OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have lost two straight and are 13-26 (.333) over the last 39 games...are a season-high tying 21 games under .500 at 60-81 (.426), which matches the A's record after 141 games last year...fell to 33-41 (.446) at home, which clinches a losing home record for the secon consecutive season (34-47 in 2015)...it is the first time they have finished with a losing record at home in consecutive years since 1996-98 when they did it three straight years...it is the fourth time in Oakland history it has happened (1977-79, 1993-94)...trail the Mariners in the season series 5-9, including a 1-7 mark in Oakland...have lost 11 of the last 12 games in Oakland against Seattle...are 49-60 against the Mariners over the last six years...are 3-5 on their nine-game homestand against Boston (1-2), Los Angeles-AL (2-1) and Seattle (0-2).
- The A's are batting .198 (89-for-450) with 39 runs scored over the last 14 games (2.79 runs per game)...have allowed three runs or fewer four times and 10 runs or more four times through eight games on this homestand...A's starting pitchers are 9-16 with a 4.08 ERA (80 er in 176.1 ip) over the last 32 games.
- Kendall Graveman is 2-2 with a 3.18 ERA (12 er in 34.0 ip) over his last five starts...is 5-4 with a 3.80 ERA (31 er in 73.1 ip) in 11 starts since the All-Star Break...is 9-4 with a 3.64 ERA (49 er in 121.0 ip) over his last 19 starts...is 5-5 with a 3.35 ERA (31 er in 83.1 ip) in 13 home starts...is 0-3 with a 7.48 ERA (18 er in 21.2 ip) in four starts against the Mariners this season...is 1-3 with a 5.40 ERA (19 er in 31.2 ip) in seven career appearances, including five starts, against Seattle...allowed two runs in the first inning, snapping a streak of 18 consecutive games without allowing a run in the first inning (since May 24).
- Ryon Healy (3-for-4, 2 r, hr, 2 rbi, gidp) is batting .355 (33-for-93) over his last 24 games...recorded his second three-hit and 14th multi-hit game this year.
- Bruce Maxwell (2-for-4) is 9-for-22 (.409) over his last eight games...recorded his second straight multi-hit game (also second of career).
- Stephen Vogt (1-for-3) snapped an 0-for-18 hitless streak, which matched his longest hitless streak of the season.
- Joey Wendle (1-for-5, rbi) has hit safely in five straight games (6-for-18, .333).

SEATTLE NOTES

- The **Seattle Mariners** have won four consecutive and five of their last six games...improved to 34-37 (.479) on the road and 23-23 (.500) during the day...are now 25-21 (.543) in the second game of a series and 29-33 (.468) against AL West competition...are 7-1 against the A's at the Coliseum this season...have won 11 of the last 12 games in Oakland and are 19-6 in their last 25 games at the Coliseum...lead the season series against the A's 9-5...are 2-0 on this six-game road trip to Oakland (2-0) and Los Angeles-AL (three games).
- Felix Hernandez is 4-1 with a 4.35 ERA (15 er in 31.0 ip) over his last five starts...is 7-1 with a 4.22 ERA (33 er in 70.1 ip) over his last 11 starts since returning from the DL on July 20...is 4-3 with a 4.06 ERA (26 er in 57.2 ip) in 10 starts during the day...is 1-0 with a 2.12 ERA (4 er in 17.0 ip) in three starts against Oakland this season...is 23-8 with a 2.61 ERA (86 er in 296.1 ip) in 43 career starts against the A's...is 12-3 with a 2.73 ERA (50 er in 165.0 ip) in 24 career starts at the Coliseum...his 12 wins at the Coliseum tie him with Tommy John for most career wins by a visiting player in Oakland.
- Norichika Aoki (3-for-5, 3 r, 2 2b, 2 rbi, bb) is hitting .352 (32-for-91) with 16 runs in 23 career games against Oakland...is batting .372 (16-for-43) in 10 career games at the Coliseum.
- Robinson Cano (0-for-3, r, bb, gidp) has reached base safely in 14 straight games...is batting .353 (18-for-51) with 10 runs during this span.
- Nelson Cruz (3-for-4, 2 r, 2 2b, 3 rbi, so) is batting .418 (23-for-55) with nine RBI against Oakland this season...has reached base safely in each of his last 13 games against the A's...is batting .387 (43-for-111) in his last 28 games against Oakland...collected his third game with two doubles this season (last: June 30 vs. Baltimore)...recorded his 43rd multi-hit and eighth three-hit game this year.
