#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have lost three straight and eight of their last nine to fall to a season-high 15 games under .500 at 48-63 (.432)...have their worst record after 111 games since the 1997 club went 43-68...were swept for the ninth time this season...fell to 5-12 (.294) in interleague play, the second worst record in the majors, but are 196-165 (.543) all-time...are now 24-32 (.429) at home and 17-26 (.395) during the day...have lost the final game in 12 of the last 16 series and are 12-24 (.333) in the final game of a series...are 4-8 all-time against the Cubs during the regular season...are 0-3 on this 10-game homestand against Chicago-NL (0-3), Baltimore (four games) and Seattle (three games).
- A's pitchers** have allowed 24 home runs in the past 12 games...have compiled a 5.74 ERA (44 er in 69.0 ip) over the last eight games...**A's starting pitchers** are 0-6 with a 9.96 ERA (38 er in 34.1 ip) in the last eight games...**Ryan Dull** has a 1.08 ERA (4 er in 33.1 ip) over his last 33 games (since May 25).
- Sean Manaea** is 0-2 with a 2.58 ERA (11 er in 38.1 ip) over his last six games...has received two runs of support or fewer in 12 of his 16 starts...is 1-3 with a 3.12 ERA (17 er in 49.0 ip) in eight games, including seven starts, since being reinstated from the DL June 29...is 3-3 with a 3.36 ERA (24 er in 64.1 ip) in 11 games at home...is 1-2 with a 2.98 ERA (15 er in 45.1 ip) in seven starts on four days rest.
- Khris Davis** (0-for-4, so) had his five-game hitting streak snapped...was batting 6-for-19 (.316) over that span.
- Ryon Healy** (0-for-3, so) had his four-game hitting streak snapped...was 5-for-15 (.333) during that stretch.
- Marcus Semien** (2-for-3, r, hr, rbi) is a .296 (32-for-108) career hitter in the month of August...has hit safely in four straight games (5-for-15, .333).

#### CHICAGO-NL NOTES

- The **Chicago Cubs** have won seven consecutive and 10 of their last 11 games...are a season-high 28 games over .500 at 69-41 (.627), which is the best record in the majors...are 17-6 in their last 23 games dating back to July 10...swept their 10th series of the season, which tops their mark of nine sweeps from last year...improved to 31-24 (.564) on the road and 6-0 in August...are now 16-7 in their last 23 interleague games dating back to July 12, 2015, including an 11-4 mark this year...improved to 26-12 (.684) against opposing left-handed starters, 50-20 (.714) when hitting a home run, and 29-8 (.784) when hitting two homers or more...finished 3-0 on this three-game road trip to Oakland (3-0)...leave following today's game for a 10-game homestand against Los Angeles-AL (two games), St. Louis (four games), and Milwaukee (four games).
- Kyle Hendricks** has an on-going career high in wins with 11 (previous: 8, 2015)...has allowed three or fewer earned runs in each of his last 14 starts dating back to May 22 and has a 1.60 ERA (16 er in 90.0 ip) over that span...is 7-2 with a 2.03 ERA (15 er in 66.2 ip) in 10 starts during the day.
- Kris Bryant** (2-for-3, r, hr, rbi, 2 bb) set a new career-high with his 27th home run in the sixth inning...is batting .326 (43-for-132) with nine homers and 28 runs in his last 35 games since June 27.
- Dexter Fowler** (1-for-4, r, bb, 2 so) extended his hitting streak to seven games (.370, 10-for-27)...has scored a run in nine straight games, which matches the longest such streak of his career (May 27-June 4, 2016).
- Anthony Rizzo** (1-for-4, rbi) has reached base safely in 14 consecutive starts...has hit safely in 37 of his last 43 games (.323, 53-for-164).
- Jorge Soler** (2-for-4, r, hr, rbi, so) is batting .321 (18-for-56) in his last 20 games...has five RBI in three games since being reinstated from the DL on Aug. 6.
