#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The **Oakland A's** played the game under protest...have lost two straight and three of their last five games...have a five-game home losing streak and are 33-44 (.429) at home for the season...dropped to 5-5 (.500) in extra innings and 23-25 (.479) in one-run games...are now 46-49 (.484) in games decided by three runs or fewer...fell to 44-52 (.458) at night and 26-39 (.400) against AL West competition...have lost the season series with the Astros 6-12 with one game remaining... have a six-game losing streak against Houston, which is their longest ever against the Astros...are 0-2 on this six-game homestand against Houston (0-2) and Texas (three games).
- A's starting pitchers are 4-0 with a 2.01 ERA (9 er in 40.1 ip) over the last seven games...are now 8-7 with a 3.28 ERA (53 er in 145.1 ip) over the last 27 games...Danny Valencia (0-for-4, 2 so) was ejected at the end of the ninth inning for arguing balls and strikes.
- Sean Manaea is 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 er in 11.0 ip) in two starts after missing 15 days with a strained left rhomboid...is 4-5 with a 2.84 ERA (26 er in 82.1 ip) in 14 games, including 13 starts, since he was reinstated from the disabled list June 29...is 5-3 with a 3.02 ERA (28 er in 83.1 ip) in 14 games at home...is 0-1 with a 1.69 ERA (4 er in 21.1 ip) in four career starts against Houston, all this season.
- Ryon Healy (0-for-4, 2 so) had his 10-game hitting streak snapped...was batting 19-for-42 (.452) with four home runs and 10 RBI over that span.
- · Jake Smolinski (1-for-4, r, so) broke up a no-hit bid with a single in the sixth inning...is batting .291 (44-for-151) at home.
- Joey Wendle (1-for-4, bb, so) is 12-for-36 (.333) over his last eight games...is batting 15-for-41 (.366) in nine games from the leadoff spot.

#### **HOUSTON NOTES**

- The **Houston** Astros have won five of their last six games...improved to 39-38 (.506) on the road and 53-48 (.525) at night...are now 37-28 (.569) against AL West competition...have a six-game winning streak against the A's and are 30-21 against Oakland in the last 51 games dating back to April 26, 2014...won the season series against Oakland 12-6 with one game remaining...are 4-1 on this six-game road trip to Seattle (2-1) and Oakland (2-0).
- Joe Musgrove is 2-2 with a 3.62 ERA (11 er in 27.1 ip) over his last five starts...is 3-3 with a 4.33 ERA (21 er in 43.2 ip) in eight games, including seven starts, at night...is 1-3 with a 7.27 ERA (21 er in 26.0 ip) in five road starts...is 1-0 with a 0.84 ERA (1 er in 10.2 ip) in two career starts against Oakland...had his scoreless inning streak against Oakland snapped at 10.1 innings after giving up a run in the sixth inning.
- · Ken Giles is the sixth pitcher in club history to record a save on his birthday, and the first since Ken Forsch did so on Sept. 8, 1974 vs. SD.
- Jose Altuve (1-for-5) recorded his 200th hit of the season...he is the first player with three consecutive 200 hit seasons since Ichiro Suzuki had 10 straight from 2001-10...is the first right-handed hitter with three straight 200 hit seasons since Michael Young had five consecutive from 2003-07 and Derek Jeter did so from 2005-07...is batting .373 (113-for-303) on the road this season.
- Evan Gattis (1-for-4, so) is batting .298 (45-for-151) with 11 home runs and 22 RBI over his last 44 games since July 31.
- Marwin Gonzalez (1-for-3, r, bb) is hitting .266 (21-for-79) over his last 23 games.
- Tony Kemp (2-for-2, r, 2 2b, rbi) drove in the tying run in the seventh inning with a pinch-hit double...had his first career two-double game.
