DON'T CHANGE HORSES (IN THE MIDDLE OF THE STREAM)

» After edging Oakland, 1-0, in Monday night's series opener, Cleveland dropped Tuesday's tilt to the Athletics by a score of 9-1...**DANNY SALAZAR** went 4.0-plus innings and took the loss in an abbreviated start (4.0IP, 8H, 6R-ER, 3BB, 2SO, HR, WP, 80 pitches)...for the second consecutive night, the Indians were held to a single run, which came on a solo HR, as **CHRIS GIMENEZ** connected for his fourth of the season to lead off the 6th...the Gimenez drive was one of only 4 hits managed by Cleveland's offense, just the eighth time this season (0-8) for the Tribe to be held to fewer than 5 base knocks...**ZACH McALLISTER** (2.0IP) & **JEFF MANSHIP** (1.0IP) both turned in scoreless relief outings.

TIME WILL TELL

» Despite last night's defeat, **Cleveland maintained possession of the American League's best record, 3rd-best in the Majors** behind the Cubs & Nationals...the Indians also have the fewest losses in the A.L. (52) - T2nd-fewest in the Majors behind the Cubs.

» **The Tribe's 46-28 (.622) record since June 1 is best in the Majors,** just ahead of Toronto (.606, 43-28).

WINS & LOSSES

» **Cleveland sits at 72-52 (.581), 20 games above the .500 mark** and one win shy of the club's high-water mark for 2016 (+21G, 72-51 on Aug. 22 - also the club's highest mark since finishing 2013 season at +22, 92-70)...the Tribe's low-water mark of the season is 2 games below .500 (10-12 on May 2).

» Cleveland holds a 23-22 record since the club's historic 14-game winning streak ended on July 2, as the Tribe has won 10 of 15, 12 of 19, 37 of 59 and 62 of last 102...**the Indians are 12-10 in August;** went 10-11 in April, 16-13 in May, 22-6 in June & 12-12 in July (*22 June wins most for Tribe in single calendar month since going 22-7 in June 1965 - 8th time in 52 seasons since '65 to record 20+ wins in any calendar month*)...**the Indians are 50-16 when scoring first,** but 22-36 when allowing opponent to strike first...**Indians are 64-1 when leading after 8.0 innings** (one loss 8/17 vs. CWS)...club has gone 31-20 bouncing back from a loss, while going 41-31 following a win...**the Tribe has a 37-31 record vs. teams .500-or-better (35-21 vs. sub-.500 teams)**...**the Tribe is 10-4 following an off day.**

» **Cleveland has gone 20-16 since the All-Star break (T4th in A.L., T7th in MLB)** after finishing the first half at 52-36 (2nd in A.L., 5th in MLB) with a 6.5-game lead in the A.L. Central - first time to hold first place at the turn since 1999 (+13.0G)...*according to Elias*, the Indians had previously led by 6.0+ games at the break just 3 times in team history (1995, 1998, 1999) and went on to win the division each time.

» Cleveland's 52 first-half wins were T3rd-most by the club entering the All-Star break over last 84 seasons since MLB's first Mid-Summer Classic in 1933 (ninth time w/ 50+ wins in that span).

» **The Indians have rallied for 27 come-from-behind wins**...club also has 18 losses after holding a lead at some point in the contest - 11 of those 18 coming in road games.

» The Indians have held a lead at some point in 10 of their last 22 losses, all over the span of their last 45 games beginning July 2 (23-22 record).

A.L. CENTRAL STANDINGS

» **Cleveland (72-52) holds sole possession of 1st place in the A.L. Central standings,** 6.5 games ahead of 2nd-place Detroit (66-59, -6.5G)...Kansas City (65-60, -7.5G) is in 3rd place, Chicago-AL (60-64, -12.0G) is in 4th place & Minnesota (49-76, -23.5G) is in 5th place...Tribe's current 6.5-game advantage is 1.0 game shy of club's largest 1st-place lead in 2016 (+7.5G, last 8/22) and signals the Indians biggest lead this late into a season since ending the 2007 regular season with an 8.0-game lead on their way to meeting Boston in the ALCS...Tribe last held a lead of more than 8.0G this late in a season on Oct. 3, 2001 (+8.5G), shortly before meeting Seattle in the ALDS.

» **The Indians have spent 82 total days in 1st place,** 29 days in 2nd place, 11 days in 3rd place and 21 days in 4th place...have held top spot in the division consecutively for nearly three months (**81 straight days since June 4**)...*Tribe held sole possession of 1st place on May 28 for first time since July 2, 2013 (+0.5G, 45-38).*

» **The club is winning at a .660 clip (33-17) within the A.L. Central, while going 39-35 (.527) in games outside the division**...the Indians have gone 5-8 against Minnesota, but 28-9 against the rest of the A.L. Central.

» This season, Cleveland has put together separate divisional winning streaks of 7 games (May 23-June 5) and 8 games (June 17-July 5, *the longest winning streak for Cleveland within the division in the same season since an 8-game stretch from April 26-May 17, 2011*).

SERIES STUFF

» Cleveland has gone 20-15-6 in 41 finalized series so far in 2016, going 11-8-2 at Progressive Field & 9-7-4 on the road...the Indians are 11-5-3 over their last 19 series played (16-9-4 over their last 29).

» **The Tribe is 26-16 in series openers** (have won 21 of 31 & 23 of last 34 series openers), **while going 24-17 in series finales**...**Tribe is 7-8 in rubber matches**...club has gone 3-2-2 in four 4-games series (*Tribe has won 17 of 28 G that have been part of four-game series*).

» **Indians have recorded 11 separate series sweeps,** incl. two (2) two-gamers, seven (7) three-gamers & two (2) four-gamers...Tribe has been swept four times, three (3) 3-game series & one (1) one-game series.

SQUIB CAKES

» The Indians have scored exactly one run in each of the first two installments of this current road trip...marks the second time this season for Cleveland to be held to one-or-zero runs in back-to-back games, as the Tribe shouldered consecutive losses on June 7 (7-1) and June 8 (5-0) at Seattle.

» Monday's victory was the first 1-0 win of any kind for the Tribe since June 21, 2015 vs. Tampa Bay with 25 consecutive losses in between when plating exactly one run.

SO VERY HARD TO GO

» Tonight the Indians are 1-1 to begin a 7-day, 7-game road trip through Oakland (1-1, one-to-play) & Texas (4 games)...Tribe has already hosted both clubs in Cleveland this season, taking a 1-2 series loss against Texas, May 30-June 1, while sweeping a 3-game set from the A's, July 29-31.

» **Cleveland's 33-29 (.541) road record is 3rd-best in the A.L. and 16th in the Majors**...that said, the club has dropped 6 of 9 and 10 of last 17 away from Progressive Field since July 2, posting a 5.38 road ERA against 4.0 runs-per-game in that 18-game span.

» Although last night raised figure from 3.62, Cleveland's 3.71 road ERA is still 2nd-lowest in the A.L. and 4th in the Majors behind Toronto (3.54), Washington (3.66) and Chicago-NL (3.68)...staff's A.L.-low .236 avg. against on the road is 2nd-lowest in Majors behind the Cubs (.222).

EAST BAY GREASE

» Today Cleveland & Oakland are set to wrap up their home-and-home season series here at The Coliseum, as the Indians hold a 4-1 advantage (swept 3-game set at Progressive Field to end July)...last night snapped a 4-game winning streak vs. Oakland, longest since notching 4 straight victories vs. the A's, May 6-9, 2013...Cleveland has secured the club's first winning season vs. Oakland since going 5-2 in 2013.

» The Indians are 3-0 all-time in games started by **Kendall Graveman**...Tribe beat the right-hander, 5-3, back on July 29 in Cleveland.

» Cleveland is 15-10 against the A.L. West this season and an A.L.-best 76-48 (.613) since the start of the 2013 season.

HITCHHIKE TO RHOME | TEXAS PREVIEW

» At the conclusion of this afternoon's game, the Indians will head to Texas where they are set to square off with the Rangers for 4 games in Arlington...Tribe took a series loss (1-2) at home to Texas, May 30-June 1, getting outscored by the Rangers, 20-10 - primarily due to losses of 9-2 and 7-3 in the first two games...Cleveland has finished .500-or-better vs. Texas in each of the previous 3 seasons, going 14-5 from 2013-15 (7-3 in Arlington).

» Cleveland has hit 160 HR's this season, T7th-most in the A.L. and T10th-most in the Majors...62 of those 160 HR's (~39%) have either tied the game (18) or given Cleveland the lead (44).

» California native **TREVOR BAUER** (6-2, 3.03 ERA in 13 road starts) is seeking to become the ninth A.L. pitcher to reach 7 road wins this season.

» **BRANDON GUYER** is batting .433 (13-30) with 3 doubles, one HR, 8 RBI and 4 runs scored in 14 games played with Cleveland so far; is 8-for-22 (.364) against LH pitching & 4-for-9 (.444) w/RISP in that span...**ANDREW MILLER** has recorded 16 K's across 10.2 innings & 9 relief appearances since joining the Indians (opponents are 4-for-36, .111)...has retired 21 of 23 batters faced over his last 5 games...**the Tribe has gone 8-1 in games that Miller has appeared in.**

» Cleveland has gone 21-22 in day games this season...Tribe has a 4.04 ERA & .254/.318/.423 slash line in day games (**4.63 runs-per-game**) compared to a 3.74 ERA & .271/.331/.451 slash line in night games (**5.17 runs-per-game**).

» **1963:** Stevie Wonder became the 1st artist ever to score a US No.1 album & single in the same week with 'Little Stevie Wonder/The 12-Year-Old Genius', which contained the single 'Fingertips part 2'...this was also the first ever live recording to reach No.1...**1975:** Queen started recording 'Bohemian Rhapsody' at Rockfield studio's in Monmouth, Wales, (the song was recorded over three weeks)...**1981:** Mark David Chapman was sentenced to 20 years in prison for the murder of John Lennon on December 8, 1980 in New York City.

TODAY'S START

» The 25-year-old right hander will be making his 21st start & 28th appearance of the season today in the finale of this three-game series at Oakland...it will also be his 85th career start & 93rd career appearance.
 » Will be pitching on regular four days' rest since making his last start, August 19 vs. Toronto...did not factor into the decision after allowing two runs on five hits with two walks and a career-high 13 strikeouts in 8.0 innings of work.
 » Has made two career starts against Oakland & did not factor into the decision of either outing...has posted a 2.25 ERA (3ER/12.0IP) in those two starts.
 » Has made nine starts (13 appearances) on the road this season, going 6-2 with a 3.03 ERA (22ER/65.1IP)...his 3.03 road ERA is the ninth-lowest in the American League.

LAST TIME OUT

» Did not factor into the decision of Cleveland's 3-2 walk-off win on August 19 vs. Toronto... allowed two runs on five hits with two walks and a career-high 13 strikeouts in 8.0 innings... both runs allowed came on a two-run homer by Russell Martin in the 1st inning...Bauer then retired 21 of his final 26 batters faced...Bauer struck out five straight batters from the final out of the 6th inning through the first out in the 8th...fanned 11 of the last 19 batters he faced.
 » Marked the seventh time in his career to record 10-or-more strikeouts in game, including his third this season...he is 3-1 with a 1.22 ERA in those seven career starts...the 13 strikeouts set a new career-high, surpassing his previous high of 11 on April 4, 2015 at Houston... became the 24th Indians pitcher to strikeout 13-or-more batters in a game (since 1913).

VS. OAKLAND | AL WEST

» Set to make his third career start against the Athletics...has posted a 2.25 ERA (3ER/12.0IP) in his previous two starts against them...faced Oakland earlier this season on July 29 at Progressive Field & did not factor into the decision after allowing three runs (one unearned) on five hits with two walks and four strikeouts in 5.1 innings...two of the three runs allowed came on a pair of solo homers by Josh Reddick & Khris Davis.
 » Has made six starts against AL West opponents this year, going an undefeated 3-0 with a 2.63 ERA (12ER/41.0IP)...has made quality starts in four of his six outings against this division & has lasted 7.0-or-more innings on four occasions...also made one relief appearance against this division, allowing two runs on three hits in 2.0 innings of relief against Seattle on April 21 at Progressive Field.

ROAD WARRIOR

» Will be making his 10th road start (14th appearance)...has gone 6-2 with a 3.03 ERA (22ER/65.1IP) in his previous 13 road outings this year...his 3.03 road ERA (22ER/65.1IP) is the ninth-lowest in the AL this season...the Indians have won eight of his 13 road appearances this year & have outscored opponents 52-36 in those games.
 » Has made quality starts in six of his nine road starts this year.
 » Since the start of the 2015 season, Bauer has held opponents to a .215 average against (116-for-540) in 27 games on the road, which is the seventh-lowest in the AL & ranks 16th in the Majors in that span.

TURNING POINT

» Bauer has gone 2-0 with a 2.66 ERA (6ER/20.1IP) over his last three starts after going 0-3 with an 8.37 ERA (22ER/23.2IP) in five starts prior...has lasted 6.0-or-more innings in each of his last three outings & has held opponents to a .192 clip (14-for-73) in that span... lasted 6.0-plus innings just once in four July starts.

2016 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

» Began the season in the bullpen when Cody Anderson and Josh Tomlin were named the club's fourth & fifth starters on March 30...made his 2016 season debut on Opening Day, April 5 against Boston...allowed two runs on two hits 1.0 innings of relief...owned a 4.76 ERA (6ER/11.1IP) with 14 strikeouts in six relief appearances for the Tribe.
 » Posted a scoreless streak of 5.2 innings that began April 8 at Chicago-AL and lasted until allowing a two-run single to Nick Castellanos on April 24 at Detroit.
 » Made three consecutive scoreless relief appearances from April 8-April 15...limited batters to a .222 clip (4-for-18) with six strikeouts compared to one walk in that stretch.
 » Earned his first win in on April 24 in the Tribe's 6-3 victory at Detroit after working 3.1 innings in relief, allowing two runs on four hits with four strikeouts.
 » Moved from the bullpen to the rotation when Carlos Carrasco was placed on the 15-day Disabled List on April 25 (retro 4/24)...made his first start on April 30 at Philadelphia and did not factor into the decision after allowing three runs on five hits in 4.0 innings of work.
 » Worked his second career complete game on June 22 against Tampa Bay at Progressive Field...limited the Rays to just one run on three hits with one walk and 10 strikeouts, which tied a season-high (previously done June 6 at Seattle).
 » Earned the win in the Tribe's 2-1, 19-inning victory on July 1 at Toronto after working 5.0 shutout innings in relief...marked his fourth straight win, which set a new career-long winning streak.
 » Went 3-0 with a 2.01 ERA (10ER/44.2IP) in six June starts, the fifth-lowest ERA in the AL for the month & 12th-lowest in MLB...held opponents to a .190 clip (30-for-158) in June, which was the sixth-lowest average against in the AL & ranked 10th in MLB.
 » Ranked in the AL Top 20 for several pitching categories during the first half including: ERA (9th), average against (.229, 7th), HR-per-9.0IP (0.71, 3rd), hits-per-9.0IP (7.66, 8th), WHIP (1.20, 14th) and strikeouts (91, 25th).
 » Recorded a career-high 13 strikeouts in 8.0 innings on August 19 vs. Toronto...held the Blue Jays to two runs on five hits with two walks & 13 punchouts.

CAREER SNAPSHOT

» Right-hander is in his fourth season with the Indians organization after being acquired from the Arizona Diamondbacks on December 11, 2012, along with RHP Matt Albers, RHP Bryan Shaw (from Arizona) & Drew Stubbs (from Cincinnati), in a 3-team trade...at time of trade, was ranked as Arizona's No. 1 prospect by *Baseball America* and had just earned D-Backs Minor League Pitcher of the Year honors.
 » Made his Major League debut with Arizona on June 28, 2012, becoming the first player from the 2011 Draft Class to reach the Majors; future teammate Cody Allen would become the second just three weeks later...did not factor into the decision after allowing two runs on five hits in 4.0 innings of work.
 » Worked his first career complete game on July 28, 2015 (9.0IP, 5H, 2R/ER, 1HR, 1BB, 6SO, 112 pitches/78 strikes), but suffered the loss in a 2-1 Indians defeat against Kansas City...marked the Indians first complete game at home since Corey Kluber recorded a complete game on Sept. 6, 2014 against Chicago-AL.
 » Set single-season career-highs during the 2015 season in appearances (31), starts (30), innings pitched (176.0), wins (11) and strikeouts (14).
 » The 2016 season marks his sixth overall in professional baseball after being selected by Arizona in the first round of the 2011 draft out of UCLA, where he went 38-4 with a 2.36 ERA across three seasons for the Bruins...finished his college career holding a number of school records, including a Pac-10 record with 203 strikeouts in 2011.
 » The Southern California native graduated from Hart High School in Santa Clarita, the same HS that produced Kevin Millar, James Shields, Bob Walker and Todd Zeile.
