OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have lost four straight games and are 10-22 (.313) over the last 32 games...are a season-high 20 games under .500 at 57-77 (.425), which is the worst record after 134 games since 1997 (53-81)...fell to 30-37 (.448) at home and 38-47 (.447) at night...have lost 17 of the last 22 games in which the opponent starts a left-handed pitcher...are 14-22 (.389) against opposing left-handed starters this season...have lost eight straight against Boston, which is the longest losing streak against the Red Sox since losing nine in a row from July 6, 2004 to May 11, 2005...have lost the season series against Boston 0-4 with two games remaining and are 235-290 against the Red Sox since moving to Oakland in 1968...are 0-1 on their nine-game homestand against Boston (0-1), Los Angeles-AL (three games), and Seattle (three games).
- The A's allowed double-digit runs for the 10th time this season...the 16 runs were a season high and the most since Aug. 16, 2015 at Baltimore (18).

L — Neal (2-4)

- Andrew Triggs left the game after the first inning with tightness in his back...is 1-1 with a 2.92 ERA (8 er in 24.2 ip) in seven games, including five starts, during his most recent stint with Oakland...is 1-1 with a 2.58 ERA (11 er in 38.1 ip) in 14 games, including six starts, over his last four stints...is 1-1 with a 2.81 ERA (8 er in 25.2 ip) in six starts...is 0-0 with a 4.50 ERA (2 er in 4.0 ip) in three career appearances, including one start, against Boston (all this season).
- Jake Smolinski (1-for-4, r) is batting .250 (12-for-48) over his last 13 games...is batting .329 (27-for-82) against left-handed pitchers.
- Danny Valencia (1-for-2, r, bb) snapped an 0-for-12 hitless streak with a single in the fourth inning...is batting .346 (37-for-107) against left-handed pitching.
- Stephen Vogt (1-for-3, 2b, rbi, so) extended his hitting streak to five games (7-for-19, .368).

• Joey Wendle (1-for-1) collected his first Major League hit with a pinch-hit single in the eighth inning.

- The **Boston Red Sox** have won 14 of their last 21 games...are 32-22 (.593) since July 3...improved to 57-45 (.559) against opposing right-handed starters and 20-11 (.645) against AL West competition...are now 34-29 (.540) on the road and 51-40 (.560) at night...clinched a season series win against the A's 4-0 with two games left...have won eight straight games against Oakland, and are 1071-877 all-time against the A's...are 1-0 on this nine-game road trip to Oakland (1-0), San Diego (three games) and Toronto (four games).
- The Red Sox have scored at least 13 runs and 15 hits in four consecutive games against the A's this year... Yoan Moncada (0-for-1, r, so, bb) and Robby Scott made their Major League debuts.
- David Price is 5-0 with a 2.06 ERA (8 er in 35.0 ip) over his last five starts...is 3-1 with a 2.08 ERA (6 er in 26.0 ip) over his last four road starts...is 1-2 with a 2.25 ERA (7 er in 28.0 ip) in four starts in the state of California this season...is 3-2 with a 3.13 ERA (21 er in 60.1 ip) in nine career starts against Oakland.
- Xander Bogaerts (1-for-3, 3 r, 2b, rbi, 2 bb) is a .305 (18-for-59) career hitter against the A's.
- Mookie Betts (1-for-5, r, 2 rbi, so, sf) has reached base safely in each of his last 20 games (31-for-82, .378).
- David Ortiz (2-for-2, r, 3 rbi, bb, sf) is batting .354 (23-for-65) with 15 RBI over his last 19 games.
- Dustin Pedroia (2-for-5, 2 r, so) has hit safely in each of his last 18 games against the A's (27-for-70, .386)...is 39-for-85 (.459) since moving into the leadoff spot on August 10...has hit safely in nine straight games (21-for-38, .553).
