OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have won three consecutive and four of their last seven games...have won each of the last three games by one run and have now won 10 of their last 14 one-run games...are 19-17 (.528) in one-run games for the season, which matches the A's win total in such games from last season...each of their last 16 wins have been by three runs or fewer...improved to 27-32 (.458) at home and 34-37 (.479) when playing at night...are now 38-46 (.452) against opposing right-handed starters...have won three straight against Baltimore and clinched the season series victory 4-2 with one game left tomorrow...are 260-260 against the Orioles since moving to Oakland in 1968 and are 996-940 all-time against the Orioles/Browns/Brewers...are 3-3 on this 10-game homestand against Chicago-NL (0-3), Baltimore (3-0) and Seattle (three games).
- A's pitchers** have compiled a 4.41 ERA (47 er in 96.0 ip) over the last 11 games...have allowed 10 runs in the past five games (10 er in 45.0 ip, 2.00 ERA)...**A's starting pitchers** have won three consecutive games for the first time since May 28-30...have allowed one earned run or fewer and have not issued a walk in each of the three starts...are 3-2 with a 1.72 ERA (6 er in 31.1 ip) over the last five games...**The A's** are batting .173 (31-for-179) with 13 walks over the last six games.
- Ross Detwiler** tossed a career-high tying 108 pitches in a career high eight innings (previous: 7.1, Sept. 20, 2011 at Philadelphia, W 3-0)...won his first game as a starter since May 10, 2013 against Chicago-NL...made his first Major League start since taking a 6-3 loss against Texas on May 14, 2015...made his first appearance in the majors since April 25...is 1-2 with a 3.77 ERA (13 er in 31.0 ip) in eight career appearances, including five starts, against Baltimore.
- Yonder Alonso** (2-for-3, 2b, rbi, bb) is 12-for-32 (.375) with five doubles, four RBI and five multiple hit games over his last 10 games.
- Danny Valencia** (1-for-3) is batting .239 (17-for-71) since the All-Star Break.
- Marcus Semien** (1-for-4, r, 2b, 2 so) is 11-for-40 (.275) over his last 11 contests.

BALTIMORE NOTES

- The **Baltimore Orioles** have lost three straight, five of their last seven, and 10 of their last 15 games...are now 44-37 (.543) at night...fell to 24-33 (.421) on the road and 10-19 (.345) against AL West competition...dropped to 11-7 (.611) when playing on Wednesdays...have lost the season series with the A's 2-4 with one game left tomorrow...are tied in the all-time series with Oakland 260-260...are 2-4 on this 10-game road trip to Chicago-AL (2-1), Oakland (0-3), and San Francisco (three games).
- Yovani Gallardo** is 1-3 with a 4.20 ERA (14 er in 30.0 ip) over his last five starts...is 2-4 with a 6.14 ERA (35 er in 51.1 ip) in 10 road starts...is 2-3 with a 4.75 ERA (28 er in 53.0 ip) in 10 starts at night...is 0-1 with a 3.71 ERA (7 er in 17.0 ip) in three starts against AL West competition this season...is 4-9 with a 4.60 ERA (53 er in 103.2 ip) in 19 career outings against AL West competition...is 0-5 with a 5.29 ERA (20 er in 34.0 ip) in six career starts against Oakland.
- Chris Davis** (2-for-4) recorded his 23rd multi-hit game this season.
- J.J. Hardy** (1-for-4, 2b) is batting .330 (37-for-112) with eight doubles over his last 32 games (since July 2).
- Adam Jones** (1-for-4, so) has hit safely in each of the six games on the current road trip (12-for-26, .462).
- Jonathan Schoop** (1-for-4) is batting .286 (10-for-35) over his last 10 games.
