OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have won two of their last three games, but are still 12-24 (.333) over the last 36 games...are now 22-21 (.512) in one-run games and 43-44 (.494) in games decided by three runs or fewer...improved to 32-39 (.451) at home and 39-48 (.448) at night...are 6-9 against the Angels this season and 420-351 since moving to Oakland in 1968...are 2-3 on their nine-game homestand against Boston (1-2), Los Angeles-AL (1-1), and Seattle (three games).
- The A's** have made 11 errors in the last eight games...played their fastest game of the season at two hours and 14 minutes.
- Zach Neal** is 1-3 with a 3.89 ERA (17 er in 39.1 ip) in nine games, including five starts, in his fourth stint with the A's this season...is 0-3 with a 5.61 ERA (16 er in 25.2 ip) over his last five games, including four starts...is 1-3 with a 5.74 ERA (20 er in 31.1 ip) in six starting assignments...is 0-0 with a 1.74 ERA (2 er in 10.1 ip) in three appearances, including one start, against Los Angeles-AL this season.
- Billy Butler** (1-for-3, so) snapped an 0-for-17 hitless streak with a single in the eighth inning.
- Ryon Healy** (2-for-3, rbi) snapped a no-hit bid with a one-out single in the sixth inning...is batting .358 (29-for-81) over his last 22 games.
- Joey Wendle** (1-for-3, 2 rbi) is 2-for-6 (.333) with 3 RBI in two games against the Angels.

LOS ANGELES-AL NOTES

- The **Los Angeles Angels** had their four-game winning streak snapped, but have still won eight of their last 10 games...are 25-24 (.510) since the All-Star Break...fell to 30-43 (.411) on the road and 44-55 (.444) at night...are now 39-34 (.534) when scoring first...despite the loss, still lead the season series with the A's 9-6...are 3-2 on this six-game road trip to Seattle (2-1) and Oakland (1-1).
- The Angels** had their 11-game homer streak against the A's snapped (18 total over that span).
- Ricky Nolasco** is 1-5 with a 4.30 ERA (22 er in 46.0 ip) since joining the Angels on August 1...is 4-7 with a 4.93 ERA (44 er in 80.1 ip) in 14 road starts...is 2-2 with a 4.05 ERA (18 er in 40.0 ip) in six career starts against the A's...is 1-1 with a 2.35 ERA (6 er in 23.0 ip) in three career starts at the Coliseum.
- C.J. Cron** (0-for-4, 3 so) had his career-high 12-game hitting streak snapped...was batting .373 (19-for-51) over that span.
- Albert Pujols** (2-for-4, r) extended his hitting streak to a season-high 12 games...is batting .451 (23-for-51) with 14 RBI over that span.
- Andrelton Simmons** (2-for-3, 2b, rbi) is batting .364 (20-for-55) over his last 15 games...is hitting .328 (78-for-238) over his last 65 games.
