OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have lost seven of their last eight games and are 10-11 since the All-Star Break...fell to 48-62 overall for the season, including a 17-25 record during day games...are now a season-high 14 games below .500...fell to 5-11 this season in interleague play, but are still 196-164 (.544) all-time in such games...dropped to 36-45 against right-handed starters this year...are 4-7 all-time against the Cubs during the regular season...are 0-2 on this 10-game homestand against Chicago-NL (0-2), Baltimore (four games) and Seattle (three games).
- Sonny Gray was charged with the loss in his first ever appearance against the Cubs after allowing two earned runs over five innings of work to bring his record to 5-11 with a 5.74 ERA (74 er in 116 ip)...left the game after five innings with right extensor muscle soreness.
- Yonder Alonso (1-for-3, 2b) is hitting .319 (15-for-47) in interleague play this season...is now batting .303 (23-for-76) over his last 25 contests.
- Khris Davis (1-for-4, so) extended his hitting streak to five games (6-for-19 during that span)...is 16-for-68 (.235) over his last 18 games but eight of the 16 hits are for extra bases (three doubles, five home runs).
- Ryon Healy (1-for-3) has hit safely in four consecutive games and is 5-for-15 (.333) during that stretch...has now started 20 of the A's 21 games since being selected from Triple-A Nashville July 15.

CHICAGO-NL NOTES

- The **Chicago Cubs** have won six consecutive games and nine of their last 10...are 16-6 in their last 22 games dating back to July 10...improved to 68-41 overall, including a 30-24 road record and 5-0 mark in August...are now 15-7 in the last 22 interleague games dating back to July 12, 2015, including a 10-4 mark this season...are 2-0 on this three-game road trip to Oakland (2-0).
- Jake Arrieta tossed eight scoreless innings to earn his first win in six starts...is now a career 1-2 in four appearances (three starts) against Oakland...improved his record to 13-5 with a 2.59 ERA (41 er in 142.1 ip).
- Dexter Fowler (1-for-5, r, so, roe) extended his hitting streak to six games and is batting .421 (8-for-19) during that stretch.
- Addison Russell (2-for-4, rbi, r, so) has hit safely in five straight games (7-for-20, .350)...recorded his 23rd multi-hit game this season.
- Ben Zobrist (2-for-5, 2 rbi) has hit safely in three straight games and recorded his 28th multi-hit game of the season.
