12-10 in games decided in the last at bat for the season...the wins and games (22) are tied for third most in the American League...each of the A's last four games and 10 of the last 14 have been decided by one-run...the A's are 7-3 in those 10 games and are 16-16 (.500) for the season...rank fourth in the AL in onerun games (32)...the loss last night was the A's fourth when leading after eighth innings, which is tied for the most in the AL (Seattle and Texas) . have six wins when trailing after seven innings, which is tied for third most in the AL...have won each of their last two extra inning games and are 4-3 in extra innings for the season...the Oakland record for fewest extra inning games in a non-strike season is nine in 1974 and 1975.

STARTING PITCHING: A's starting pitchers are 3-2 with a 4.65 ERA (32 er in 62.0 ip) in 11 games since the All-Star Break...are 27-41 with a 4.96 ERA (299 er in 543.0 ip) for the season...rank second in the American League in highest ERA, tied for second in most losses and third in fewest wins and home runs (73)...last Saturday, Kendall Graveman tossed the A's first complete game since Aug. 7, 2015 (Gray vs. Houston)...it snapped a streak of 148 consecutive games without a complete game, which was the second longest such streak in Athletics history (151, July 9, 2008-July 5, 2009).

PITCHING: The A's have compiled a 3.60 ERA (49 er in 122.1 ip) over the last 13 games but have a 4.64 ERA for the season, which is second highest in the American League...also have the fourth highest opponents batting average (.267) and slugging percentage (.428).

OFFENSE: The A's are batting .233 (49-for-210) with 17 runs scored over their last six games (2.8 runs per game)...have drawn two walks in each of those games, which is the A's longest streak of consecutive games with two walks or fewer since a seven-game streak from April 8-15, 2006... have 254 walks for the season, which is second fewest in the American League and third fewest in the majors...are on pace to draw 411 walks, which would break the Oakland record for fewest walks in a season (433 in 1978)...have the lowest on-base percentage in the AL (.306), the second fewest strikeouts (673) and the third lowest slugging percentage (.399).

DEFENSIVE DOINGS: The A's have gone five straight games without an error, which follows a season-high streak of seven consecutive games with an error, which followed an Athletics record streak of 15 consecutive games without an error...have 64 errors for the season, which is tied for second most in the American League...A's outfielders have 11 assists, which is second fewest in the majors (San Francisco, 10).

HOME AND AWAY: The A's are 0-1 on their first post-break road trip, an 11-day, nine-game trip to Texas (0-1), Cleveland (three games) and Los Angeles-AL (three games)...went 3-4 on the last road trip to Minnesota (1-2) and Houston (2-2) and are 21-26 (.447) on the road...started the year 7-0 on the road, went 5-20 from April 23 to June 11 and are 9-6 since then...went 7-3 on the last homestand against Toronto (2-1), Houston (2-1) and Tampa Bay (3-1) but are 24-29 (.453) at home for the season, which is the third worst home record in the American League...are batting .260 (431-for-1656) on the road compared to .243 (427-for-1757) at home... have the fourth highest road batting average in the AL and the third lowest home batting average...have a 5.32 ERA (241 er in 407.1 ip) on the road

compared to 4.06 (218 er in 483.0 ip) at home...have the second highest road ERA in the majors (Cincinnati, 5.87).

SERIES NOTES: The A's won three of four from Tampa Bay to close out the last homestand and have now won three consecutive series for the first time since 2014 when they won their first three after the All-Star Break (July 18-27)...have won the first game in 10 of the last 13 series but have lost the final game in 10 of the last 12 series...for the season, are 19-14 in the first game of a series compared to 10-22 in the final game of a series.

DESIGNATED HITTERS: A's designated hitters are batting .210 (73-for-347) with nine home runs and 36 RBI...rank last in the American League in RBI, tied for last with Texas in home runs and have the second lowest batting average (Houston, .188)...the A's DH has homered just twice over the last 50 games (Butler on Sunday, Davis on June 17).

IN THE PINCH: A's pinch hitters are 5 for their last 16 (.313) with a walk and seven RBI...are batting .227 (17-for-75) with two doubles, a triple, two home runs and 13 RBI for the season...rank second in the American League in hits, RBI and plate appearances (77) and tied for second in extra base hits (5).

LEFT AND RIGHT: After facing a left-handed starting pitcher in three straight and six of the last nine games, the A's are scheduled to face a righty in the final two games of this series and all three games of the Cleveland series...have lost 11 of their last 14 games in which the opponent starts a left-handed pitcher and have won 13 of the last 17 games when the opponent starts a right-hander...are 12-16 (.429) in games started by a lefty compared to 33-39 (.458) against righties...the mark against lefties is second worst in the American League (Seattle, 13-20).

THIS AND THAT: The A's scored all seven of their runs yesterday with two outs...have now scored 29 of their 44 runs since the All-Star Break with two outs (65.9%)...are hitting .337 (56-for-166) with runners in scoring position since June 27 and are batting .276 with RISP for the season, which ranks fourth in the American League...are 29-32 (.475) in night games compared to 16-23 (.410) during the day.

THE DISABLED LIST: The A's have used the disabled list 21 times, which marks the sixth time in the last 10 years they have used the DL 20 or more times in a season...the 21 players have combined to miss 966 games (46.0 games per stint)...currently have 12 players on the DL (Alvarez, Bassitt, Canha, Doolittle, Doubront, Fuld, Lambo, Parker, Phegley, Rodriguez, Sogard, Triggs)...today is the 22nd day the A's have had at least 12 players on the DL...prior to this year, have never had more than 11 players on the DL at one time...have had at least six players on the DL all year and at least three players on the DL every day since July 30, 2011...have not had fewer than two players on the DL since the end of the 2006 season when they had just one.

A's vs. RANGERS: The season series is even at four games each...the A's lost the first game in Texas last night after going 4-3 in two series in Oakland...will return to Arlington in three weeks and will be in Houston two weeks after that...the A's have won three of the previous four season series and are 44-40 against Texas over the last five years...are 336-347 all-time against the Texas Rangers...that breaks down to 177-167 in Oakland and 159-180 in Texas...are 92-92 at Globe Life Park...have an all-time record of 433-429 against the Rangers/Senators franchise.

TODAY'S TIDBITS

Coco Crisp is batting a Major League leading .426 with runners in scoring position... *Khris Davis* is 10-for-27 (.370) with 10 runs, five home runs and 16 RBI in eight games against Texas... *Marcus Semien* ranks second among ML shortstops in home runs (20) and fourth among AL shortstops in RBI (48).

THIS DATE IN A'S HISTORY

In 1977 Vida Blue tosses a complete game four hitter in the A's 2-1 win over California...it is the 100th complete game of his career as he becomes the first and only Oakland Athletic to reach the century mark...in 1994 Stan Javier ties an Oakland record by collecting three doubles in the A's 6-0 win at California...Steve Ontiveros, Bob Welch and Bill Taylor combine on the three-hit shutout.

FOR STARTERS: Was reinstated from the 15-day disabled list June 5 and is 1-4 with a 4.86 ERA (29 er in 53.2 ip) in nine starts since his return...was placed on the DL May 22 retroactive to May 21 with a strained right trapezius...was 3-5 with a 6.19 ERA in nine starts before going on the DL...has a 5.49 ERA for the season, which is second highest in the majors (Locke, PIT 5.54) and more than two runs higher than his previous career high (3.08 in 2014).

is tied for seventh most in the American League and is one short of his career high of 10 from 2014...has surrendered 15 home runs, which is two short of his high of 17 from last year.

LAST 14 STARTS: Is 1-8 with a 6.45 ERA (54 er in 75.1 ip) and .299 (92-for-308) opponents batting average over his last 14 starts after going 3-1 with a 2.73 ERA and .232 opponents batting average over his first four starts...had a career-high seven-game losing streak from April 27 to July 6, which was the longest by an A's pitcher since Tyson Ross had an eight-game losing streak from May 19-Sept. 24, 2012...had a 6.16 ERA and .293 opponents batting average during the streak, which spanned 12 starts from April 27 to July 6...the streak of 12 consecutive starts without a win tied for second longest by an A's starter this century (13, Braden, April 29-Sept. 29, 2007; 12, Bassitt, Aug. 9, 2015-April 28, 2016)

WILD PITCHES: Has 14 wild pitches, which are five more than any other pitcher and one short of his career high of 15 from 2014...13 came before the All-Star Break, which are most in Athletics history before the break... had three wild pitches May 20 against New York and is the first A's pitcher with three wild pitches in a game since Doug Johns on Sept. 6, 1995 at Boston...has 44 career wild pitches, which is seventh most in Oakland history (Mike Norris is 6th with 53).

NIGHT AND DAY: Is 2-8 with a 6.85 ERA (51 er in 67.0 ip) in 12 starts at night compared to 2-1 with a 2.86 ERA (11 er in 34.2 ip) in six starts during the day...is tied for second in the American League in night losses (Archer, TB 9)...over the last two years, he is 7-3 with a 2.17 ERA (23 er in 95.1 ip) in 15 starts during the day, 11-13 with a 4.28 ERA (102 er in 214.1 ip) in 34 starts at night.

BEFORE AND AFTER THE BREAK: Is 1-1 with an 8.18 ERA (10 er in 11.0 ip) in two starts since the All-Star Break after going 3-8 with a 5.16 ERA in 16 starts before the break...the eight losses were two more than his combined pre-All-Star Break total from the previous two seasons (20-6, 2.42 ERA in 37 starts)...is now 23-14 with a 3.13 ERA in 54 career appearances before the All-Star Break compared to 14-15 with a 3.59 ERA (100 er in 250.2 ip) in 40 games after the break.

OPPONENTS BATTING: Has allowed a .343 opponents on-base percentage, which is fourth highest in the American League...has the seventh highest batting average (.283) and eighth highest slugging percentage (.476)...has issued 19 of his 38 walks with two outs, which is tied for second most in the AL...has yielded a .333 (31-for-93) batting average with runners in scoring position, which is tied for third highest in the AL among pitchers that qualify for the ERA title...opponents are batting .238 (35-for-147) the first time through the lineup, .277 (39-for-141) the second time and .348 (40-for-115) after that...has surrendered 11 of his 15 home runs to right-handed hitters and has a .536 opponents slugging percentage against righties compared to .413 against lefties...10 of the 15 home runs he has allowed have been solo shots...opponents are 24-for-55 (.436) with five doubles and four home runs (.745 slugging percentage) when putting the first pitch in play.

SPOTS IN THE ORDER: Has held the opponents number seven hitter to a .130 (6-for-46) batting average, which is the lowest in the majors among pitchers that qualify for the ERA title...however, the opponents number eight hitter is batting .463 (19-for-41) and the nine hitter is hitting .447 (17-for-38), both of which are the highest marks in the majors...the five hitter is batting ..159 (7-for-44), which is eighth lowest in the American League

DAY REST: Is scheduled to start on four days rest today...is 1-7 with a 5.96 ERA (36 er in 54.1 ip) in 10 starts on four days rest compared to 3-2 with a 4.94 ERA (26 er in 47.1 ip) in eight starts on five days rest or more.

INNING BY INNING: Has a 3.23 ERA (19 er in 53.0 ip) and .215 (42-for-195) opponents batting average over the first three innings of the game compared to a 7.95 ERA (43 er in 48.2 ip) and .346 (72-for-208) opponents average from the fourth inning on.

IN JULY: Is 1-3 with a 7.04 ERA (18 er in 23.0 ip) in four starts in July... has lost more than three games in a month once in his career (4 in Aug. 2014)...has posted an ERA above 5.40 in a month twice in his career (9.61 in May 2016 and 6.84 in Sept. 2015)...had allowed just 16 runs in 77.0 career July innings entering this year (1.64 ERA)..

LAST START: He was the losing pitcher in the A's 7-3 loss to Tampa Bay last Thursday in Oakland...allowed a career-high seven runs for the fourth time this year and sixth time in his career...yielded a RBI single to Dickerson in the first and a solo home run to Beckham in the second but the A's scored three times in the bottom of the second to take a 3-2 lead...he surrendered a game-tying home run to Dickerson in the fourth and four more runs in the fifth inning on a Forsythe RBI double, RBI singles by Miller and Longoria and a sacrifice fly by Dickerson.

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTING PITCHER

LHP Sean Manaea (3-5, 4.61 ERA): Has not allowed a run in three of his four starts since he was reinstated from the disabled list June 29... is 1-1 with a 2.35 ERA and .228 opponents batting average in five games total over that span...was 2-4 with a 6.02 ERA and .282 opponents batting average in nine starts when he was placed on the 15-day DL June 14 with a left pronator strain...ranks second among American League rookies in strikeouts (66), tied for second in games started (13) and third in innings pitched (80.0)...has not walked a batter in his last three games, 20.0 innings and 79 batters faced...had a no decision in his last start, a 1-0 A's win over Tampa Bay in 13 innings last Friday in Oakland (8.0 ip, 5 h, 7 so)...has two runs of support or fewer in nine of his 13 starts...is 1-0 with a 2.45 ERA (11.0 ip, 7 h, 3 r, 3 er, 2 bb, 8 so, 1 hr) in two career starts against Texas, both this year in Oakland.

- The A's bullpen has compiled a 3.02 ERA (14 er in 41.2 ip) and .190 (29-for-153) opponents batting average since the All-Star Break...has a 4.15 ERA (160 er in 347.1 ip) for the season, which is fifth highest in the American League.
- Has tossed 347.1 innings, which is the most in the AL and third most in the majors.
- Has allowed 37-of-164 (22.6%) inherited runners to score, which is the second best percentage in the AL (Houston, 21.8%).
- Has converted 28-of-41 (68.3%) save opportunities...the 28 saves rank fifth in the AL but the 13 blown saves are tied for third most.
- Ranks second in the AL in opponents grounded into double plays (34), fourth in strikeouts (326), tied for fourth in wins (18) and fifth in opponents on-base percentage (.311)...is tied for second in wild pitches (22) and ranks fifth in most home runs (43).
- Ranks third in the AL in first batter strikeouts (78) and has the third lowest first batter slugging percentage (.336).
