



# BALTIMORE ORIOLES GAME NOTES

Baltimore Orioles (63-49) at Oakland Athletics (50-63)

RHP Yovani Gallardo (4-3, 5.47) vs. LHP Ross Detwiler (0-0, 5.79)



**BEASTS OF THE EAST:** The Orioles own a record of 63-49 (.563) and are in a virtual tie for first place of the American League East division with the Toronto Blue Jays (64-50, .561)...According to STATS, LLC., the Orioles have spent 109 days (of 129 days) in first place (or tied) of the AL East this season...The Orioles lead AL East clubs with a 26-19 (.578) record in games within the division.

**HIT PARADE:** **OF Adam Jones** went 2-for-4 with a home run in Tuesday's 2-1 loss at Oakland...Jones surpassed **OF Al Bumbry** for sole possession of 10<sup>th</sup> place on the Orioles all-time hit list with 1,404 hits as an Oriole.

**ZACH ATTACK:** **LHP Zach Britton** recorded his 34<sup>th</sup> consecutive save to begin the season on Friday, going 34-for-34...According to STATS, LLC., Britton has the longest save streak in as many chances to start a season by a left-handed pitcher in Major League history and he ranks seventh all-time...Britton leads the AL and is tied for second in the majors in saves and his 0.58 ERA (3 ER/46.2 IP) leads Major League relievers...He ranks third on the O's all-time saves list with 107 and is one of two left-handers in O's history with at least 100 career saves (also Tippy Martinez)...Britton is the active Major League leader with 36 consecutive saves, dating to October 1, 2015.

**EASY AS ONE, TWO, THREE:** **3B Manny Machado** went 3-for-6 on Sunday with three home runs and seven RBI in the 10-2 win at Chicago...His three home runs came in each of the first three innings of the game...According to STATS, LLC., Machado is one of nine players in Major League history to homer in three consecutive innings in a game and the first since Kevin Mench did so for the Texas Rangers on June 30, 2005 vs. Los Angeles (AL)...He is also one of two players in Major League history to hit a home run in each of the first three innings of a game joining Carl Reynolds, who did so for the Chicago White Sox on July 2, 1930 at New York (AL).

**WINDY CITY WIN:** **RHP Dylan Bundy** set a career high with nine strikeouts on Sunday at Chicago...He improved to 3-2 with a 3.00 ERA (9 ER/27.0 IP) and 33 strikeouts in five starts this season...**RHP Ubaldo Jiménez** tossed 3.0 perfect innings of relief and recorded his first career save.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** The Orioles are currently on a 10-day, 10-game road trip with stops at Chicago (2-1), Oakland (0-2), and San Francisco (three games)...Beginning on Friday, August 5, the Orioles began a stretch in which they will play 15 of 23 games on the road...Following this current road trip, the Orioles will return home for games against Boston (two games), Houston (four games), and Washington (two games) before hitting the road for games at Washington (two games) and New York (three games).

**VS. OAKLAND:** The Orioles and Athletics play the sixth game of seven matchups between the two clubs this season...The A's lead the season series, 3-2...The Orioles won the season series in 2015, 6-1, including a four-game series sweep at Oriole Park...The Athletics visited Baltimore, May 7-8...Baltimore leads Oakland in the all-time series, 260-259, with the Orioles trailing 128-129 at home and leading 132-130 at Oakland.

**PITCH PERFECT:** Orioles relievers lead the American League and rank second in the majors with a 3.07 ERA (129 ER/378.1 IP)...The Orioles bullpen ranks second in the majors with 26 wins while their record of 26-9 (.743) leads the majors...The Orioles 40 saves are tied to lead the AL and are tied to lead the majors.

**HOMER'S ODYSSEY:** The Orioles lead the majors with 170 home runs...**OF Mark Trumbo** is tied for the Major League lead with 31 homers...**3B Manny Machado** ranks eighth in the American League with 26 home runs.

**HOMER HAPPY:** Since the beginning of the 2012 season, four current Orioles rank among Major League leaders in home runs...**1B Chris Davis** (182) is tied for the Major League lead, while **OF Adam Jones** (143) ranks ninth, **OF Mark Trumbo** (133) is tied for 12<sup>th</sup> and **INF/DH Pedro Álvarez** ranks 16<sup>th</sup> with 129.

**HOME COOKIN':** The Orioles lead the majors with 39 wins at home this season...At 39-17 (.696), the Orioles own the best home record in the majors...The Orioles have hit 89 home runs at home this season to lead the majors...The Orioles rank sixth in the American League and eighth in the majors with a .272 average at home.

**BETTER LATE THAN NEVER:** The Orioles have scored 171 runs this season in the seventh inning or later to rank third in the American League and sixth in the majors...The Orioles' 52 home runs in the seventh inning or later lead the AL and rank second in the majors.

**FOUR-PLUS SEASONS:** Since the beginning of the 2012 season, the Orioles lead all American League clubs and rank fourth in Major League Baseball with 418 wins, finishing with a .500 or better record in each of the last four seasons...In that span, Orioles hitters lead the majors with 1,024 home runs, 72 more than the Toronto Blue Jays (2<sup>nd</sup>, 952)...The Orioles have also committed the fewest number of errors (379) since 2012.

**THIS DATE IN ORIOLES HISTORY:** On this date in 1963, **1B Boog Powell** became the first Oriole to hit three home runs in one game, with three solo blasts against the Washington Senators at D.C. Stadium in a 6-5 loss.

**DISABLED LIST:** Three Orioles are currently on the disabled list...**LHP T.J. McFarland** (left knee inflammation, retroactive to June 29) was placed on the 15-day DL on June 30...**LHP Brian Duensing** (left elbow inflammation, retroactive to June 20) was transferred to the 60-day DL on July 3...**OF Joey Rickard** (right thumb ligament injury, retroactive to July 21) was placed on the 15-day disabled list on July 22.

**THE SKIPPER:** Three-time Manager of the Year (1994, 2004, 2014), **Buck Showalter** is currently in his seventh season as Orioles manager...He has managed the Yankees (1992-95), D-backs (1998-2000), Rangers (2003-06) and Orioles (August 2010-current)...Showalter's 1,403 career victories rank 28<sup>th</sup> all-time...His 521 wins as Orioles manager are second-most in club history (ahead of **Paul Richards**, 517) and he ranks behind **Earl Weaver** (1,480)...Showalter ranks fourth among active managers behind Bruce Bochy, Dusty Baker, and Mike Scioscia.

**RBI WORLD SERIES:** The Baltimore RBI team concluded their run at the RBI World Series in Cincinnati with a loss in the Junior Division semifinals to Atlanta Metro RBI 10-0 on Sunday, August 7...Earlier that day, Baltimore upset the number one seed Nobu Yamuchi RBI from Hilo, Hawaii, with a 1-0 win to advance to the semifinals...Pitcher Dustin Morris retired 13 of the 16 batters he faced with four strike outs and a walk, recording a shutout in that game...The Baltimore RBI team won their Junior Division (ages 13-15) Mid-Atlantic Regional Championship to clinch a berth to the 2016 Reviving Baseball in Inner Cities (RBI) World Series in Cincinnati...This is the first RBI World Series appearance for the Baltimore RBI program in the tournament's 24-year history.

# TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: #49 YOVANI GALLARDO

**Height:** 6-2      **Weight:** 205      **Bats:** Right      **Throws:** Right



**Age:** 30  
**Born:** February 27, 1986 in Penjamillo, Michoacan, Mexico  
**Resides:** Fort Worth, TX  
**Acquisition Date:** February 25, 2016

**How Acquired:** Signed by the O's as a free agent to a two-year contract with club option for 2018

**QUICK HITS:** Made his 250<sup>th</sup> career start on June 24, against Tampa Bay (one of 24 active pitchers to accomplish the feat)...With his win on June 29, at San Diego, he surpassed RHP Ismael Valdez for sole possession of third place on the all-time wins list among Mexican-born pitchers (currently has 106 career victories)...Posted seven consecutive seasons (2009-15) with at least 30 starts (one of eight pitchers to do so in that span)...Since 2009, he ranks tied for eighth among active pitchers in games started (237), tied for 14<sup>th</sup> in victories (97), and 13<sup>th</sup> in innings pitched (1411.2)...Was one of six pitchers to log at least 180.0 innings each season from 2009-15.

**DL STINT:** Placed on the 15-day disabled list on April 23 with right shoulder bicep tendinitis...Made three starts on a Major League rehab assignment (one with Class A-Advanced Frederick and two with Triple-A Norfolk)...His last rehab outing came on June 13 with the Tides at Charlotte (ND, 5.0 IP, 1 H, 1 ER, 2 BB, 5 K, 1 HR).

**LAST START:** He earned the win on August 5 at Chicago-AL (6.0 IP, 7 H, 2 ER, 1 BB, 3 K, 1 HR)...It was his third Quality Start of the season (and second over his last three outings)...He surrendered a solo home run to José Abreu in the bottom of the fourth inning.

**CAREER VS. OAKLAND:** Gallardo has gone 0-4 and posted a 6.11 ERA (19 ER/28.0 IP) in five career starts vs. Oakland...He is 0-1 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER/11.0 IP) in two career starts at the Oakland Coliseum...Last pitched at Oakland on June 10, 2015 as a member of Texas (ND, 7.0 IP, 5 H, 2 ER, 1 BB, 10 K).

**AGAINST THE AL WEST:** He is 0-0 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER/11.0 IP) in two starts against the AL West this season...Over his career, Gallardo has gone 4-8 with a 4.79 ERA (52 ER/97.2 IP) in 18 career outings (five Quality Starts) against the AL West...Last faced an AL West club on July 9 vs. Los Angeles-AL at Oriole Park (ND, 5.0 IP, 6 H, 2 ER, 4 BB, 2 K).

**SUMMER WINS:** Gallardo has gone 24-11 with a 3.92 ERA (110 ER/252.1 IP) in 42 career starts in August...His 24 career victories in August are the most wins he has accumulated in any month (and it's the only month in which he has least 20 career wins).

**TROUBLE IN THE FIRST:** He has posted a 7.71 ERA (12 ER/14.0 IP) in the first inning of his 14 starts this season, surrendering 20 hits (including two home runs) and 13 walks.

**MAKING MEXICO PROUD:** Is one of four Mexican-born pitchers in Major League history to record more than 100 career victories (currently ranks third on the all-time list with 106 wins behind **Fernando Valenzuela**, 173; and **Esteban Loaiza**, 126)...Ranks second on the Major League all-time strikeouts list among Mexican-born pitchers with 1,398...Became the fourth Mexican-born pitcher to log at least 1,500.0 innings in his Major League career.

**AT ORIOLE PARK:** In six career starts at Oriole Park (one as a member of Texas in 2015), he is 2-0 with a 2.73 ERA (10 ER/33.0 IP)...The Orioles are 5-0 in Gallardo's home outings this season...In his career, he has gone 56-38 with a 3.63 ERA (317 ER/786.0 IP) and 71 Quality Starts in 130 home games (129 starts).

**ON THE ROAD:** He is 2-3 with a 6.75 ERA (34 ER/45.1 IP) in nine road starts (two Quality Starts) this season...In 2015, he went 5-5 with a 3.31 ERA (34 ER/92.1 IP) in 17 road starts...In his career, he has gone 50-40 with a 3.86 ERA (326 ER/760.0 IP) and 78 Quality Starts in 131 road games (129 starts).

**DOMINATE IN THE DAYTIME:** Since the beginning of the 2014 season, he has gone 11-6 with a 3.16 ERA (47 ER/134.0 IP) and 10 Quality Starts in 23 daytime outings...In eight daytime starts last season, he went 4-3 with a 2.36 ERA (12 ER/45.2 IP)...This season, he is 2-1 with a 6.04 ERA (17 ER/25.1 IP) and 21 strikeouts in five day outings (Orioles are 4-1 in those contests).

**QUALITY STRETCH:** In eight outings from May 24-July 2, 2015, he posted seven Quality Starts and went 4-0 with a 0.88 ERA (5 ER/51.1 IP) over that stretch...He did not surrender a run over four consecutive starts (26.1 IP) from June 15-July 2, 2015.

**TALE OF TWO HALVES:** Went 3-1 with a 5.82 ERA (28 ER/43.1 IP) in nine starts prior to the All-Star break this season...Following the All-Star break, he has gone 1-2 with a 4.97 ERA (16 ER/29.0 IP) in five starts...In his 148 career games (146 starts) prior to the All-Star break, he has gone 56-45 with a 3.56 ERA (349 ER/881.1 IP)...After the All-Star break, he has gone 50-33 with a 3.98 ERA (294 ER/664.2 IP) in 113 career games (112 starts).

**RUN SUPPORT:** He has received 40 runs of support in 14 starts this season (4.98 run support average)...Among qualifying AL starting pitchers in 2015, he had the 15<sup>th</sup>-lowest RSA (4.05).

**KEEPING IT IN PLAY:** He has surrendered 10 home runs (1.24 HR per 9.0 IP) in 14 starts (72.1 IP) this season...In 2015, he ranked eighth among qualifying AL starters in home runs allowed per 9.0 innings (0.73)...Gallardo surrendered 15 home runs over 33 starts (184.1 IP) last season.

**DOUBLE-DIGIT K'S:** He has recorded 10 or more strikeouts in 20 career starts, most recently on June 10, 2015 at Oakland as a member of Texas (10 K).

**2015 HIGHLIGHTS:** First season with Texas after being acquired via trade on January 19, 2015 from the Brewers...Finished second on the Rangers in wins (13) and innings (184.1), and tied for first in games started (33)...Among qualifying American League starting pitchers, ranked 14<sup>th</sup> in pitching WAR (2.8), according to STATS, LLC...Recorded a career-best 3.42 ERA (70 ER/184.1 IP), which ranked 11<sup>th</sup> among qualifying AL starting pitchers...Among qualifying AL starting pitchers last season, Gallardo ranked 12<sup>th</sup> in ground ball percentage (50.8) and induced the seventh-most ground balls (303).
