THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY:

SEPT. 19

1971 - Joe Morgan hits an 11th-inning, walkoff homer off Clay Carroll on his 28th birthday in a 5-4 Astros win over the Reds... Morgan was traded to the Reds the next season and spent 8 total years with the club... Morgan is still the only player in club history to hit a walkoff homer on his birthday.

TODAY'S MEDIA AVAILABILITY

The Astros clubhouse will be open from 4:00-4:50 p.m...manager A.J. Hinch will be available in the Astros dugout at approx. 4:50 p.m.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros, winners of 3 of their last 4 games, begin the final leg of their 6-game road trip to Seattle (2-1) and Oakland (3g) tonight with the 1st of 3 games against the A's...RHP Brad Peacock (0-0) will get the start for Houston opposite his former organization and A's rookie RHP Jharel Cotton (1-0).

PEACOCK IN FLIGHT: RHP Brad Peacock is making his 3rd start of the season and is fresh off an outing where he limited the Rangers to 1 run on 3 hits in 6.0 innings, striking out 5 and walking 2 on Tuesday in Houston (3-2 loss)...Peacock has allowed 3 earned runs or less in each of his last 9 Major League starts dating back to 2014 (career-long streak).

DIVISION FOES: The Astros are facing AL West opponents in their final 19 games of the season, a stretch that began on Monday against the Rangers (1-2) and continued this weekend in Seattle (2-1)...the Astros will face the Mariners (3g), A's (3g) and Angels (7g) to finish their campaign, a trio that the Astros have combined to go 31-13 (.705) against this season.

STRAIGHT A'S: The Astros enter tonight's game having won their last 4 games vs. the A's...in their last matchup (Aug. 29-31 in Houston), the Astros completed a 3-game sweep.

VS. OAKLAND: The Astros have gone 28-21 against the A's since April 26, 2014, which includes season series victories over Oakland in 2015 (10-9) and 2016 (10-6 thus far with 3 to play)...Houston's 28-21 record in their last 49 games opposite Oakland represents a stark difference from their 1st 30 matchups, with the Astros going just 5-25 in those contests.

TOUGH DRAW: On Wednesday, the Astros concluded a stretch of playing 13 consecutive games against 1st place opponents, which included road series at Texas (1-2) and at Cleveland (2-2), and home series with the Cubs (1-2) and Rangers (1-2).

ABOUT YESTERDAY: The Astros could not complete the series sweep over the Mariners yesterday at Safeco Field, falling 7-3...SS Carlos Correa (2x4) hit his 20th homer, reaching that mark for the 2nd consecutive season...RF George Springer (1x3) also homered and now leads the club with 28...RHP Doug Fister (7ER/3.2IP) suffered the loss as Houston was stymied by rookie LHP Ariel Miranda (2ER/7IP).

THE PRODIGY: Yesterday, Carlos Correa joined Alex Rodriguez as the only shortstops in Major League history to hit 20 homers twice through their age-21 seasons (ESPN Stats & Info):

TOSSING ZEROS: On Friday and Saturday, the Astros received consecutive scoreless outings of at least 6.0 innings pitched from their starting pitchers for the 1st time since Aug. 24-25, 2015 at NYY...Mike Fiers went 6.0 scoreless for the win Saturday, while Collin McHugh went 7.0 scoreless on Friday.

IN THE STANDINGS: There are 6 teams within 4.0 games of the 2 AL Wild Card Spots, with the Astros entering tonight's game 3.0 games back of Toronto.

BRINGIN' THE HITS: With a Major League leading 198 hits, 2B Jose Altuve needs 2 more to reach 200 for the 3rd consecutive season...last player with 3 consecutive 200-hit seasons: Ichiro Suzuki, 10 straight from 2001-10...last right-handed hitter with 3 straight: Michael Young, 5 straight 200-hit seasons (2003-07).

YEAR OF THE WHIFF: With 6 strikeouts yesterday, the Astros pitching staff established a new club record for strikeouts in a season (1,284)...the Astros rank 3rd in the AL in strikeouts, while the bullpen leads the AL with 562, also a club record...Collin McHugh leads the club (161 K's), and Michael Feliz (93) and Ken Giles (92) rank 3rd and 4th among AL relievers, respectively.

MVP CALIBER: Jose Altuve leads the AL in average (.337) and in hits (198), ranks T-2nd in doubles (40), T-3rd in steals (27), 3rd in WAR (7.7), 4th in OBP (.397), 4th in total bases (320) and 4th in OPS (.942).

OUT WEST: Houston has fared well on the road over the last 3 months, posting a 24-17 road record dating back to June 14 (tops in MLB in that span).

FLYING HIGH: Jose Altuve has hit .378 (111x294) with a 1.011 OPS (.443 OBP/.568 SLG) on the road this year...the last Major League players with road batting averages this high in a single season: Ichiro Suzuki (.405 in 2004) and Barry Bonds (.386 in 2002).

TALE OF TWO SEASONS: The Astros are 61-43 (.587) since May 23, which has come after the club bottomed out with a 17-28 record after a loss on May 22...it's been an uphill battle for the Astros all season, as the club started 7-17 in April and has since recovered to go 71-54 (.568) in 125 games since.

MAN OF THE YEAR: Lance McCullers has been selected by the fans as 1 of 6 division winners for the 2016 Marvin Miller Man of the Year award...McCullers and his wife, Kara, share a passion for pet rescue, founded the Lance McCullers Jr. Foundation, and have supported shelters and programs that promote pet adoption and work to make Houston a no-kill city.

LAST START - 9/13 VS. TEX: pitched well in what was his 2nd Major League start of the season, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing 1 run on 3 hits in 6.0 innings...left the game carrying a 2-1 lead, which ended as a 3-2 Rangers win last Tuesday in Houston.

ABOUT PEACOCK: 28-year-old is set to make his 3rd Major League start of 2016 and his 8th overall appearance...is in his 3rd stint with Houston after his most recent recall on 9/2...was also with the club from 8/3-5 and 8/19-29.

- has made 43 starts in his Major League career, going 11-15 with a 4.36 ERA (108ER/223IP) and 195 strikeouts.
- has appeared in the Majors with Houston in every season since 2013...made his MLB debut in 2011 with Washington.
- was acquired from the A's along with **C Max Stassi** and **IF Chris Carter** in exchange for **IF Jed Lowrie** and **RHP Fernando Rodriguez** on 2/4/13.

SOLID RUN: has allowed 3 earned runs or less in each of his last 9 starts in the Major Leagues dating back to 2014...this is a career-long streak...has gone 1-2 with a 2.44 ERA (12ER/44.1IP) and 40 strikeouts in that span, with Houston going 4-5 in those games.

VS OAK: is starting against his former club for the 8th time in his career tonight...faced Oakland once this season, on 8/29 in Houston, and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in relief in the Astros 6-0 win.

FORMER A'S: was acquired by Houston from Oakland along with **IF Chris Carter** and **C Max Stassi** on Feb. 2 in exchange for **IF Jed Lowrie** and **RHP Fernando Rodriguez**...was the top pitching prospect in the A's minor league system at the time of the trade, according to *Baseball America*.

IN THE PEN: his 1st 5 appearances with Houston this season came out of the bullpen...posted a 3.86 ERA (3ER/7IP) while recording 7 strikeouts and 3 walks in his 7.0 innings.

GET RIGHT: right-handed hitters have gone 4x29 (.138) with 7 strikeouts against him this season...has also had strong career success against righties, as he's limited them to a .218 (86x395) opponent average.

AT TRIPLE A: went 5-6 with a 4.23 ERA (55ER/117IP), 119 strikeouts and 40 walks in 22 games (21 starts) at Triple A Fresno this season.

- over his last 11 starts at the level, went 5-4 with a 2.91 ERA (21ER/65IP), 62 strikeouts and 15 walks.

HIS JOURNEY BACK: pitched with the Astros Major League club for most of the 2013-14 seasons before missing nearly the entire 2015 season with various injuries, including recovery from right hip surgery and a left intercostal strain...made just 1 Major League start in 2015 and pitched a combined total of 11.2 innings in regular season action.

CAREER RECAP: was once a top prospect while pitching in the Nationals system, ranking as high as the No. 36 prospect in all of baseball after the 2011 season by *Baseball America*...since then he's been traded twice, to Oakland in the **Gio Gonzalez** deal, and to Houston as part of the **Jed Lowrie** swap...was with the Astros for their rebuilding seasons of 2013-14 before being sidelined with injuries for all but 1 Major League start in 2015...has had a productive and healthy 2016 campaign and worked his way back to the Major League roster by posting solid numbers as a starter at Triple A.

LAST START - 9/14 VS. TEX: gave the Astros a much-needed quality start in the club's 8-4 win over the Rangers last Wednesday in Houston...tossed 6.1 innings, allowing 3 runs on 5 hits, while fanning 7 and allowing 2 walks...earned his 3rd career victory.

WHAT TO KNOW ABOUT JOE: 23-year-old rookie is set to make his 10th career Major League appearance, and 9th career start tomorrow.

- was recalled from Triple A on 8/1 for his 1st career stint in the Major Leagues...at the time of his promotion, was ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 3 prospect in Houston's system, and the No. 32 overall prospect in baseball.

HOMEBOY: has had most of his success at home thus far in his short Major League career...has given up just 6 runs in 29 innings (1.86 ERA) at the venue between 5 appearances (4 starts)...owns a 8.71 ERA (20ER/20.2IP) on the road.

VS. OAK: faced the A's once since his recall, earning the win on 8/29 in Houston after tossing 5.1 scoreless innings, while allowing just 3 hits and 3 walks with 7 strikeouts
