#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have won four of their last five games and are 14-13 since the All-Star Break...improved to 52-64 (.448) on the season, including a 28-33 (.459) mark at home and 35-37 (.486) at night...are now 39-47 (.453) against opposing right-handed starters and 5-6 (.455) in August...improved to 21-17 (.553) in the first game of a series and 22-24 (.478) against AL West competition...snapped a seven-game home losing streak against Seattle to tie the season series at 5-5 with the Mariners...are now 332-263 all-time against Seattle, including a 180-117 mark in Oakland...are 4-4 on this 10-game homestand against Chicago-NL (0-3), Baltimore (3-1) and Seattle (1-0).
- The **A's** have scored 12 runs over the past two games after scoring nine runs over the previous six games...**A's pitchers** have surrendered at least one home run in 16 of the last 18 games (29 home runs total)...**A's starting pitchers** are 4-3 with a 2.61 ERA (12 er in 41.1 ip) over the last seven games.
- Sean Manaea** is 2-3 with a 3.27 ERA (20 er in 55.0 ip) in nine games, including eight starts, since he was reinstated from the DL June 29...is 1-2 with a 2.84 ERA (14 er in 44.1 ip) over his last seven games...is 4-3 with a 3.45 ERA (27 er in 70.1 ip) in 12 games at home...is 2-2 with a 3.16 ERA (18 er in 51.1 ip) in eight starts on four days rest...is 1-0 with a 5.73 ERA (7 er in 11.0 ip) in two career appearances against Seattle...walked the first batter in each of his first three innings.
- Khris Davis** (2-for-4, 2 r, hr, 2 rbi, gidp) hit his 28th home run of the year in the first inning, which is a new career-high (previous: 27, 2015)...is batting .288 (75-for-260) with 23 of his 28 home runs at night...the 23 home runs are the most by an Athletic at night over the last 10 years...recorded his 29th multi-hit game.
- Marcus Semien** (4-for-4, 2 r) recorded his third career four-hit game (last: April 20, 2014 at Texas)...extended his hitting streak to four games (8-for-17, .471)...is batting .400 (12-for-30) in eight games on the current homestand...recorded his 22nd multi-hit game of the season.
- Stephen Vogt** (2-for-4, 2 r, 2b, rbi, so) is batting .320 (8-for-25) over his last eight games...recorded his 25th multi-hit game of the year.

#### SEATTLE NOTES

- The **Seattle Mariners** had their season-high six game winning streak snapped, but are still 14-8 in their last 22 games...are now 40-36 (.526) at night...fell to 27-29 (.482) on the road and 19-25 (.432) against AL West competition...dropped to 20-18 (.526) in the first game of a series and are 11-8 (.579) when playing on Fridays...are tied in the season series 5-5 with the A's, but are still 22-12 against Oakland since 2013...had their seven-game winning streak in Oakland snapped, which was one short of a franchise high (8, July 6, 2007-April 17, 2008)...are 0-1 on this seven-game road trip to Oakland (0-1) and Los Angeles-AL (four games).
- The **Mariners** have had each of their last 13 games decided by three runs or fewer (9-4 in those 13 games).
- Joe Wieland** took the loss in his 2016 debut and his 10th career start...is 1-6 with a 6.32 ERA (37 er in 52.2 ip) in 12 career appearances, including 10 starts...is 0-3 with a 9.93 ERA (25 er in 22.2 ip) in six games, including five starts, on the road...made his first career appearance against Oakland.
- Ketel Marte** (1-for-3, r, so, gidp) snapped an 0-for-11 hitless streak with a single in the sixth inning.
- Shawn O'Malley** (2-for-3, r, 3b, rbi, bb, so) hit his second triple of the season and his career (also: June 7 vs. Cleveland)...recorded his eighth multi-hit game.
- Kyle Seager** (1-for-3, r, hr, rbi, so, gidp) broke up a no-hit bid with two outs in the fifth inning with a home run to right field...has hit safely in each of his last six games (10-for-23, .435)...recorded his 36th two-out RBI of the season.
