#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** snapped their three-game losing streak, but are still 2-8 in their last 10 games...improved to 7-14 (.333) in August and 37-43 (.463) at night...are now 29-36 (.446) at home and 12-16 (.429) against AL Central clubs...improved to 15-32 (.319) in games decided by four runs or more...snapped a four game losing streak against Cleveland, but trail the Indians in the season series 1-4...are 21-21 against Cleveland dating back to 2011...are 1-1 on this three-game homestand against Cleveland (1-1).
- A's pitchers** have allowed 13 home runs in the last 12 games.
- Chad Pinder** (1-for-4, rbi, so) and **Bruce Maxwell** (1-for-4, r, 2b, 2 rbi) earned their first Major League RBI.
- Sean Manaea** is 3-4 with a 3.44 ERA (26 er in 68.0 ip) in 11 games, including 10 starts, since being reinstated from the DL June 29...is 2-3 with a 4.40 ERA (15 er in 30.2 ip) in five starts in August...is 5-3 with a 3.26 ERA (28 er in 77.1 ip) in 13 games at home...made his first career appearance against Cleveland.
- Khris Davis** (2-for-4, 3 r, 2b, hr, 3 rbi, bb, 2 so) hit his 33rd home run of the season, which is the most by an Athletic since Jack Cusp also hit 33 in 2008...has hit 18 homers at home, which are the most homers in the Coliseum since Josh Reddick also had 18 in 2012...is batting 15-for-44 (.341) with six home runs and 12 RBI over his last 12 games...is hitting .289 (84-for-291) with 26 of his 33 home runs at night...the 26 night home runs are the most by an Athletic in the last 10 years...scored three runs in a game for the fifth time this season and sixth time of his career (last: June 28, 2016 at San Francisco).
- Ryon Healy** (3-for-4, 2 2b, rbi) extended his hitting streak to 10 games (15-for-37, .405)...recorded his first three-hit game and ninth multi-hit game...hit two doubles in a game for the second time this season (also: August 3 at Los Angeles-AL).
- Jake Smolinski** (1-for-5, r, rbi, so) extended his hitting streak to six games (7-for-23, .304).
- Danny Valencia** (2-for-5, 2 r, 2b) is batting .313 (25-for-80) over his last 23 games...recorded his 32nd multiple-hit game, his seventh in his last eight games.

#### CLEVELAND NOTES

- The **Cleveland Indians** had their two-game winning streak snapped, but are still 5-2 in their last seven and 11-5 in their last 16 games...fell to 20-16 since the All-Star Break...fell to 20-games over .500 at 72-52 (.581), which is one game shy of their high water mark...fell to 33-29 (.532) on the road and 12-10 in August...dropped to 15-10 (.600) against AL West clubs...had their four-game winning streak against the A's snapped, but still lead the season series 4-1...are now 21-21 against Oakland dating back to 2011...are 1-0 on this seven-game road trip to Oakland (1-0) and Texas (four games).
- Danny Salazar** is 0-1 with a 16.20 ERA (9 er in 5.0 ip) in two starts since being activated from the DL August 18...has allowed 15 earned runs on 15 hits with eight walks over his last three starts (all in August), a span of just 7.0 innings (19.29 ERA), and is 0-2 in those starts...is 2-1 with a 2.61 ERA (6 er in 20.2 ip) in three career starts against the A's.
- Chris Gimenez** (1-for-1, r, hr, rbi, bb) is 6-for-17 (.353) over his last eight games.
- Brandon Guyer** (1-for-1, 2b, bb) is batting .433 (13-for-30) with three doubles in 12 games with Cleveland.
- Mike Napoli** (1-for-4, 2 so) ended a no-hit bid with a single in the top of the fourth inning...is batting .313 (42-for-134) over his last 38 games.
- Francisco Lindor** (0-for-4, so) had his eight-game hitting streak snapped...was batting .364 (12-for-33) over that span.
