OAKLAND NOTES

The Oakland A's have lost two of their last three games and are 5-10 over the last 15 contests...are now 19-18 (.514) in one-run games...fell to 52-65 (.444) overall and 28-34 (.452) at home...are now 35-38 (.479) at night and 39-48 (.448) against opposing right-handed starters...dropped to 22-25 (.468) against AL West competition and 5-7 (.417) in August...trail the Mariners in the season series 5-6 and are 49-57 against Seattle over the last six years...are 4-5 on this 10-game homestand against Chicago-NL (0-3), Baltimore (3-1) and Seattle (1-1).

- The A's have scored 15 runs over the past three games after scoring nine runs over the previous six games...have hit a home run in 21 straight games against Seattle (27 homers total)...A's pitchers have allowed at least one home run in 17 of the last 19 games (31 home runs total).
- Kendall Graveman is 7-2 with a 3.83 ERA (37 er in 87.0 ip) over his last 14 starts...is 4-1 with a 2.79 ERA (13 er in 42.0 ip) over his last six home starts...took his first loss in Oakland since May 19...is 4-4 with a 3.03 ERA (22 er in 65.1 ip) in 10 starts at home...is 1-1 with a 5.82 ERA (11 er in 17.0 ip) in three starts in August...is 5-6 with a 4.27 ERA (46 er in 97.0 ip) in 16 starts at night...is 1-2 with a 3.71 ERA (11 er in 26.2 ip) in six career appearances, including four starts, against Seattle.
- Billy Butler (3-for-4, 2 r, 2 2b) is hitting .474 (18-for-38) with seven RBI over his last 11 games...recorded his fourth three-hit and 14th multi-hit game this season...hit two doubles in a game for the second time this season (also: April 4 vs. Chicago-AL).
- Coco Crisp (3-for-5, rbi, so) is batting 27-for-59 (.458) with runners in scoring position this season...recorded his fourth three-hit and 25th multi-hit game.
- Khris Davis (1-for-4, r, hr, rbi, 2 so) is batting .288 (76-for-264) with 24 of his 29 home runs at night.
- Stephen Vogt (2-for-4) is batting .321 (9-for-28) in nine games on the current homestand...recorded his second straight multi-hit game, his 26th this year.

SEATTLE NOTES

- The Seattle Mariners have won seven of their last eight games...are 15-8 in the last 23 games, 16-10 in the last 26, and 18-12 in their last 30 games...are now 41-36 (.532) at night...improved to 20-21 (488) in one-run games...improved to 28-29 (.491) on the road and 20-25 (.444) against AL West competition, including a 9-12 mark on the road against AL West clubs...have won eight of their last nine games against the A's at the Coliseum and now lead the season series 6-5 with Oakland...are 23-12 against the A's since 2013...are 1-1 on this seven-game road trip to Oakland (1-1) and Los Angeles-AL (four games).
- The Mariners have had each of their last 14 games decided by three runs or fewer (10-4 in those 14 games).
- Hisashi lwakuma is 13-3 with a 3.58 ERA (40 er in 100.2 ip) over his last 16 starts (since May 20)...is 10-3 with a 3.62 ERA (41 er in 102.0 ip) in 16 starts at night... is 6-5 with a 4.17 ERA (36 er in 77.2 ip) in 13 starts on the road...is 3-0 with a 3.29 ERA (7 er in 19.1 ip) in three starts against Oakland this season...is 8-5 with a 3.90 ERA (37 er in 85.1 ip) in 14 games, including 13 starts, in his career against the A's...is 5-1 with a 3.19 ERA (13 er in 36.2 ip) in six career starts at the Collseum.
- Norichika Aoki (1-for-5) has hit safely in 18 of his 19 games with an at bat against Oakland...is batting .325 (25-for-77) with 11 runs in 20 total games against the A's.
 Robinson Cano (1-for-4, r, hr, 2 rbi) is 6-for-18 (.333) with four runs and two homers over his last four games.
- Nelson Cruz (2-for-4, r, hr, rbi, so) is batting .435 (10-for-23) with four runs, two homers and four RBI over his last six games...is hitting .315 (79-for-251) with 20 homers and 54 RBI in 66 games as the designated hitter...recorded his 35th multi-hit game this season.
