OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** snapped a five-game losing streak, but are still 11-23 (.324) over the last 34 games...improved to 31-38 (.449) at home and 20-30 (.400) during the day...are now 15-22 (.405) against opposing left-handed starters...lost the season series with Boston 1-5, the second straight year losing the season series...however, snapped a nine-game losing streak against Boston, which was the third longest such streak in Oakland history (since 1968)...are 1-2 on their nine-game homestand against Boston (1-2), Los Angeles-AL (three games), and Seattle (three games).
- The A's have committed nine errors in the last eight games...earned their fifth shutout win this season...improved to 21-21 (.500) in one-run games.
- Kendall Graveman is 2-2 with a 2.06 ERA (8 er in 35.0 ip) over his last five starts...is 9-3 with a 3.18 ERA (41 er in 116.0 ip) over his last 18 starts...is 5-4 with a 2.64 ERA (23 er in 78.1 ip) in 12 starts at home...is 5-3 with a 3.03 ERA (23 er in 68.1 ip) in 10 starts since the All-Star Break...is 0-0 with a 1.35 ERA (2 er in 13.1 ip) in three career appearances, including two starts, against Boston...tossed a career-high tying 112 pitches.
- Khris Davis (1-for-4, 2b, 2 so) is batting .282 (22-for-78) with five doubles over his last 22 contests.
- Marucs Semien (1-for-4, 2 so) broke up a no-hit bid with a single in the eighth inning with two outs.
- Jake Smolinski (0-for-3, hbp) is batting .241 (13-for-54) over his last 15 games.
- Stephen Vogt (0-for-3) had his five-game hitting streak snapped...was batting ..364 (8-for-22) over that span.

BOSTON NOTES

- The **Boston Red Sox** are 5-6 in their last 11 games, but are still 33-23 (.589) since July 3...are now 35-30 (.538) on the road...fell to 58-46 (.558) against opposing right-handed starters and 21-12 (.636) against AL West competition...despite the loss, won the season series with the A's 5-1, the second straight year winning the season series...had a nine-game winning streak against Oakland snapped...However, are still 291-236 against the A's since they moved to Oakland in 1968...are 2-1 on this nine-game road trip to Oakland (2-1), San Diego (three games) and Toronto (four games).
- Eduardo Rodriguez is 0-2 with a 2.83 ERA (9 er in 28.2 ip) over his last five starts...is 1-3 with a 2.73 ERA (16 er in 52.2 ip) in nine starts since the All-Star Break...is 1-1 with a 1.52 ERA (5 er in 29.2 ip) over his last five road starts...is 2-2 with a 4.19 ERA (20 er in 43.0 ip) in eight road starts this season.
- Mookie Betts (1-for-4, so) has reached base safely in each of his last 22 games (33-for-90, .367).
- Yoan Moncada (2-for-4) recorded his second straight multi-hit game.
- David Ortiz (0-for-2, 2 bb, 2 so) is batting .366 (26-for-71) with 17 RBI over his last 21 games.
- Dustin Pedroia (2-for-4) has hit safely in each of his last 20 games against the A's (31-for-78, .397)...is 43-for-93 (.462) since moving into the leadoff spot on August 10...has hit safely in 11 straight games (25-for-46 .543)...recorded his fourth straight multi-hit game (9-for-18, .500) and 45th this season.
