OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** had their three-game winning streak snapped but took their 16th series of the season...have not won more than three in a row since a five-game winning streak from May 28-June1...have not swept a four-game series since 2014 against Toronto...are now 4-6 in August and 13-13 since the All-Star Break...fell to 51-64 overall, including a 17-27 record during day games...are now 38-47 against right-handed starting pitchers...despite the loss, clinched the season series against Baltimore at 4-3...are now 9-9-2 in home series for the season...are 260-261 against the Orioles since moving to Oakland in 1968...are 3-4 on this 10-game homestand against Chicago-NL (0-3), Baltimore (3-1) and Seattle (three games).
- A's starting pitching has used eight different starters in the last eight games...it marks the first time in Oakland history the A's have used eight different starters over an eight-game span in one season.
- Andrew Triggs gave up three earned runs over four innings and was charged with the loss in his second start of the season and career, bringing his record to 0-1 with a 5.50 ERA (23 er in 37.2 ip) in 20 appearances.
- Billy Butler (2-for-4, rbi, r, so) is batting .331 (41-for-124) over his last 45 games after hitting .200 over his first 29 contests
- Ryon Healy (1-for-4, hr, 2 rbi, r) hit his fourth career homer since being selected from Triple-A Nashville July 15...has started 24 of the A's 25 games at third.
- Marcus Semien (2-for-5, so) has hit safely in three straight games and is 8-for-26 (.308) on the current homestand.
- Stephen Vogt (0-for-3, bb, 2 so) had his three-game hitting streak snapped...is 8-for-50 (.160) over his last 14 games.

BALTIMORE NOTES

- The **Baltimore Orioles** snapped a three-game losing streak and are 5-5 over their last 10 games...improved to 64-50 overall, including a 25-33 road record... are now 20-13 during day games and a 47-36 record versus right-handed starting pitchers...lost the season series to the A's, 4-3, despite Thursday's win to close out the four-game series...own the all-time series lead versus Oakland at 261-260...are 3-4 on this 10-game road trip to Chicago-AL (2-1), Oakland (1-3), and San Francisco (three games).
- Chris Tillman allowed two earned runs over seven innings to record his team-leading 15th win of the season...snapped a three-game winless streak heading into today's start and improved his record to 15-4 with a 3.46 ERA (58 er in 151 ip)...became the 14th Orioles pitcher (since 1954) to surpass the 1,000 career innings pitched milestone...is now a career 4-0 with a 2.58 ERA (13 er in 45.1 ip) against the A's in seven starts.
- Pedro Alvarez (2-for-4, 3 rbi, 2b, so) snapped an 0-for-9 hitless stretch with his fourth-inning double...is batting .292 (42-for-144) over his last 41 games.
- · Adam Jones (2-for-5, hr, rbi, 2 r, so) extended his hitting streak to seven (14-for-31, .452 during that stretch)...recorded his 36th multi-hit game of the year
- Mark Trumbo (2-for-4, GS, 5 rbi, 2 r, 2 so) snapped an 0-for-13 slump heading into the game with his RBI single in the fourth inning...hit his third career grand slam in the fifth inning...hit his last grand slam on Sept. 15, 2014 versus San Francisco during his stint with Arizona...has a team-high 82 RBI this season.
