- **STREAKING** – OF **Dan Robertson** has hit safely in 17 of his last 21 games with 10 multi-hit contests, batting .345 (29x84) with 13 runs scored, 6 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs, 15 RBI, 3 stolen bases, 6 walks and 3 sacrifice flies.
- **WELCOME TO TACOMA** – OF **James Ramsey** has reach base safely in 4 straight games, batting .538 (7x13) with 4 runs scored, 1 double, 1 home run, 5 RBI and 2 walks.
- **MULTI-HIT MADNESS** – INF **Mike Freeman** has hit safely in each of his first 6 games with Tacoma, including 5 multi-hit contests, batting .440 (11x25) with 7 runs scored, 3 doubles, 1 home run 5 RBI and 4 walks.
- **HE JUST HITS** – OF **Stefen Romero** has hit safely in 68 of 92 games this season, batting .309 (112x362) with 62 runs scored, 21 doubles, 5 triples, 18 home runs, 78 RBI, 3 HBP, 32 walks and 1 stolen base.
- **ON A ROLL** – INF **Tyler Smith** has hit safely in 7 of his last 10 games, batting .395 (15x38) with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, 1 home run, 7 RBI and 1 stolen base.
- **TURNING ON THE HEAT** – INF **Zach Shank** has hit safely in 9 of his last 11 games, batting .350 (14x40) with 8 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 triples, 2 RBI and 5 walks...overall he is batting .325 (63x194) with 33 runs scored, 12 doubles, 2 triples, 3 home runs, 17 RBI, 2 HBP, 19 walks and 1 stolen base in 57 games over 2 stints with Tacoma.
- **ON A ROLL** – Dating back to June 17, RH **Joe Wieland** is 7-1 with a 3.00 ERA (19 ER, 57.0 IP) in last 10 games/9 starts...during this stretch he has limited opponents to a .257 (56x218) average, while walking 14 and striking out 50.

RECAP: The Generals scored 2 runs in the bottom of the 9th inning to tie the game 3-3, but allowed 1 run in the top of the 11th inning as Jackson fell to Biloxi 3-4 on Thursday night. RF **Tyler O'Neill** (3x5, 2B, 2 RBI, BB) led the team with 3 hit, while SS **Benji Gonzalez** (2x5, R, BB) and CF **Ian Miller** (2x4, R, 2B, RBI) each collected 2 of the Generals 10 hits. Starter **Tyler Herb** (6.0,5,2,2,3,5) allowed 2 runs on 5 hits over 6.0 innings, but did not factor into the decision. RH **Aaron Brooks** (1.2,4,0,0,1,3), RH **Dan Altavilla** (2.1,1,1,1,1,4) and RH **Ryne Harper** (1.0,3,1,1,0,1) combined to allow 2 runs and strike out 8 over 5.0 innings in relief. Harper picked up his 3rd loss of the season after allowing a run in the top of the 11th inning.

SOUTHERN LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE WEEK: LHP **Ryan Yarbrough** was named the Southern League Pitcher of the Week, Aug. 1-7. In his only start during the week, he allowed only 1 hits, walked 1 and struck out 6 over 6.0 scoreless innings to earn his 11th win of the season. Yarbrough's 11 wins also tie him with Joey Nation (2000), Nate Teut (2000), and Renyel Pinto (2004) for the third most wins in franchise history. Brian McNichol (1998) is second with 12 wins and Ricky Nolasco (2005) is first with 14. This marks his 2nd POW Award this season, also receiving the honor on May 23-29.

OF NOTE:

- **IMPRESSIVE STRETCH** – C **Marcus Littlewood** has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 games, batting .356 (16x45) with 12 runs scored, 6 doubles, 8 RBI and 11 walks.
- **GETTING IN GOING** – OF **Ian Miller** has reached base safely in 13 straight games, including at least 1 hit in 12 games, batting .413 (19x46) with 7 runs scored, 4 doubles, 8 RBI, 3 HBP, 4 walks and 9 stolen bases.
- **HEATING UP** – INF **Tim Lopes** has hit safely in 13 of his last 15 games, batting .417 (25x60) with 13 runs scored, 3 doubles, 11 RBI, 1 HBP, 10 walks and 3 stolen bases...Lopes has hit safely in 7 straight games, Aug. 4-current, batting .483 (14x29) with 6 runs scored, 1 double, 5 RBI, 6 walks and 1 stolen base.
- **IT'S GETTING HOT IN HERE** – OF **Tyler O'Neill** has reached base safely in 97 of 107 games this season, including hits in 88 games (29 multi-hit contests)...overall this season he is batting .305 (124x406) with 57 runs scored, 24 doubles, 4 triples, 20 home runs, 86 RBI, 54 BB, 7 HBP and 9 stolen bases.
 - **TRIPLE CROWN** – **O'Neill** currently leads the Southern League in 3 of the Triple Crown category, leading the league in batting average (.305) and RBI (86)...trails by only 1 home run by Daniel Palka (21), who has been promoted to AAA...the only other Triple Crown winner was Mike Reinbach of the 1972 Asheville Orioles: .346 average, 30 HR, 109 RBI...O'Neill's 86 RBI are the third most in franchise history. Alex Liddi is second with 92 in 2010 while Julio Zuleta is 1st with 97.
- **LET'S GO STREAKING** – In first 12 relief appearance over 2 stints with Jackson, RH **Kyle Schepel** tossed 18.0 scoreless innings in relief from May 12-July 22...overall he is 1-0 with a 1.03 ERA (3 ER, 26.1 IP) in 17 games...he has limited opponents to a .176 (16x91) with 14 walks and 27 strikeouts.
- **STREAKING** – RH **Andrew Moore** is 4-1 with a 2.35 ERA (10 ER, 38.1 IP) over his last 6 starts...during this stretch, dating back to July 11, he has limited opponents to a .250 (34x136) average, while walking 5 and striking out 27.
- **HEATING UP IN JULY** – LH **Ryan Yarbrough** is 4-1 with a 2.18 ERA (8 ER, 33.0 IP) over his last 7 starts, dating back to July 8...during this streak has limited opponents to a .178 (21x118) average, while walking 7 and striking out 22.
- **BULLPEN BULLY** – Over his last 32 relief appearances, RH **Dan Altavilla** is 6-2 with 12 saves and a 1.09 ERA (5 ER, 41.1 IP)...during this stretch, dating back to May 6, he has limited opponents to a .187 (28x150) average, while walking 13 and striking out 55.
 - **SCORELESS INNINGS** – From July 3-Aug 12, **Altavilla** has tossed 18.0 scoreless innings over 14 relief appearances.

RECAP: The Blaze were limited to only 3 hits as Bakersfield fell to Visalia 0-4 on Thursday night. SS **Drew Jackson** (1x4), 1B **Kyle Petty** (1x3) and CF **Austin Wilson** (1x3) each collected 1 of the team's 3 hits. Starter **Osmer Morales** (5.0,3,1,1,2,9,WP) recorded the loss, allowing 1 run on 3 hits, while walking 2 and striking out 9 in 5.0 innings. RH **Vinny Nittoli** (2.0,4,1,0,0,1) and RH **Ramon Morla** (1.0,2,2,2,1,2,2WP,HB) combined to allow 3 runs (2 ER) on 6 hits over 3.0 innings.

CALIFORNIA LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE MONTH: RHP **Zack Littell** was named California League Pitcher of the Month for July. In 5 starts with the Blaze in July, Littell went 4-0 with a 0.84 ERA (3 ER, 32.0). He limited opponents to a .184 (21x114) average, while walking 3 and striking out 25. He recorded 5 quality starts, including tossing a season-high tying 8.0 innings on July 26 at San Jose (8.0,5,0,0,0,6). Littell did not allow a run in 4 of his 5 starts in July, including tossing 20.0 scoreless innings over 3 starts, July 16-27. Littell began the season with Single A Clinton making 16 starts before being promoted to Bakersfield on July 4. Overall in 16 starts with the LumberKings, Littell went 5-5 with a 2.76 ERA (30 ER, 97.2 IP). He limited opponents to a .258 (94x365) average, while walking 21 and striking out 95. Littell was the Mariners 11th round selection in the 2013 MLB First-Year Player draft out of Eastern Alamance (NC) High School.

OF NOTE:

- **HITS, HITS AND MORE HITS** – C **Tyler Marlette** has hit safely in 26 of his last 34 games with 13 multi-hit contests, batting .351 (46x131) with 22 runs scored, 11 doubles, 6 home runs, 26 RBI, 13 walks, 1 HBP and 4 stolen base.
 - **HOMER HAPPY** – **Marlette** recorded 4 of his 5 multi-homer games in his career in 2016: May 18 at High Desert (2x5, 2 R, 2 HR, 6 RBI), May 23 at Lake Elsinore (2x4, 2 R, 2 HR, 3 RBI), June 3 at Stockton (3x5, 2 R, 2B, 2 HR, 3 RBI) and July 15 vs. Modesto (2x3, 2 R, 2 HR, 5 RBI)...prior to this season had only recorded 1 other multi-HR game on April 12 vs. Rancho Cucamonga (2x3, 3 R, 2 HR, 3 RBI, HBP).
 - **POW** – **Marlette** was named California League Player of the Week, July 4-10. Marlette hit safely in all 7 games he appeared during the week, including 6 multi-hit contests (.607/17x28, 8 R, 6 2B, 8 RBI, 2 BB, SB).
- **BULLPEN BULLY** – LH **Joe Pistorese** recorded the win in his Bakersfield debut on Aug. 10 at Visalia, allowing 1 hit and striking out 6 over 2.0 scoreless innings...in 14 relief appearances combined between Clinton and Bakersfield, he is 2-0 with 1 save and a 0.40 ERA (1 ER, 22.1 IP), including not allowing over his last 19.1 innings in relief (7/1-current)...overall he has limited opponents to a .145 (11x76) average, while walking 2 and striking out 33.
- **IN A GROOVE** – After allowing 11 runs (10 ER) over his first 7.2 innings to begin the season, RH **Thyago Vieira** is 1-0 with 4 saves and a 0.71 ERA (2 ER, 25.1 IP) in his last 19 relief appearances (5/28-current)...during this 19-game stretch, he has limited opponents to a .161(15x93) average, while walking 7 and striking out 32.
- **ON A ROLL** – Since being promoted to Bakersfield, RH **Darin Gillies** is 2-0 with 1 save and a 1.27 ERA (3 ER, 21.1 IP) in 13 games in relief...he has limited opponents to a .157 (11x70) average, while walking 7 and striking out 28...he tossed 10.0 consecutive scoreless innings, July 2-25...during this stretch he has limited opponents to a .133 (4x30) average, while walking 5 and striking out 12.
- **WHAT A START** – RH **Zack Littell** is 5-1 with 2.09 ERA (10 ER, 43.0 IP) over his first 7 games/6 starts with Bakersfield...he has limited opponents to a .214 (34x159) average, while walking 6 and striking out 39.

RECAP: The LumberKings scored 5 runs over the last 3 innings, including 3 runs in the 9th inning, as Clinton came-from-behind to defeat Burlington 6-4 on Thursday night. 1B **Dalton Kelly** (3x5, R, 2 2B, 3 RBI) led the team with 3 hit and 3 RBI, while **Gus Craig** (2x3, R, HR, RBI) and SS **Rayder Ascanio** (2x2, 2 R, BB) each collected 2 of the LumberKings 9 hits. Starter **Nick Neidert** (1.0,2,1,1,0,0,HR) allowed 1 run on 2 hits in the 1st inning. RH **Pablo Lopez** (6.0,5,3,3,1,1,HR) allowed 3 runs on 5 hits over 6.0 innings in relief. LH **Jake Brentz** (1.0,0,0,0,0,2) earned his first win with Clinton striking out 2 in a 1-2-3 8th inning ,while RH **Matt Walker** (1.0,1,0,0,0,1) allowed 1 hit and struck out 1 over a scoreless 9th inning to pick up his 9th save.

NO HITTER: Starter **Pedro Vasquez** and relievers **Joey Strain**, **Lukas Schiraldi** and **Matt Walker** combined on a no-hitter as Clinton won their 6th straight game with a 2-0 win over Beloit on July 9. The no hitter was the 25th recorded in franchise history, and the first at home since Victor Sanchez no hit the Lansing Lugnuts on July 17th, 2013. It is the third combined no hitter in franchise history, as the last one came on May 1st, 2015, when Daniel Missaki, Kody Kerski, and Troy Scott combined to no hit the Cedar Rapids Kernels. The four pitchers used tonight were the most used in any of the franchise's 25 no hitters. **Vasquez** (3.0,0,0,0,0,4) struck out 4 over 3.0 hitless innings, but did not factor into the decision. **Strain** (3.0,0,0,0,0,2), **Schiraldi** (2.0,0,0,0,1,4) and **Walker** (1.0,0,0,0,0,1) combined to allow only 1 walk and struck out 7 over 6.0 hitless innings in relief. **Strain** earned his 5th win of the season, while **Walker** picked up his 8th save. 2B **Rafael Fernandez** (2x4, RBI) led the team with 2 hits and drove in 1 of the LumberKings 2 runs, while CF **Luis Liberato** (1x3, RBI), 1B **Dalton Kelly** (1x3, RBI) and SS **Rayder Ascanio** (1x3, R) each collected 1 of the team's 5 hits.
