STATE OF THE SOX: Boston has won 13 of its last 20 games and owns MLB's 3rd-best record since 7/3 (31-22, .585) behind only the Cubs (35-18) and Blue Jays (32-18).

- Boston leads the AL with a +121 run differential.
- The Sox were off yesterday after concluding a stretch of 23 games in 23 days (14-9) on Wednesday...It also wrapped up a stretch of 43 games in 44 days (23-20).

IT'S BEEN DONE: The Sox are 74-59 through 133 games...6 of the last 13 World Series champs had a record of 74-59 or worse after 133 games, including 3 of the last 6.

- The Sox need only 4 more victories to match last year's win total (78-84)...Boston went 71-91 in 2014.

WELL, FOR STARTERS: Boston's starters posted a 3.29 ERA in August (69 ER/189.0 IP), MLB's 3rd-lowest mark behind the Cubs (2.16) and Royals (3.27)...Sox starters held opponents to a .220 AVG in the month, 2nd to only CHC (.189).

- Boston's starters have a 3.50 ERA in the club's last 48 games since 7/9, which ranks 2nd in MLB behind only the Cubs (2.72)...No team has received more innings from its starters than Boston has in that span (301.0).

PRICE CHECK: David Price is 9-7 with a 3.16 ERA in 21 starts since 5/12 (50 ER/142.1 IP), including 4-0 with a 1.93 ERA and .202 opponent AVG in his last 4 (28.0 IP, 6 ER, 5 BB, 27 SO).

- Price has made 3 starts in California this season: 6/8 at SF (8.0 IP, 3 H, 2 ER), 7/28 at LAA (8.0 IP, 7 H, 0 R), and 8/7 at LAD (5.0 IP, 6 H, 3 ER)...The Sox lost all 3 of those games despite a combined 2.14 ERA from Price.

LEADING THE WAY: Dustin Pedroia is 37-for-80 (.467) since moving into the leadoff spot on 8/10...His .714 AVG in his last 5 games (15-for-21) is the highest mark for any player over a 5-game span (min. 20 AB) since May 2008, when Lance Berkman had 16 hits in 20 at-bats (.800) over 5 games for the Astros (source: Elias).

HAMMERIN' HANLEY: Hanley Ramirez has homered in 3 of his last 5 games, including each of his last 2...In 17 games since 8/11, he is batting .365 with 22 RBI and a 1.121 OPS (23-for-63, 6 2B, 5 HR, 7 BB).

ONE-TWO PUNCH: David Ortiz (31 HR, 102 RBI) and Mookie Betts (30 HR, 96 RBI) could become the 11th set of Red Sox teammates with at least 30 HR & 100 RBI each...The most recent duos to accomplish the feat were Ortiz & Manny Ramirez (4 times, 2003-06), Nomar Garciaparra & Mo Vaughn (1998), and Tony Armas & Dwight Evans (1984).

- Ortiz and Betts could also become only the 2nd set of Sox teammates with at least 30 HR, 40 doubles, and 100 RBI each (Ortiz & Ramirez in 2004), as well as the 6th set with 75+ XBH each.

GOING OUT WITH A BANG: David Ortiz leads the majors in doubles (42), XBH (74), SLG (.622), and OPS (1.022)...He ranks 4th in RBI (102) and T-12th in HR (31).

FEATS OF MOOKIE: Mookie Betts leads MLB in multi-hit games (57) and is the only major leaguer with at least 300 total bases (315)...He also ranks 2nd in hits (179) and XBH (71), 3rd in runs (103), and T-6th in RBI (96).

- With 30 HR and 96 RBI, Betts could join Ted Williams (1939, 1941) as the only Red Sox players ever with 30+ HR and 100+ RBI in a season before turning 24.
- In 52 games since 7/1, Betts is batting .374 with a 1.078 OPS (80-for-214, 18 2B, 3B, 14 HR)...In that time, he leads the AL in AVG (2nd in MLB), SLG (.664, 2nd in MLB), OPS (3rd in MLB), and doubles (T-1st in MLB).

HEAD TO HEAD: Boston needs only 1 win this weekend to secure a season series victory, having swept the A's at Fenway Park from 5/9-11...The Sox have won each of the last 7 meetings and 9 of the last 10, marking their longest winning streak vs. OAK since 7/6/04-5/11/05 (9 games).

- Dustin Pedroia has hit safely in each of his last 17 games against the A's, the longest streak by a Red Sox vs. OAK since Mo Vaughn (17, 1995-97)...The only Red Sox with *longer* hit streaks against the A's since the franchise moved to Oakland in 1968 are Jim Rice (22, 1979-81) and Jerry Remy (20, 1978-81).

STRAIGHT A'S: The Red Sox totaled 40 runs on 48 hits in their 3-game series vs. OAK from 5/9-11, scoring 13+ runs in 3 consecutive games for the first time in franchise history...Boston became the first team to record at least 13 runs and 15 hits in 3 consecutive games since the Rockies did so from 6/6-8/96, and the first to accomplish the feat in a single series since the 1986 Indians (9/4-6 at MIL).

- Jackie Bradley Jr. totaled 13 RBI in the series, the most by a Red Sox player in a 3-game set since Nomar Garciaparra had 14 vs. SEA in May 1999.

SLUGGIN' SOX: The Sox have scored a major league-best 724 runs, 71 more than the AL's 2nd-highest mark (TOR-653)...Boston scored 634 runs in 2014 and 748 in 2015.

- Boston also leads the majors in doubles (294), AVG (.285), OBP (.350), SLG (.467), and OPS (.817).

HOMER HAPPY: The Red Sox have hit 76 HR since 7/4, 3rd-most in MLB in that time (STL-81, BAL-81).

TOUGH WITH 2: The Red Sox own the majors' highest AVG, OBP, SLG, and OPS with 2 strikes (.214/.281/.335/.616)... Boston's AVG with 2 strikes was .183 in 2014 and .199 in 2015...The Sox own 7 of the AL's top 22 OPS marks with 2 strikes (min. 100 AB), including David Ortiz (1st, .885), Sandy Leon (2nd, .817), and Xander Bogaerts (9th, .685).

RELEASE THE KIMBREL: Since returning from the DL on 8/1, Craig Kimbrel is 7-for-7 in save chances with a 0.82 ERA and .105 opponent AVG (11.0 IP, R, 19 SO, 4-for-38)... He has converted each of his last 12 save opportunities.

- Kimbrel has 249 saves in his career and is only 28 years old...Only 34 players have recorded 250+ saves since the stat became official in 1969...Francisco Rodriguez is the only other pitcher with as many as 200 saves prior to turning 29 years old (268).

ARM & HAMMER: Boston outfielders have combined for 7 double plays (T-3rd in MLB), 31 assists (6th in MLB), and a .992 fielding % (1st in MLB)...Boston leads MLB with a .501 SLG, an .853 OPS, and 237 RBI as an outfield...Sox outfielders lead the AL in hits (443), runs (257), and XBH (177).

BOSTON'S BACKSTOPS: Sox catchers have thrown out 11 of 21 (52%) attempted base stealers since 7/9...Only CLE has allowed fewer steals in that span (9)...21 teams have allowed 20+ steals in that time, and 10 teams have allowed 30+.

- The Red Sox are 21-6 in Ryan Hanigan's starts this season...They have won each of his last 8 starts behind the plate and 11 of his last 12.

BOTTOM'S UP: Boston's No. 9 hitters lead the majors in AVG (.290), OBP (.349), SLG (.450), OPS (.799), runs (67), hits (136), doubles (34), triples (tied, 7), XBH (50), and RBI (64)...4 Red Sox with at least 20 AB in the No. 9 spot are batting above .300: Jackie Bradley Jr. (.364, 39-for-107), Andrew Benintendi (.333, 19-for-57), Sandy Leon (.500, 22-for-44), and Marco Hernandez (.355, 11-for-31).

TONIGHT'S START:

- Has won each of his last 4 starts, all quality outings...Has a 1.93 ERA (6 ER/28.0 IP) and a .202 opponent AVG (21-for-104) in those 4 starts.
- His 3.16 ERA (50 ER/142.1 IP) over his last 21 starts since 5/12 is the 9th-lowest in the American League during that time.
- Is 2-1 with a 1.89 ERA (4 ER/19.0 IP) in his last 3 road starts...Has a .174 opponent AVG (12-for-69) and a 1.00 WHIP in those outings.
- Is among AL leaders with 186 SO (4th), 28 starts (T-1st), and 183.2 IP (T-3rd).
- Ranks among AL leaders with 4.54 SO/BB (6th), 9.11 SO/9.0 IP (6th), and 2.01 BB/9.0 IP (9th)...Is tied for the ML lead with 24 GS of 100+ pitches (also Verlander).
- Trails only Chris Sale (10) for the most starts of 8.0+ IP in the majors this season (9), the most by a Red Sox in a single season since Pedro Martinez in 2002 (11).
- Leads the AL with 7 double-digit strikeout efforts, tied with Jon Lester for the most by a Red Sox pitcher in a single season since Pedro Martinez in 2002 (9).

Last start: Earned the win on 8/27 vs. KC, allowing 2 R on 5 H with 2 BB and 7 SO.

VS. THE ATHLETICS:

- Has tossed 7.0+ IP in each of his last 4 starts vs. OAK...Is 2-1 with a 2.17 ERA (7 ER/29.0 IP), a .178 opponent AVG (19-for-107), and 31 SO/5 BB in those outings.

2016 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- His 140 strikeouts and 7 double-digit strikeout games prior to the All-Star break are the most ever by a Red Sox LHP.
- Recorded 10 SO and 1 BB in 3 consecutive starts from 6/29-7/10...According to Elias, the only other Red Sox to ever make 3 consecutive starts of 10+ SO and 1 or 0 BB are Pedro Martinez (Aug. 1999) and Rich Hill (Sept. 2015).
- On 4/26 at ATL, set a team season high with 14 SO over 8.0 IP...Was also the highest single-game strikeout total on the road by a BOS LHP in the last 100 years.
