OAKLAND NOTES

W — Neal (2-1)

• The **Oakland A's** have won two consecutive games, but are 3-8 in their last 11 games...have now won nine of their last 13 one-run games and are now 18-17 (.514) for the season...improved to 26-32 (.448) at home and 13-17 (.433) against left-handed starters...are now 33-37 (.471) when playing at night...lead the season series with the Orioles 3-2, but are still 259-260 against Baltimore since moving to Oakland in 1968...are 2-3 on this 10-game homestand against Chicago-NL (0-3), Baltimore (2-0) and Seattle (three games).

L — Miley (7-10)

- A's pitchers have allowed 26 home runs in the past 14 games...have compiled a 4.86 ERA (47 er in 87.0 ip) over the last 10 games...A's starting pitchers have won two consecutive games, but are still 2-7 with a 7.30 ERA (43 er in 53.0 ip) in the last 11 games...The A's are batting .179 (27-for-151) with 10 walks over the last five games.
- Zach Neal made his second career start, his first since May 25 of this year at Seattle (L, 3-13), and is 1-1 with a 7.71 ERA (8 er in 9.1 ip) in such games...is 2-0 with a 1.04 ERA (2 er in 17.1 ip) over his last seven games dating back to June 18...made his first career appearance against Baltimore.
- Jake Smolinski (2-for-2, r, 2 bb) is batting .366 (30-for-82) at home...is hitting .377 (23-for-61) against left-handed pitchers.
- Danny Valencia (1-for-3, 2b, rbi) snapped an 0-for-15 hitless streak with an RBI double in the third inning.
- Stephen Vogt (1-for-2, 2 bb, so) is batting .333 (6-for-18) with three RBI over his last six games.

BALTIMORE NOTES

- The **Baltimore Orioles** have lost four of their last six and nine of their last 14 games...are now 44-36 (.550) at night...fell to 24-32 (.429) on the road and 10-18 (.357) against AL West competition...are now 8-9 (.471) when playing on Tuesdays...trail 2-3 in the season series with the A's, but lead the all-time series 260-259...are 2-3 on this 10-game road trip to Chicago-AL (2-1), Oakland (0-2), and San Francisco (three games).
- Wade Miley is 0-2 with a 4.91 ERA (6 er in 11.0 ip) in two starts since being acquired from Seattle on July 31...is 1-4 with a 3.56 ERA (12 er in 30.1 ip) over his last five starts...is 4-5 with a 4.84 ERA (38 er in 70.2 ip) in 12 road starts...is 1-5 with a 5.25 ERA (28 er in 48.0 ip) in eight starts against AL West competition...is 2-1 with a 1.80 ERA (4 er in 20.0 ip) in three career starts against Oakland.
- J.J. Hardy (0-for-3, so) had his five-game hitting streak snapped...was batting .412 (7-for-17) over that span.
- Adam Jones (2-for-4, r, hr, rbi) surpassed Al Bumbry for 10th on the Orioles all-time hits list with 1,404 after his 35th multi-hit game this season (tying hit was a home run in the fourth inning)...has hit safely in each of the five games on the current road trip (11-for-22, .500).
- Hyun-Soo Kim (0-for-4, gidp) had his career-high 10-game hitting streak snapped...was batting .324 (12-for-37) over that span.
