#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have lost five straight games and are 10-23 (.303) over the last 33 games...are a season-high 21 games under .500 at 57-78 (.422), which is the worst record after 135 games since 1997 (53-82)...fell to 30-28 (.517) at home and 38-48 (.442) at night...have lost nine straight against Boston, which matches the longest losing streak against the Red Sox since also losing nine in a row from July 6, 2004 to May 11, 2005...have lost the season series against Boston 0-5 with one game remaining and are 235-291 against the Red Sox since moving to Oakland in 1968...are 0-2 on their nine-game homestand against Boston (0-2), Los Angeles-AL (three games), and Seattle (three games).
- The **A's** allowed double-digit runs for the 11th time this season...have committed eight errors in the last seven games
- Daniel Mengden** is in his second stint with the A's this season...is 1-6 with a 6.66 ERA (38 er in 51.1 ip) in 10 starts...is 0-5 with a 7.53 ERA (24 er in 28.2 ip) in six starts at home...is 0-3 with a 9.11 ERA (27 er in 26.2 ip) in six starts against American League clubs...made his first appearance against Boston.
- Bruce Maxwell** (1-for-3, rbi) recorded his fourth RBI of the year in the sixth inning.
- Jake Smolinski** (1-for-3, r) broke up a no-hit bid with a double in the sixth inning...is batting .255 (13-for-51) over his last 14 games.
- Stephen Vogt** (1-for-3, r) extended his hitting streak to five games (8-for-22, .364).

#### BOSTON NOTES

- The **Boston Red Sox** have won 15 of their last 22 games...are 33-22 (.600) since July 3...improved to 58-45 (.563) against opposing right-handed starters and 21-11 (.656) against AL West competition...are 35-29 (.547) on the road and have won nine of the last 13 games on the road...are now 52-40 (.565) at night...have won the season series with the A's 5-0 with one game remaining...have nine straight games against Oakland, which is the longest winning streak since also winning nine in a row from July 6, 2004 to May 11, 2005...have won 11 of the last 12 games against Oakland and are 1072-877 all-time against the A's...are 2-0 on this nine-game road trip to Oakland (2-0), San Diego (three games) and Toronto (four games).
- The **Red Sox** have scored double digit runs in all five games against the A's this year...**Yoan Moncada** (2-for-5, r, 2b, rbi, 2 so) recorded his first Major League hit with an RBI double in the third inning and first multi-hit game...**Hanley Ramirez** (1-for-4, r, hr, rbi, bb, so) hit his 20th homer of the year, the first time hitting 20 or more home runs in a season since 2013 (19 in each of the past two seasons, both with Boston).
- Rick Porcello** is the first Red Sox ever to win at least 19 of his first 22 decisions...is 4-0 with a 2.52 ERA (10 er in 35.2 ip) over his last five games...is 12-3 with a 2.99 ERA (41 er in 123.1 ip) in 18 starts at night...is 6-3 with a 3.42 ERA (36 er in 94.2 ip) in 14 starts on the road...is 6-5 with a 3.76 ERA (34 er in 81.1 ip) in 14 career appearances, including 13 starts, against Oakland.
- Xander Bogaerts** (2-for-5, 2 r, rbi, 2 so) is a .313 (20-for-64) career hitter against the A's.
- Mookie Betts** (1-for-4, 2b, 2 rbi, bb, 2 so) has reached base safely in each of his last 21 games (32-for-86, .372).
- David Ortiz** (3-for-4, 2 2b, 2 rbi) is batting .377 (26-for-69) with 17 RBI over his last 20 games...recorded his seventh game of the season with at least two doubles (last: July 4 vs. Texas).
- Dustin Pedroia** (2-for-4, 2 r, bb) has hit safely in each of his last 19 games against the A's (29-for-74, .392)...is 41-for-89 (.461) since moving into the leadoff spot on August 10...has hit safely in 10 straight games (23-for-42, .548).
