OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have lost three of their last four games and are 5-11 over the last 16 contests...dropped to 28-35 (.444) at home and 17-28 (.378) during the day...have lost 13 of the last 17 games in which the opponent starts a left-handed pitcher...are now 13-18 (.419) against opposing left-handed starters... dropped to 22-26 (.458) against AL West competition...are now 12-26 (.316) in the last game of a series...trail the Mariners in the season series 5-7 and are 49-58 against Seattle over the last six years...finished 4-6 on this 10-game homestand against Chicago-NL (0-3), Baltimore (3-1) and Seattle (1-2)...leave following today's game for a six-game road trip to Texas (three games) and Chicago-AL (three games).
- The A's have hit a home run in 22 straight games against Seattle (30 homers total), which is their most consecutive games with a home run against one team (previous: New York, July 22, 1992-April 30, 1994)...A's pitchers have allowed at least one home run in 18 of the last 20 games (32 home runs total).
- Zach Neal is 1-1 with a 2.84 ERA (6 er in 19.0 ip) in five games, including two starts, in his fourth stint with the A's this season...is 2-1 with a 2.78 ERA (7 er in 22.2 ip) over his last eight games dating back to June 18...is 1-2 with a 7.98 ERA (13 er in 14.2 ip) in his three starting assignments this season...is 1-1 with a 3.92 ERA (9 er in 20.2 ip) in seven games at home.
- Khris Davis (2-for-4, r, hr, 2 rbi, so) has homered in three straight games for the second time in his career (also: May 26-28, 2014)...is the first Athletic with 30 home runs in a season since Brandon Moss in 2013 (30)...finished batting .290 (9-for-31) over the current homestand...has hit 17 of his 30 homers at home.
- Ryon Healy (1-for-2, r, hr, rbi, bb) is batting .250 (8-for-32) with four of his five home runs during the day.
- Tyler Ladendorf (0-for-2) is hitless in his last 17 at bats...that matches the longest hitless streak of his career (also: Sept. 17, 2015-May 20, 2016).
- Marcus Semien (1-for-5, 2b, 2 so) is batting .300 (15-for-50) in August and is a .299 (41-for-137).

SEATTLE NOTES

- The **Seattle Mariners** have won eight of their last nine games...are 16-8 in the last 24 games, 17-10 in the last 27, and 19-12 in their last 31 games...improved to 29-29 (.500) on the road and 21-18 (.538) during the day...are now 21-25 (.457) against AL West competition, including a 11-11 mark on the road against AL West clubs...improved to 18-16 (.529) in the third game of a series...have won nine of their last 10 games against the A's at the Coliseum and lead the season series with Oakland 7-5...are 24-12 against the A's since 2013...are 2-1 on this seven-game road trip to Oakland (2-1) and Los Angeles-AL (four games).
- Wade Leblanc is 1-0 with a 5.29 ERA (10 er in 17.0 ip) in his last three starts...is 1-0 with a 6.75 ERA (7 er in 9.1 ip) in two starts on the road...is 2-0 with a 4.98 ERA (12 er in 21.2 ip) in five career appearances, including three starts, against Oakland.
- Norichika Aoki (3-for-5, rbi) has hit safely in 19 of his 20 games with an at bat against Oakland...is batting .341 (28-for-82) with 11 runs in 21 total games against the A's...recorded his third three-hit and 20th multi-hit game of the year.
- Adam Lind (1-for-4, r, hr, rbi, bb) is 3-for-5 (.600) with three home runs, five RBI and a walk in his career against Zach Neal.
- Shawn O'Malley (2-for-3, r, 2b, rbi, bb) is batting .310 (18-for-58) with nine runs, three doubles and eight RBI over his last 17 games (since July 22).
- **Kyle Seager** (2-for-5, r, 2 2b, 4 rbi) is hitting .375 (12-for-32) with 10 RBI over his last eight games...recorded his third four-RBI game this season (last: August 9 vs. Detroit)...hit two doubles in a game for the third time this season (last: July 2 vs. Baltimore).
