OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** fell to 60-82 (.423) with the loss today and are now a season-high 22 games under .500 (previous: 21 games, three times)...have clinched a losing record for the second consecutive season (went 68-94 last year), marking the first time the A's have finished with a losing record in back-to-back seasons since they had three straight from 2007-09...went 3-6 on this nine-game homestand against Boston (1-2), Los Angeles-AL (2-1) and Seattle (0-3)...leave following the game today for a seven-game road trip to Kansas City (four games) and Texas (three games).
- Raul Alcantara was recalled from Triple-A Nashville Monday and is 0-1 with a 7.27 ERA (7 er in 8.2 ip) in two starts since then.
- Ryan Madson had his 12-game, 13.2-inning scoreless streak snapped (dating back to Aug. 4).
- Khris Davis (1-for-4, r) singled in the first inning to snap a 0 for 15 streak, which was three short of the longest hitless streak of his career (0-for-18, April 29-May 7, 2015).
- Ryon Healy (1-for-4, r, so) is batting .355 (33-for-93) over his last 25 games after hitting .223 over his first 27 contests.
- Stephen Vogt (2-for-4) is 3-for-7 (.429) over his last two games to snap a season-high tying 0-for-18 streak.

SEATTLE NOTES

- The **Seattle Mariners** have a five-game winning streak, which is one short of matching their season high of six (Aug. 5-10)...are 3-0 on this six-game road trip to Oakland (3-0) and Los Angeles (three games).
- James Paxton is 2-0 with a 3.55 ERA (10 er in 25.1 ip) in four starts during the day, 2-6 with a 4.11 ERA (35 er in 76.2 ip) in 13 starts at night.
- Edwin Diaz recorded his 15th save and is the fifth rookie in Mariners history to record 15 or more saves (Sasaki, 37 in 2000; Farquhar, 16 in 2013; Romo, 16 in 1977; Schooler, 15 in 1988).
- Norichika Aoki (1-for-4) is a .347 (33-for-95) career hitter against the A's, which is the second best mark against Oakland (min. 100 PA) among active players (V. Martinez, DET .356).
- Robinson Cano (0-for-5, so) had his streak of reaching base in 14 consecutive games snapped...batted .353 during the streak, which began Aug. 27.
- Nelson Cruz (2-for-4, so) has reached base safely in 14 of his 15 games against the A's this year, including each of the last 14, and is batting .424 (25-for-59) with eight runs, four doubles, three home runs and 10 RBI.
- Ketel Marte (3-for-3, rbi, hbp) hit a go-ahead RBI single in the ninth inning...recorded his seventh game of three or more hits this year.
- Mike Zunino (2-for-4, r, 2b, hr, 2 rbi, so) is 6-for-23 (.261) with two home runs and four RBI in seven games in the month of September.
