**RECAP:** The Rainiers scored 6 runs in the top of the 4th inning, including 2 RBI by 1B **Dan Vogelbach** and C **Jese Sucre**, as Tacoma defeated Memphis 6-5 on Saturday night. **Vogelbach** (2x5, R, 2B, 2 RBI), **Sucre** (2x3, R, 2B, 2 RBI), RF **Stephen Romero** (2x5, R, 2B) and DH **Rob Brantly** (2x4, RBI, BB) each recorded multi-hit games, while 2B **Mike Freeman** (1x5), 3B **Zach Shank** (1x5) and LF **James Ramsey** (1x3, R) each collected 1 of the Rainiers 11 hits. Starter **Taijuan Walker** (4.1,6,4,4,4,3) allowed 4 runs on 6 hits over 4.1 innings, but did not factor into the decision. SP **Pat Venditte** (2.0,1,0,0,2,3), RH **Andrew Kittredge** (1.0,1,1,1,1,1) and LH **David Rollins** (1.2,0,0,0,1,0) combined to allow only 1 run over the final 4.2 innings in relief. **Venditte** earned his first win as a Rainier, while **Rollins** picked up his 2nd save of the season.

**OF NOTE:**

- **WELCOME TO TACOMA** – OF **James Ramsey** has reach base safely in 6 straight games, batting .500 (9x18) with 5 runs scored, 1 double, 1 home run, 5 RBI and 3 walks.
- **MULTI-HIT MADNESS** – INF **Mike Freeman** has hit safely in each of his first 8 games with Tacoma, including 5 multi-hit contests, batting .382 (13x34) with 7 runs scored, 3 doubles, 1 home run 5 RBI and 4 walks.
- **HE JUST HITS** – OF **Stefen Romero** has hit safely in 70 of 94 games this season, batting .313 (116x371) with 64 runs scored, 23 doubles, 5 triples, 19 home runs, 79 RBI, 3 HBP, 32 walks and 1 stolen base.
- **TURNING ON THE HEAT** – INF **Zach Shank** has hit safely in 11 of his last 13 games, batting .354 (17x48) with 9 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 triples, 3 RBI and 5 walks...overall he is batting .327 (66x202) with 34 runs scored, 12 doubles, 2 triples, 3 home runs, 18 RBI, 2 HBP, 19 walks and 1 stolen base in 60 games over 2 stints with Tacoma.
- **BULLPEN BULLY** – Dating back to June 18, LHP **Paul Fry** is 1-0 with a 2.75 ERA (6 ER, 19.2 IP) in 19 relief appearances...during this stretch he has limited opponents to a .236 (17x72) average, while walking 13 and striking out 23.

**RECAP:** The Generals scored 5 runs in the bottom of the 6th inning, including a 3-run home run by DH **Tyler O'Neill**, as Jackson held off a late rally by the Shuckers for 5-3 on Saturday night. LF **Leon Landry** (2x4, R, 3B) recorded the team's only multi-hit contest, while **O'Neill** (1x4, R, HR, 3 RBI), CF **Ian Miller** (1x4, R), 3B **Adam Law** (1x4, R), SS **Tim Lopes** (1x4), C **Marcus Littlewood** (1x2, R, 2B, 2 BB) and 2B **Brock Hebert** (1x3, 3B, 2 RBI) each collected 2 of the Generals 8 hits. Starter **Brett Ash** (8.0,7,0,0,0,3) earned the win and improved to 11-8 on the season, allowing 7 hits and striking out 3 over 8.0 shutout innings. RH **Guido Knudson** (0.2,2,3,3,1,0,HR) allowed 3 runs in the 9th inning, while RH **Ryne Harper** (0.1,0,0,0,0,0) retired the only batter faces and stranded 1 runner to pick up his 3rd save.

**SOUTHERN LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE WEEK:** LHP **Ryan Yarbrough** was named the Southern League Pitcher of the Week, Aug. 1-7. In his only start during the week, he allowed only 1 hits, walked 1 and struck out 6 over 6.0 scoreless innings to earn his 11th win of the season. Yarbrough's 11 wins also tie him with Joey Nation (2000), Nate Teut (2000), and Renyel Pinto (2004) for the third most wins in franchise history. Brian McNichol (1998) is second with 12 wins and Ricky Nolasco (2005) is first with 14. This marks his 2nd POW Award this season, also receiving the honor on May 23-29.

### OF NOTE:

- **IMPRESSIVE STRETCH** – C **Marcus Littlewood** has hit safely in 14 of his last 15 games, batting .360 (18x50) with 14 runs scored, 8 doubles, 8 RBI and 13 walks.
- **GETTING IN GOING** – OF **Ian Miller** has reached base safely in 20 straight games, including at least 1 hit in 17 games, batting .352 (25x71) with 10 runs scored, 5 doubles, 11 RBI, 3 HBP, 7 walks and 11 stolen bases.
- **HEATING UP** – INF **Tim Lopes** has hit safely in 15 of his last 17 games, batting .397 (27x68) with 13 runs scored, 3 doubles, 12 RBI, 1 HBP, 10 walks and 3 stolen bases...Lopes has hit safely in 8 straight games, Aug. 4-current, batting .432 (16x37) with 6 runs scored, 1 double, 6 RBI, 6 walks and 1 stolen base.
- **IT'S GETTING HOT IN HERE** – OF **Tyler O'Neill** has reached base safely in 98 of 109 games this season, including hits in 89 games (29 multi-hit contests)...overall this season he is batting .302 (125x415) with 58 runs scored, 24 doubles, 4 triples, 21 home runs, 89 RBI, 54 BB, 7 HBP and 9 stolen bases.
  - **TRIPLE CROWN** – **O'Neill** currently leads the Southern League in 2 of the 3 Triple Crown category, while tied for the lead in the 3rd...he is leading the league in batting average (.302) and RBI (89), while tied with Daniel Palka (21), who has been promoted to AAA, in home run...the only other Triple Crown winner was Mike Reinbach of the 1972 Asheville Orioles: .346 average, 30 HR, 109 RBI...O'Neill's 89 RBI are the 3rd-most in franchise history. Alex Liddi is 2nd with 92 in 2010 while Julio Zuleta is 1st with 97.
- **LET'S GO STREAKING** – In first 12 relief appearance over 2 stints with Jackson, RH **Kyle Schepel** tossed 18.0 scoreless innings in relief from May 12-July 22...overall he is 1-0 with a 1.03 ERA (3 ER, 26.1 IP) in 17 games...he has limited opponents to a .176 (16x91) with 14 walks and 27 strikeouts.
- **STREAKING** – RH **Andrew Moore** is 5-0 with a 2.01 ERA (9 ER, 40.1 IP) over his last 6 starts...during this stretch, dating back to July 17, he has limited opponents to a .225 (32x142) average, while walking 5 and striking out 31.
- **HEATING UP IN JULY** – LH **Ryan Yarbrough** is 4-1 with a 2.18 ERA (8 ER, 33.0 IP) over his last 7 starts, dating back to July 8...during this streak has limited opponents to a .178 (21x118) average, while walking 7 and striking out 22.
- **BULLPEN BULLY** – Over his last 32 relief appearances, RH **Dan Altavilla** is 6-2 with 12 saves and a 1.09 ERA (5 ER, 41.1 IP)...during this stretch, dating back to May 6, he has limited opponents to a .187 (28x150) average, while walking 13 and striking out 55.
  - **SCORELESS INNINGS** – From July 3-Aug 12, **Altavilla** has tossed 18.0 scoreless innings over 14 relief appearances.

**RECAP:** Trailing 8-2 after the 3rd, 10-4 after the 4th and 12-4 after 7 inning, the Blaze scored 4 runs in each the 8th and 9th innings to tie it 12-12 and scored 2 more runs in the bottom of the 13th inning as Bakersfield defeated Lake Elsinore 14-13 on Saturday night. LF **Jay Baum** (1x6, R, 2 RBI, BB) walk-off 2-run single with 2 outs in the bottom of the 11th inning to secure the comeback victory. DH **Justin Seager** (3x6, 3 R, 2 HR, 7 RBI) recored his first career multi-home run game and set a career hight with 7 RBI. He hit a 3-run blast with 2 outs in the 4th inning and a grand slam home run with 1 out in the bottom of the 9th inning to tie the game 12-12. SS **Drew Jackson** (3x5, 2 R, 2 BB), 2B **Gianfranco Wawoe** (2x7, R, 2B, 2 RBI) and CF Austin Wilson (2x5, 3 R, 2 2B, RBI, BB) each collected at least 2 of the Blaze's 15 hits. Starter **Eddie Campbell** (2.2,8,8,8,3,1,2HR) allowed 2 runs on 8 hits over 2.2 innings, but did not factor into the decision. RH **Isaac Sanchez** (2.1,5,2,2,1,0), LH **Joe Pistorese** (2.0,4,2,2,0,1), RH **Darin Gillies** (2.0,1,0,0,1,4), RH **Ramon Morla** (1.0,2,0,0,0,1) and RH **Vinny Nittoli** (1.0,1,1,1,1,0) combined to allow 5 runs over 8.1 innings in relief. **Nittoli** picked up his 3rd win, despite allowing the go-ahead run to score in the top of the 11th inning.

**CALIFORNIA LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE MONTH:** RHP **Zack Littell** was named California League Pitcher of the Month for July. In 5 starts with the Blaze in July, Littell went 4-0 with a 0.84 ERA (3 ER, 32.0). He limited opponents to a .184 (21x114) average, while walking 3 and striking out 25. He recorded 5 quality starts, including tossing a season-high tying 8.0 innings on July 26 at San Jose (8.0,5,0,0,0,6). Littell did not allow a run in 4 of his 5 starts in July, including tossing 20.0 scoreless innings over 3 starts, July 16-27. Littell began the season with Single A Clinton making 16 starts before being promoted to Bakersfield on July 4. Overall in 16 starts with the LumberKings, Littell went 5-5 with a 2.76 ERA (30 ER, 97.2 IP). He limited opponents to a .258 (94x365) average, while walking 21 and striking out 95. Littell was the Mariners 11th round selection in the 2013 MLB First-Year Player draft out of Eastern Alamance (NC) High School.

## OF NOTE:

- **HITS, HITS AND MORE HITS** – C **Tyler Marlette** has hit safely in 28 of his last 36 games with 14 multi-hit contests, batting .348 (49x141) with 22 runs scored, 11 doubles, 6 home runs, 26 RBI, 14 walks, 1 HBP and 4 stolen base.
  - **HOMER HAPPY** – **Marlette** recorded 4 of his 5 multi-homer games in his career in 2016: May 18 at High Desert (2x5, 2 R, 2 HR, 6 RBI), May 23 at Lake Elsinore (2x4, 2 R, 2 HR, 3 RBI), June 3 at Stockton (3x5, 2 R, 2B, 2 HR, 3 RBI) and July 15 vs. Modesto (2x3, 2 R, 2 HR, 5 RBI)...prior to this season had only recorded 1 other multi-HR game on April 12 vs. Rancho Cucamonga (2x3, 3 R, 2 HR, 3 RBI, HBP).
  - **POW** – **Marlette** was named California League Player of the Week, July 4-10. Marlette hit safely in all 7 games he appeared during the week, including 6 multi-hit contests (.607/17x28, 8 R, 6 2B, 8 RBI, 2 BB, SB).
- **BULLPEN BULLY** – LH **Joe Pistorese** recorded the win in his Bakersfield debut on Aug. 10 at Visalia, allowing 1 hit and striking out 6 over 2.0 scoreless innings...in 15 relief appearances combined between Clinton and Bakersfield, he is 2-0 with 1 save and a 1.11 ERA (3 ER, 24.1 IP), including not allowing over his 20.1 innings in relief (7/1-8/13)...overall he has limited opponents to a .174 (15x86) average, while walking 2 and striking out 34.
- **IN A GROOVE** – After allowing 11 runs (10 ER) over his first 7.2 innings to begin the season, RH **Thyago Vieira** is 1-0 with 5 saves and a 0.68 ERA (2 ER, 26.1 IP) in his last 20 relief appearances (5/28-current)...during this 20-game stretch, he has limited opponents to a .155 (15x97) average, while walking 7 and striking out 34.
- **ON A ROLL** – Since being promoted to Bakersfield, RH **Darin Gillies** is 2-0 with 1 save and a 1.16 ERA (3 ER, 23.1 IP) in 14 games in relief...he has limited opponents to a .156 (12x77) average, while walking 8 and striking out 32...he tossed 10.0 consecutive scoreless innings, July 2-25...during this stretch he has limited opponents to a .133 (4x30) average, while walking 5 and striking out 12.
