Kyle Seager has hit safely in 9 straight games, batting .406 (13x32) with 9 runs, 2 doubles, 3 home runs, 7 RBI, 7 walks and 2 stolen bases...is looking for his 9th career hitting streak of 10+ games (last: 11, April 30-May 10, 2016).

TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners open a 2-city, 6-game road trip with the first of three games against Oakland (3 G)...will also play Los Angeles-AL (3 G) on the next leg of the trip...just concluded a 2-team, 7-game homestand against Los Angeles-AL (1-2) and Texas (3-1)...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners are 4-3 in their last 7 games and 4-8 in their last 12 games...are 5-10 in their last 15 games...overall have won 18 of their last 33 games and 20 of their last 37...are 26-22 in their last 48 games, 27-24 in the last 51 games and 36-31 in their last 67 games since snapping a 6-game losing streak...are 44-50 over their last 94 games since May 27 following a 26-12 stretch from April 13-May 25.

- **Buenos Diaz** - since Aug. 1, **Edwin Diaz** leads the Majors (ahead of Los Angeles - NL's Kenley Janzen) in saves with 13...during that time span, Diaz has converted 13 of 14 save opportunities (92.9%) while posting a 13.50 strikeout/9.0 innings ratio (24 K, 16.0 IP).
- **Streaking** - **Robinson Canó** has reached base safely in 12 straight games (8/27-c), batting .378 (17x45) with 8 runs, 1 double, 3 home runs and 6 RBI during this span.
- **Seager Surge** - Since Aug. 6, **Kyle Seager** is batting .368 (39x106) with 23 runs, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 7 home runs, 23 RBI, a .452 on-base percentage, a .623 slugging mark and a 1.074 OPS in 29 games.
- **Guti, Guti, Guti** - **Franklin Gutierrez** is 12-for-his-last-30 (.400) with 5 runs, 2 double, 3 home runs and 10 RBI in his last 10 games since Aug. 26.
- **Divisional Data** - Seattle is 27-33 vs. the AL West, 14-17 vs. the AL Central and 18-11 vs. AL East this season...is 13-7 vs. Interleague opponents.

FEELS LIKE HOME...Seattle is 5-1 against the Athletics at the Oakland Coliseum this season...Seattle has won 8 of the last 9 games in Oakland and are 17-6 in the last 23 games here (since May 5, 2014)...if Seattle wins 2 out of 3 this series, the 7-2 (.778) mark will be the 2nd-best single-season winning percentage in Oakland behind the 2007 club (8-1/.889) and ahead of the 2015 club (7-3/.700).

S/OAKING THE A'S...**Nelson Cruz** is hitting .404 (19x47) with 6 runs, 1 double, 3 home runs, 6 RBI, a .451 on-base mark and a .617 slugging percentage against Oakland...he's reached base safely in 11 of the 12 games this season, including the last 11 straight...in his last 26 games against the A's, he's hitting .379 (39x103) with 18 runs, 3 doubles, 8 home runs and 18 RBI.

GREEN WITH ENVY...**Norichika Aoki** is hitting .341 (28x82) with 12 runs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 8 RBI and a .382 on-base mark in 21 career games against Oakland, including .353 (12x34) in 8 games at the Coliseum...overall, he's hit safely in 19 of 20 games (with an at-bat) against Oakland.

BEAR LOOKS FOR 15...**Hisashi Iwakuma** is 1 win shy of equaling his career-high with 15 wins (also: 2014)...with his next win, he will become the 3rd Japanese-born pitcher in Major League history with multiple seasons of 15+ wins and just the 2nd to do so in the American League...Iwakuma would join Hideo Nomo, who won 16 games with Los Angeles - NL in each 1996, 2002 & 2003 and Daisuke Matsuzaka, who won 15+ games with Boston in 2007 (15) and 2008 (18).

CALIFORNIA DREAMING...Seattle is opening a 6-game swing through California with 3 games in Oakland before playing 3 in Anaheim...on the season, Seattle is 10-5 in the state of California this season (5-1 at OAK, 4-3 at LAA & 1-1 at SD).

ADAM BOMB'S RIGHTIES...**Adam Lind** has hit 19 of his 20 home runs this season against right-handed pitching...all 19 of those home runs have come since May 14th in 229 at-bats...in that span, he has averaged a home run every 12.05 at-bats against righties.

SIMPLY SILVER SLUGGER...**Kyle Seager** is among the American League leaders in several offensive categories as a 3rd baseman...among AL 3rd basemen, Seager ranks 2nd in on-base percentage (.376), T2nd in hits (151), 3rd in OPS (.906), 3rd in runs (82), T3rd in RBI (90), 3rd in slugging (.530), 4th in extra-base hits (63), 4th in total bases (271), 4th in doubles (33), 4th in batting (.295) and 5th in home runs (27).

DAE-HO HEATING UP...**Dae-Ho Lee** is hitting .448 (13x29) with 6 runs, 1 double, 1 home run, 8 RBI and a .500 on-base mark in his last 8 games (since Aug. 30)...he has recorded 5 multi-hit games in that span and has driven in runs in 5 of the 8 games.

LEFTY LANDING...**Kyle Seager** and **Dae-Ho Lee** each homered against a Rangers left-handed pitcher last night...Seattle now has 72 home runs against left-handers this season, a club record (previous: 70 in 1997)...the 72 home runs vs. lefties is the 10th-most in the Majors since 2000...during that time span, the White Sox (78 HR in 2004) and Yankees (78 HR in 2012) share the team record.

INFIELD POP...**Robinson Canó** (32 HR), **Kyle Seager** (27 HR) and **Adam Lind** (20 HR) have each hit at least 20 home runs this season...the trio of Canó, Seager and Lind are just the third infield trio in club history to post at least 20 home runs in a season...Canó, Seager and Lind join the 1999 trio of Alex Rodriguez (42 HR), David Bell (21 HR) and Russ Davis (21 HR) and the 1997 trio of Paul Sorrento (31 HR), Rodriguez (23 HR) and Davis (20 HR)...(min. 60% of total starts in the infield).

DUCKS ON THE POND...the Mariners lead the Major Leagues with 36 home runs this season with 2 or more runners on base (4 grand slams, 32 three-run home runs)...Seattle ranks ahead of Boston (31), Cincinnati (31), St. Louis (31) and Colorado (28)...the 36 home runs of 3 or more runs are the most by the Mariners since the 2000 club hit 41 such home runs and trails the club record of 53 such homers in 1996.

THE CANÓ SHOW...**Robinson Canó** ranks among the American League leaders in several defensive categories at 2nd base...Canó's leads the AL in fielding percentage with a mark of .997 (also leads MLB), while ranking 2nd in the AL in putouts (258) and 2nd in the AL in Zone Rating with a mark of .822...Zone Rating is defined by *STATS Inc.* as "an estimate of a player's efficiency in fielding balls hit into his typical defensive zone."

AS YOU KNOW...**Kyle Seager** hit his 27th home run of the season last night...**AND YOU MAY KNOW**...that he's improved his home run output in each of his first 6 seasons (3 in 2011, 20 in 2012, 22 in 2013, 25 in 2014, 26 in 2015 and now 27 in 2016)...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...that he's the first player in the Majors to do so since Matt Kemp (2006-11)?...the only other Mariners player to accomplish the feat is **Tino Martinez** (0 in 1990, 4 in 1991, 16 in 1992, 17 in 1993, 20 in 1994 & 31 in 1995).

ABOUT IWAKUMA...

- Pronounced: he-sash-ee ee-wah-ku-mah
• 35-year-old right-hander is making his 140th career appearance...
• Re-signed with Seattle as a free agent to a 2016 contract with vesting options for 2017 and 2018 on Dec. 17, 2015.
... 15 in '16? ... with a win tonight, Iwakuma would tie his career high with 15 wins in a single season...

GOOD RUN... dating back to Aug. 7, 2015, Iwakuma is 21-14 with a 3.65 ERA (100 ER, 246.1) in 39 starts... during this stretch, his 21 wins rank T5th in the Majors with Cole Hamels-TEX (21-5) and Stephen Strasburg-WAS (21-6)... trails Jake Arrieta-CHI (26-6), J.A. Happ-PIT/TOR (24-5), Rick Porcello-BOS (23-7) & David Price-TOR/BOS (23-9).

MAKING JAPAN PROUD... Iwakuma has recorded at least 14 wins in 3 of his 5 seasons with the Mariners... he is 1 of 6 Japanese pitchers to record at least 14 wins in a single season, joining Yu Darvish (1x), Kazuhisa Ishii (1x), Hiroki Kuroda (1x), Daisuke Matsuzaka (2x) and Hideo Nomo (4x)... and only 1 of 3 Japanese pitchers to record multi seasons with at least 14 wins, trailing only Nomo (4x) and ahead of Matsuzaka (2x)...

STREAKER... had a 5-game winning streak June 28-July 23 vs. PIT, vs. BAL, at KC, vs. HOU & at TOR... it was the second time in his career that he has won five straight starts (also: Aug. 8-Sept 5, 2014)... won a career-best 7 straight starts Aug. 16, 2013-May 20, 2014.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY... since 2013, Iwakuma ranks 11th in the American League with 68 quality starts... teammate Felix Hernandez ranks 4th during that time span with 80 quality starts... Chris Sale leads the AL during that span with 87 quality starts... Iwakuma has posted 16 quality starts this season, including 13 of his last 20 starts, dating back to May 20... his 16 quality starts this season are the 2nd-most in his career, trailing 23 quality starts in 2013 and 17 quality starts in 2014 (had 12 QS in 2015).

JUST GET HIM THREE... owns a career record of 52-7 in 75 career starts when receiving at least 3 runs of support... the Mariners have given Iwakuma 2 or fewer runs of support in 15 of his 28 starts this season (he's 2-11 in those games with 3 NDs)... is undefeated in 21 career starts when receiving 6 or more runs of support (including a 6-0 mark this season) posting a record of 20-0.

PITCHING WITH SUPPORT... in 173.0 IP over 28 starts this season, Kuma has received 109 runs of support... Iwakuma's 5.67 run support average is 10th-highest in the AL, but he's received 2 or fewer runs of support in 15 of his 28 starts this season... since July 29 has received only 13 runs of support over his last 8 starts, including 1 run or less in 4 starts... during this stretch has the 3rd-lowest runs support average in the American League, trailing only Ricky Nolasco-MIN/LAA (2.33) and Marcus Stroman-TOR (2.53).

AS A STARTER... since making his first MLB start 7/2/12 has gone 60-35 with a 3.29 ERA (291 ER, 796.1 IP) in 125 starts... since his first MLB start, Iwakuma's ERA is 7th-best in the American League (min. 75 GS), with rotation-mate Felix Hernandez holding the 2nd spot with a 3.01 mark.

2016 FIRST HALF RECAP...

- Rotation Rock - Only member of the Mariners Opening Day rotation to make every scheduled start.
• Cloud Nine - Won 9 games in the first half, the most he's won before the All-Star Break (8 in 2013 & 2014).
• Inning Eater - Tossed 114.1 innings in the first half, led the Mariners and it was T11th-most in the American League.

30-year-old right-hander will make his 21st start of the season tomorrow vs. the Athletics... W#10 in last start on 9/5 vs. TEX (5.2,6,6,6,4,3,2HR)... W#7 Aug. 15 at LAA (6.2,4,2,2,4,8,HR); his 150th career win... is 6-1 with a 4.62 ERA (33 ER, 64.1 IP) in 10 starts since returning from the DL on July 20... on 15-day DL (right calf strain), June 1-July 20; was 1-0 with a 3.86 ERA (4 ER, 9.1 IP) with 13 strikeouts and 3 walks over 2 rehab starts with short-A Everett and AAA Tacoma... win #146 on May 9 vs. TB (7.0,4,2,2,2,4,2HR,2HB); becoming the Mariners franchise leader... Career: 153-106 with 3.15 ERA (836 ER, 2389.2 IP) and 2,249 strikeouts in 354 career starts... is the Mariners all-time leader in wins, strikeouts, starts and innings pitched... in his 12th Major League season (debuted 8/4/05)... vs. OAK: is 22-8 with a 2.67 ERA (86 ER, 290.1 IP) with 273 strikeouts and 72 walks in 42 career starts vs. the A's, including going 11-3 with a 2.83 ERA (50 ER, 159.0 IP) in 23 starts at Oakland... since 2013, is 9-2 with a 2.43 ERA (30 ER, 111.1 IP) in 16 starts vs. OAK (18 BB, 102 K, 14 QS).
