#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The **Oakland A's** have lost three straight, eight of the last nine and 17 of the last 23 games...fell to a season-high 19 games under .500 at 53-72 (.424), which is their worst record after 125 games since 1997 (50-75)...were shutout for the eighth time this season, and the fourth time at home...fell to 28-36 (.438) at home and 36-43 (.456) at night...dropped to 19-20 (.487) in one-run games and are 39-40 (.494) in games decided by three runs or fewer...are now 11-16 (.407) against AL Central competition and 6-14 (.300) in August...have lost the season series with the Indians 0-4 with two games left and are 20-21 against Cleveland dating back to 2011...are 0-1 on this three-game homestand against Cleveland (0-1).
- A's pitchers have allowed 12 home runs in the last 11 games.

W — Carrasco (9-6)

- Andrew Triggs set career highs in innings pitched (6.0) and pitches (89) while matching his season high in strikeouts (6; also: June 3, 2016 at Houston)... it was his longest scoreless streak this season...is 0-1 with a 2.55 ERA (5 er in 17.2 ip) in five games, including three starts, in his most recent stint with the A's...is 0-1 with a 2.41 ERA (5 er in 18.2 ip) in four starting assignments this season...made his first career appearance against Cleveland.
- Ryon Healy (2-for-3, so) extended his hitting streak to nine games (13-for-34, .382).
- Jake Smolinski (1-for-4, 3 so) extended his hitting streak to five games (6-for-18, .333).

#### **CLEVELAND NOTES**

- The Cleveland Indians have won four of their past five, 10 of their last 14, and 12 of their last 18 games...recorded their ninth shutout win this season, the fifth on the road...are 20-15 since the All-Star Break...improved to a season-high 21 games above .500 at 72-51 (.585)...are now 33-28 (.541) on the road and 12-9 in August...are now 26-16 (.619) in the first game of a series, and 15-9 (.625) against AL West competition...clinched a season series win against the A's 4-0 with two games left, the first season series win against Oakland since going 5-2 in 2013...are 21-20 against the A's dating back to 2011 and lead the all-time series 1029-903...are 1-0 on this seven-game road trip to Oakland (1-0) and Texas (four games).
- The Indians have played five consecutive one-run games (4-1 record) and are 19-17 (.528) in one-run games this season.
- Carlos Carrasco has struck out at least eight batters in four consecutive starts...is 2-2 with a 5.01 ERA (18 er in 32.1 ip) in five starts in August...is 6-3 with a 1.74 ERA (13 er in 67.1 ip) in 10 starts on the road...is 7-3 with a 3.72 ERA (34 er in 82.1 ip) in 13 starts at night...is 2-0 with a 1.13 ERA (3 er in 24.0 ip) in three career starts against Oakland...is 3-1 with a 2.57 ERA (8 er in 28.0 ip) in four starts against AL West competition this season...is 8-4 with a 2.83 ERA (39 er in 124.0 ip) in 18 career starts against AL West clubs.
- Lonnie Chisenhall (2-for-4, 2b) is batting .327 (54-for-165) with 13 doubles and 36 RBI over his last 48 games.
- Jason Kipnis (1-for-4, 2b) is batting .347 (51-for-147) with 12 doubles over his last 39 games...is hitting .284 (67-for-236) on the road this year.
- Jose Ramirez (0-for-4) had his streak of 27 consecutive games reaching base safely snapped.
- Carlos Santana (1-for-3, r, hr, rbi, bb) leads all Indians with 13 homers on the road...is batting .253 (57-for-225) with 32 RBI on the road.
