OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have lost three straight after winning six of their previous seven contests...have a season-high six-game home losing streak and are now 33-45 at the Coliseum for the season...fell to 26-40 against AL West competition...lost the season series against the Astros for the second consecutive season, as they finished 6-13 this year...have a seven-game losing streak against Houston, which extends their longest ever against the Astros...are 0-3 on this six-game homestand against Houston (0-3) and Texas (three games).
- Daniel Mengden was charged with his seventh home loss in eight career starts at the Coliseum after allowing four earned runs in 5.2 innings... is now 2-8 with a 5.74 ERA (44 er in 69 ip) and has not won back-to-back decisions since being selected from Triple-A Nashville June 11.
- Yonder Alonso (1-for-4, 2b) is 14-for-42 (.333) over his last 14 games after going 2-for-21 (.095) over his previous eight...extended his team lead in doubles to 30 on the season.
- Brett Eibner (1-for-4, 2b, rbi) has hit safely in back-to-back games and is batting .250 (10-for-40) with seven RBI over his last 12 games after going 7-for-47 (.149) with four RBI over his first 24 contest with the A's.
- Bruce Maxwell (1-for-4, 2b, rbi, 2 so) is 14-for-36 (.389) over his last 12 games after going 4-for-32 (.125) over his first 13 contests.
- Stephen Vogt (1-for-4, rbi, bb, roe, so) snapped an 0-for-13 slump in his first at-bat...is batting .199 (35-for-176) over his last 50 games but is hitting .348 (23-for-66) in 17 games against Houston.

HOUSTON NOTES

- The Houston Astros have won six of their last seven games...improved to 40-38 on the road and 28-23 during day games...are now 38-28 against AL West competition...have a seven-game winning streak against the A's and are 31-21 against Oakland in the last 52 games dating back to April 26, 2014...took the season series for the second consecutive year against Oakland with a 13-6 mark...concluded their six-game road trip at 5-1 against Seattle (2-1) and Oakland (3-0) and now return home to begin a seven-game homestand.
- Collin McHugh allowed two earned runs over 5.2 innings of work to record his fifth consecutive win (one shy of tying his career-high set in 2015)...improved his record to 12-10 with a 4.61 ERA (87 er in 170 ip)...Houston has won seven straight games with him on the mound.
- Carlos Correa (2-for-4, 2b, r, rbi) finished the current road trip hitting .348 (8-for-23) and went 4-for-11 in the series against Oakland.
- Evan Gattis (2-for-4, 2 hr, 2 r, 3 rbi, so) hit a pair of home runs to pass George Springer for the team lead in homers with 30...
- Jake Marisnick (0-for-4, rbi, so) is 0 for his last 17 at-bats and went 2-for-17 (.118) on the current road trip.
