OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have lost five of their last six and are 11-24 (.314) over the last 35 games...are a season-high tying 21 games under .500 at 58-79 (.423), which matches their record after 137 games last year...have allowed double-digit runs in three of the last four games...fell to 21-29 (.420) at home and 20-31 (.392) during the day...are 5-9 against the Angels, including a 1-6 mark in Oakland...have lost eight of the last nine games in Oakland against the Angels and are 54-55 against Los Angeles-AL since the start of the 2011 season...are 1-3 on their nine-game homestand against Boston (1-2), Los Angeles-AL (0-1), and Seattle (three games).
- The A's** have hit 19 home runs against the Angels, which matches their highest total against any team this year (Texas)...scored more than three runs for the first time since August 28...have made 10 errors in seven games...**Joey Wendle** (1-for-3, rbi, so) earned his first Major League RBI with a single in the fourth inning.
- Raul Alcantara** made his Major League debut...hit three batters in the first inning, which is the most by an A's pitcher since Jesse Hahn on 6/10/15 vs. Texas...there has never been four hit batters by the same pitcher in franchise history since at least 1913...is the first pitcher to hit three batters and have a balk called since Howard Ehmke did so on April 27, 1930.
- Sean Doolittle** made his first appearance in a game since June 25 at Los Angeles-AL...recorded his first strikeout since June 15 vs. Texas.
- Khris Davis** (1-for-3, 2 r, hr, rbi, 2 bb, 2 so) is batting .284 (23-for-81) with eight home runs over his last 23 contests...his 35 homers are most by an Athletic since Nick Swisher had 35 in 2006...has hit 19 homers at home, which are the most by an Athletic over the last eight years.
- Bruce Maxwell** (1-for-3, 2b, 2 rbi, 2 bb, so) is 4-for-15 (.267) over his last six games.
- Danny Valencia** (3-for-4, 2 r, 2b, hr, 2 rbi, bb) is hitting .380 (19-for-50) against Los Angeles-AL...recorded is 34th multi-hit game.

LOS ANGELES-AL NOTES

- The **Los Angeles Angels** have won three straight and eight of their last nine games...are 25-23 (.521) since the All-Star Break...improved to 30-42 (.417) on the road and 18-21 (.462) during the day...are now 39-33 (.542) when scoring first...lead the season series against the A's 8-5 and have won 25 of the last 37 overall meetings...have also won eight of the last nine games in Oakland and are 55-54 against the A's since the start of the 2011 season...have homered in 11 consecutive games against Oakland (18 total)...are 3-1 on this six-game road trip to Seattle (2-1) and Oakland (1-0).
- Jered Weaver** reached 2,000 innings pitched for his career...joins Chuck Finley and Nolan Ryan as the only pitchers to toss 2,000 innings in a Angels uniform...is 2-2 with a 6.23 ERA (18 er in 26.0 ip) over his last five starts...is 2-3 with a 5.80 ERA (29 er in 45.0 ip) in eight starts vs. AL West competition this season...is 14-11 with a 2.91 ERA (78 er in 241.0 ip) in 37 career starts against Oakland.
- Jose Valdez** earned his first Major League win.
- C.J. Cron** (2-for-5, r) extended his hitting streak to a career-high 12 games (20-for-51, .392)...is batting .339 (21-for-62) since returning from the DL on Aug. 20.
- Albert Pujols** (2-for-5, 2 r, 2b, 2 rbi, gidp) extended his hitting streak to a season-high 11 games (also: June 24-July 5)...is batting .447 (21-for-47) with 14 RBI over that span...has 50 RBI since the All-Star Break...is one double shy of tying Barry Bonds for 15th on the all-time doubles list.
- Mike Trout** (3-for-4, 2 r, so, hbp) is batting .453 (24-for-53) with four doubles and 11 RBI over his last 15 games...seven of his last 13 hits have been for extra bases...recorded his 14th three-hit and 42nd multi-hit game this season.
