OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** had their two-game winning streak snapped, but have still won six of the last eight games...have a four-game home losing streak and are now 33-43 (.434) at home for the season...dropped to 46-48 (.489) in games decided by three runs or fewer...fell to 44-51 (.463) at night and 26-38 (.406) against AL West competition...trail the Astros in the season series 6-11 with two games remaining...have a five-game losing streak against Houston, which is their longest such streak against the Astros...are 0-1 on this six-game homestand against Houston (0-1) and Texas (three games).
- The A's have hit 16 home runs over the last eight games...A's starting pitchers are 4-0 with a 2.36 ERA (9 er in 34.1 ip) over the last six games...are now 9-7 with a 3.42 ERA (53 er in 139.1 ip) over the last 26 games.
- Jharel Cotton is 1-0 with a 1.50 ERA (3 er in 18.0 ip) in three career starts...struck out a career-high six batters while allowing a career-low zero walks...is the fifth
 Oakland pitcher to allow no more than one earned run in each of his first three career starts (also: Alan Wirth, Mike Norris, John Henry Johnson and Rich Harden).
- Khris Davis (0-for-4, so) had his eight game hitting streak snapped...was 11-for-29 (.379) over that span.
- Ryon Healy (1-for-4, r, hr, rbi) has hit safely in each of his last 10 games and is 19-for-42 (.452) with four home runs and 10 RBI over that span...is batting .382 (26-for-68) in September.
- Bruce Maxwell (1-for-3, r, hr, rbi, so) hit his first Major League home run with a solo shot to left field in the second inning...is batting .419 (13-for-31) with eight RBI over his last nine games.

HOUSTON NOTES

- The **Houston Astros** have won four of their last five games...are now 36-28 (.563) against AL West competition...improved to 38-38 (.500) on the road and 52-48 (.520) at night...have a five-game winning streak against the A's and are 29-21 against Oakland in the last 50 games dating back to April 26, 2014...lead the season series against Oakland 11-6 with two games remaining...are 3-1 on this six-game road trip to Seattle (2-1) and Oakland (1-0).
- Brad Peacock is 0-0 with a 2.86 ERA (7 er in 22.0 ip) in eight appearances, including three starts, this season...is 1-4 with a 4.79 ERA (25 er in 47.0 ip) in 10 career appearances, including nine starts, against the A's...has allowed three earned runs or less in each of his last 10 starts dating back to 2014, which is a career-long streak...is 1-2 with a 2.54 ERA (14 er in 49.2 ip) over that span.
- Carlos Correa (2-for-4, r) is hitting .310 (22-for-71) over his last 20 games.
- Evan Gattis (1-for-3, r, hr, rbi, ibb, 2 so) hit his team-high tying and career-high 28th home run of the year...the 28 homers top his previous career-high of 27 set last season...is batting .297 (44-for-148) with 11 home runs and 22 RBI over his last 43 games since July 31.
- Marwin Gonzalez (1-for-4, 2 rbi) snapped an 0-for-12 hitless streak with a go-ahead two-RBI single in the ninth inning.
- Tyler White (1-for-1, 2b, rbi) hit his third pinch-hit double of the season...is 4-for-11 (.364) with three RBI in the pinch this year...has tied a club record for most pinch-hit doubles by a rookie (also: Russ Johnson, 1999).
