OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** won their second consecutive game but are still 3-7 over their last 10 games...snapped a five-game losing streak during day games (18-29 overall during the day compared to 37-43 at night)...improved to 8-14 in August and are now 30-36 at home...improved to 13-16 against AL Central clubs...lost the season series against Cleveland despite Wednesday's win with a 2-4 mark this year...are 22-21 against Cleveland dating back to 2011...closed out their three-game homestand against Cleveland at 2-1 and will now travel tomorrow to begin a six-game road trip to St. Louis (three games) and Houston (three games) on Friday.
- Today's game marked the 18th time in the A's last 28 games that their opponent has been in first place in their division at the time of the game...are now 7-11 in such games.
- A's pitchers have allowed 14 home runs in the last 13 games.
- Kendall Graveman allowed just one earned run over 6.2 innings of works to record his team-leading 10th win of the season...improved his record to 10-8 with a 3.97 ERA (66 er in 149.2 ip)...is now 9-2 with 3.33 ERA (38 er in 102.2 ip) over his last 16 starts after going 1-6 with a 5.36 ERA over his first nine starts.
- Khris Davis (2-for-4, r, 3b) is batting 17-for-48 (.354) with six home runs and 12 RBI over his last 13 games.
- Ryon Healy (1-for-3, rbi, r, bb) extended his career-high hitting streak to 11 games (17-for-41, .415)...is batting .313 (30-for-96) against right-handed pitchers.
- Chad Pinder (1-for-3, sac fly, rbi, so) knocked in his second big league RBI in back-to-back games since being selected from Triple-A Nashville Aug. 17.
- Jake Smolinski (2-for-5, r) extended his hitting streak to seven games, going 8-for-28 (.286) during that span.

CLEVELAND NOTES

- The Cleveland Indians lost their second straight game but are still 11-6 over their last 17 games...fell to 12-11 in August...are now 23-23 since the club's 14-game winning streak that ended July 2...are now 22-37 when allowing opponents to score first, as opposed to 50-16 when scoring first...fell to 33-30 on the road and are now 15-11 against AL West clubs...won the season series over Oakland despite Wednesday's loss with a 4-2 mark this season...are 21-22 against the A's dating back to 2011...are 1-2 on this seven-game road trip to Oakland (1-2) and Texas (four games).
- Trevor Bauer allowed three earned runs over 6.2 innings and was charged with the loss in Wednesday's rubber match of the series...the loss now brings his record to 9-6 with a 3.88 ERA (63 er in 146 ip).
- Roberto Perez (1-for-2, hr, rbi, r, bb) hit his first home run of the season.
- Jose Ramirez (2-for-4, 2b) recorded his 39th multi-hit game of the season...has reached base in 28 of his last 30 games...snapped an 0-for-7 slump heading into today's contest.
- Mike Napoli (0-for-3, so) had his two-game hitting streak snapped...is batting .307 (42-for-137) over his last 39 games since July 8.
