THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY:

SEPT. 21

2002 - RHP Wade Miller goes 8.0 innings, allowing 2 runs in a 6-3 Astros win over the Cardinals in St. Louis en route to his 12th consecutive winning decision, which tied a franchise record...RHP Mark Portugal also had a 12-game winning streak from July 11-Oct. 2, 1993.

TODAY'S MEDIA AVAILABILITY

The Astros clubhouse will be open from 10:00-10:50 a.m....manager **A.J. Hinch** will be available in the Astros dugout at approx. 10:50 a.m.

TODAY'S GAME: Winners of 5 of their last 6 games, the Astros conclude their 6-game road trip to Seattle (2-1) and Oakland (2-0) today with the series finale against the A's...RHP Collin McHugh (11-10) will start for the Astros in their attempt to sweep the A's for the 2nd consecutive series, while Oakland will counter with former Astros farmhand RHP Daniel Mengden (2-7).

MR. SEPTEMBER: RHP Collin McHugh is 2-0 with a 3.31 ERA this month, and has gone undefeated in 12 September starts as an Astro (since 2014), posting a 10-0 record and a 3.08 ERA...his 10 September wins since 2014 rank 2nd in the AL behind LHP David Price (11-2)...in 2014, McHugh was the September AL Rookie of the Month (4-0, 1.59 ERA).

STRAIGHT A'S: The Astros have won their last 6 games vs. the A's, which includes a 3-game sweep in Houston from Aug. 29-31...this marks Houston's longest winning streak against the A's in club history.

DIVISION FOES: The Astros are facing AL West opponents in their final 19 games of the year, a stretch that began on Monday against TEX (1-2) and has continued this road trip to SEA (2-1) and OAK (2-0)...the Astros will face the A's (1g), Angels (7g) and Mariners (3g) to finish their campaign, a trio that the Astros have combined to go 33-13 (.717) against this season.

VS. OAKLAND: The Astros have gone 30-21 against the A's since April 26, 2014, which includes season series victories over Oakland in 2015 (10-9) and 2016 (12-6 thus far with 1 to play)...Houston's 30-21 record in its last 51 games opposite Oakland represents a stark difference from the 1st 30 matchups, with the Astros going just 5-25 in those contests.

LAST NIGHT'S WIN: The Astros executed their 3rd consecutive comeback victory against the A's with a 2-1 win in 10 innings...RHP Joe Musgrove (1ER/5.1IP) carried a no-hitter into the 6th inning before giving way to RHP Chris Devenski (0ER/3.2IP), who got the win after retiring all 11 batters he faced...the Astros got a game-tying, pinch-hit double from a rookie for the 2nd-consecutive night, this time from PH-LF Tony Kemp (2x2)...Kemp also scored the winning run on a RF George Springer (2x5) RBI-single in the 10th.

KENNY G'S DAY: Ken Giles recorded his 13th save of the season last night on his 26th birthday...Giles became the 6th player in Astros history to record a save on his birthday, and the 1st since RHP Ken Forsch did so on his 28th birthday on Sept. 8, 1974 vs. SD.

EXTRA EXTRA!: Last night was Houston's AL-leading 17th extra-inning contest of the season...ties for the 2nd-most extra-inning games in the Majors with San Francisco, behind only Atlanta (22).

TALE OF TWO SEASONS: The Astros are 63-43 (.594) since May 23, which has come after the club bottomed out with a 17-28 record after a loss on May 22...it's been an uphill battle for the Astros all season, as the club started 7-17 in April and has since recovered to go 73-54 (.575) in 127 games since.

IN THE STANDINGS: There are 6 teams within 3.5 games of the 2 AL Wild Card Spots, with the Astros entering today 2.0 games back of Baltimore for the 2nd Wild Card spot.

BRINGIN' THE HITS: Last night, Jose Altuve reached 200 hits for the 3rd consecutive season, becoming the 1st player with 3 consecutive 200-hit seasons since Ichiro Suzuki had 10 straight from 2001-10...the last right-handed hitters to record 3 straight: Michael Young (5 straight from 2003-07) and Derek Jeter (3 straight from 2005-07).

MORE 200 HITS: Prior to Jose Altuve, there had only been one 200-hit season in club history, accomplished by Craig Biggio (210) in 1998...Altuve is the fifth 2nd baseman in MLB history to record three 200-hit seasons, with the other 4 being Hall of Famers:

OUT WEST: Houston has fared well on the road over the last 3 months, posting a 26-17 road record dating back to June 14 (tops in MLB in that span)...on the season, Houston ranks 2nd in the AL in runs per game on the road (4.92) behind Boston (5.10).

MVP CALIBER: Jose Altuve leads the AL in average (.337) and ranks 2nd in hits (200), T-2nd in doubles (40), T-3rd in steals (27), 3rd in WAR (7.6), 4th in OBP (.395), 4th in total bases (322) and 6th in OPS (.935).

THE PRODIGY: On Sunday, Carlos Correa joined Alex Rodriguez as the only shortstops in Major League history to hit 20 homers twice through their age-21 seasons (ESPN Stats & Info).

YEAR OF THE WHIFF: The Astros pitching staff has set a club record for strikeouts in a season (1,298)...the Astros rank 3rd in the AL in strikeouts, while the bullpen leads the AL with 570, also a club record.

HEART OF A DRAGON: Chris Devenski's 1.35 ERA out of the bullpen is the lowest single-season ERA by a reliever in club history...last night was his 2nd perfect appearance of at least 3.2 innings this season, as he also threw 4.1 perfect innings on Aug. 1 vs. TOR...only 2 other Major League relievers since 1913 had 2 perfect outings of at least 3.2 innings in a single year: RHP Mike Bacsik (1979) and RHP Neil Allen (1984).

LAST START - 9/16 AT SEA: stretched his winning streak to 4 games and earned his 11th win of the season by tossing 7.0 scoreless frames while allowing just 2 hits and 2 walks with 6 strikeouts on Friday at SEA... the Astros won that game 6-0 at Safeco.

- with the win, McHugh improved his record to 4-0 with a 1.08 ERA (3ER/25IP) against the Mariners this season...is now 9-3 with a 3.96 ERA (32ER/72.2IP) in 12 career starts against Seattle...his 9 victories against the Mariners are an Astros franchise high.

ABOUT MCHUGH: 29-year-old right-hander is set to make his 31st start of the season, and his 16th on the road.

- enters today's game with a 4-game winning streak, his season long, and his longest since ending the 2015 season with a 6-game streak...the club has won 6 straight games with him on the mound.

- since joining Houston in 2014 after being claimed off waivers, has gone 41-26 with a 3.79 ERA (220ER/522.2IP) in 87 starts.

- has reached 11 wins in each of the last 3 seasons...the last Astros pitcher to win 11+ games in 3 consecutive seasons was **LHP Wandy Rodriguez** from 2009-11.

MR. SEPTEMBER: has gone 2-0 with a 3.31 ERA (6ER/16.1IP) this month, and has gone undefeated in 12 September starts as an Astro (since 2014), posting a 10-0 record and a 3.08 ERA (26ER/76IP)...his 10 September wins in that span rank 2nd in the AL behind **LHP David Price** (11-2).

FEEL THE BREEZE: dating back to May 19, he ranks 6th in the AL in strikeouts per 9.0 innings (9.51) and 10th in strikeouts (131)...has recorded those 131 strikeouts in 124.0 innings and 22 starts, in which the club has gone 15-7.

- has thrown his curveball 29.2% of the time, which is the 2nd-highest percentage among starters in the Majors this season, trailing only **Drew Pomeranz** (39.3%), per FanGraphs.com.

YOU PLAY TO WIN THE GAME: ranks T-5th in the AL in wins (41) since 2014...since Aug. 1, 2014, ranks 4th in the Majors, trailing only **RHP Jake Arrieta** (43), **LHP Madison Bumgarner** (38) and **LHP David Price** (38).

VS. OAK: is set to face the Athletics for the 9th time in his career and the 4th time this season...owns a 5-1 record with a 3.00 ERA (17ER/51IP) with 52 strikeouts in his 8 career starts against the A's...his 5 wins opposite Oakland lead all Astros pitchers in franchise history...the Astros have won 7 of McHugh's 8 career starts vs. OAK, including 5 straight.

- has faced the A's 3 times this season and earned his lone victory in his last start on 8/30 in Houston...tossed 6.0 scoreless innings in that outing, allowing just 4 hits and 1 walk with 5 strikeouts in the Astros 3-1 win.

- went 1x5 last night at OAK...was his 200th hit this season...has reached the 200-hit plateau for the 3rd straight season...other than Altuve, only **Craig Biggio** (210 hits in 1998) has recorded 200+ hits in a single season in franchise history...the last player with 3 consecutive 200-hit seasons was **Ichiro Suzuki** (2001-10)...the last right-handed hitter with 3 straight was **Michael Young** (2003-07).
- per Elias*: has increased his HR total in each of his last 3 seasons...the only other player in ML history to have 3 straight 200-hit seasons while increasing his HR total by at least 5 in each season was **Rogers Hornsby** (1920-22).
- has started all 5 games at 2B since leaving with right oblique discomfort on 9/14.
- is the 2nd Astro to record 40 doubles in 3 straight seasons: also **Biggio** (2003-05)...is 1 of 3 2nd basemen in ML history to have a year with 40 doubles, 100 runs, 24 HR and 27 steals: also **Soriano** (2002, 2005) and **Alomar** (1999).
- ranks 2nd the Majors in hits (200) and leads the AL in batting (.336)**...ranks T-2nd in the AL in doubles (40), 3rd in WAR (7.6), T-3rd in steals (27), 4th in OBP (.395), 4th total bases (322) and 6th in OPS (.935).
- his 94 RBI are the most by an Astro since **Carlos Lee** had 94 in 2011 (Lee is also the last Astro with more than 94 RBI, as he had 102 in 2009).
- has hit 22 HR and 84 RBI as a 2nd baseman...the last Astros 2nd baseman to post 22 HR in a single season was **Craig Biggio** (26) in 2005...the last to post 84 RBI was **Jeff Kent** (106, club record) in 2004.
