OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** had their two-game winning streak snapped and are 13-25 (.342) over the last 38 games...are 60-80 (.429) for the season, which matches the A's record after 140 games last year...have been eliminated from the AL West...are now 22-22 (.500) in one-run games...fell to 33-40 (.452) at home and 39-49 (.443) at night...dropped to 24-34 (.414) against AL West opponents...trail the Mariners in the season series 5-8 and have lost 10 of the last 11 games in Oakland...are 49-59 against Seattle over the last six years...are 3-4 on their nine-game homestand against Boston (1-2), Los Angeles-AL (2-1) and Seattle (0-1).
- The A's** are batting .193 (80-for-414) with 36 runs scored over the last 13 games (2.77 runs per game)...did not homer for the first time in 22 games against Seattle.
- Daniel Mengden** is 0-2 with a 10.57 ERA (9 er in 7.2 ip) in his second stint with the A's this season...is 1-7 with a 6.39 ERA (40 er in 56.1 ip) overall this season...is 0-6 with a 6.95 ERA (26 er in 33.2 ip) in seven starts at home...his six-game career-opening home losing streak is the longest in Oakland history (previous: 5, Steve Ontiveros, 1985-85; Dallas Braden, 2007)...it is the third longest in A's history since at least 1913 (11, Bob Hasty; 7, Wally Burnette)...is 0-4 with a 8.24 ERA (29 er in 31.2 ip) in seven starts against American League teams...made his first career appearance against Seattle.
- Yonder Alonso** (1-for-4, 2 so) is hitting .259 (93-for-359) against right handed pitchers.
- Bruce Maxwell** (3-for-3, 2b, rbi) is 7-for-18 (.389) over his last seven games...recorded his first career multi-hit and three-hit game.
- Joey Wendle** (2-for-4, rbi) has hit safely in four straight games (5-for-13, .385)...recorded his first career multi-hit game.

SEATTLE NOTES

- The **Seattle Mariners** are 5-3 in their last eight games...are now 24-25 (.490) in one-run games...improved to 33-37 (.471) on the road and 51-45 (.531) at night...are now 26-20 (.565) in the first game of a series and 28-33 (.459) against AL West competition...are 6-1 against the A's at the Coliseum this season...have won 10 of the last 11 match ups in Oakland and are 18-6 in the last 24 games at the Coliseum...lead the season series against the A's 8-5...are 1-0 on this six-game road trip to Oakland (1-0) and Los Angeles-AL (three games).
- The Mariners** have nine players with at least 10 home runs, which ties a club record (last: 2015).
- Hisashi Iwakuma** recorded his 15th win of the season, matching his career high (15-9 in 2014)...is one of seven Mariners pitchers to record at least two seasons with 15 or more wins...is one of three Japanese starters to record at least 15 wins in multiple seasons (3, Hideo Nomo; 2, Daisuke Matsuzaka)...is 1-4 with a 4.55 ERA (15 er in 29.2 ip) over his last five starts...is 7-7 with a 4.29 ERA (45 er in 94.1 ip) in 16 road starts...is 4-0 with a 3.12 ERA (9 er in 26.0 ip) in four starts against Oakland this season...is 9-5 with a 3.82 ERA (39 er in 92.0 ip) in 15 career appearances, including 14 starts, against the A's.
- Norichika Aoki** (1-for-4, r, hr, rbi, 2 so) is hitting .337 (29-for-86) with 13 runs in 22 career games against Oakland...is batting .342 (13-for-38) in nine career games at the Coliseum.
- Robinson Cano** (1-for-3, r, bb, so) has reached base safely in 13 straight games...is batting .375 (18-for-48) with nine runs during this span.
- Nelson Cruz** (1-for-4, 2b, rbi, 2 so) is batting .392 (20-for-51) with six RBI against Oakland this season...has reached base safely in each of his last 12 games against the A's...is batting .374 (40-for-107) in his last 27 games against Oakland.
