**WINS AND LOSSES:** The Rangers open a 3-game series in Oakland tonight, Texas' final regular season road contests of 2016...the club had won consecutive games before losing to LAA on Wednesday and was 3-3 on the homestand against the A's (1-2) and Angels (2-1)...Texas has dropped 4 of 7 overall and is 8-9 beginning 9/4...club has won 15 of 24, 17 of 27, 21 of 34, and 27 of the last 43 games...team is 35-21 (.625) since 7/23, 2nd-best in ML to CHC at .684 (39-18), and is 68-44 since 5/20...at **90-63 (.588), Texas has the best record and most wins in the A.L., 2nd-best in MLB in both categories** to only the Cubs (97-55, .638)...current record matches the 2nd best 153-game start in club history (see charts)...90 wins rank T6th most in club history, 2 more than last year (see below)...2016 is Texas' 7th winning season in last 8 years (beginning 2009 every year but 2014), one of just 4 ML clubs to accomplish that feat to date (LAD/NYY/STL).

**BACK IN THE 90s:** The Rangers have reached 90 victories for the 8th time in franchise history, 1st since 2013 (91) and 5th in last 7 years beginning 2010, most in ML in that span...club earned 90th win on 9/20 in 152nd game to match fewest games ever (2012)...Rangers were 1st AL team to 50, 70, 80, and 90 wins in 2016.

• Club has been a season best 28 games above .500 4 times (9/3, 9/13, 9/15, 9/21), just the 4th season in club history to reach 28-over at any point (also 1999, 2011, 2012).

**IN THE LEAD:** Texas has assured itself of no worse than a regular season tie for the A.L. West Division title...club could win outright with a Houston (vs. LAA) and Seattle (at MIN) loss this evening OR a victory tonight vs. the A's...it would be the club's 2nd straight and 7th A.L. West title overall, most of any A.L. West team since 3-division play began in 1994 (6--LAA and OAK; 3--SEA)...see chart below for full information.

• The Rangers enter play on Friday with a 9.0-game lead in the A.L. West over HOU...club has led by at least 8.5 games for 24 consecutive days...current 9.0-game lead is largest in A.L. and 2nd-best in baseball to the Cubs (+17.0 GA in N.L. Central)...season-high 10.5 game lead on 9/3, the 2nd-largest league/division lead on any date in franchise history to 11.0 games, 9/30/10 after a win vs. LAA...this is just the 4th season in club history to have a lead of 10+ games (1999, 2010, 2011)...Texas has had share of 1st for 140 days, sole possession of 1st for 131 days...club has been in 1st place for 116 consecutive days beginning 5/29.

**ON THE ROAD:** This series at the Coliseum marks the Rangers' only road games in the season's final 15 contests beginning 9/16...Texas won 4 of its last 6 away from home, capturing the 1st 2 G in 3-game series at LAA and HOU in that span...club is 14-11 on the road beginning 7/23 but just 17-23 beginning 6/29...at 40-38 (.514), Texas is T3rd in A.L. road winning percentage, needing one win for 2nd straight (45-36 in 2015) and 5th winning mark in the last 6 seasons.

**VS. OAKLAND:** Texas is 8-8 vs. the A's in 2016, winning 4 of 6 and 8 of 12...The Rangers are 44-48 against OAK since the start of 2012, winning only one season's series in that span...Texas is 3-4 at the Coliseum in 2016, winning the last 3 since a defeat on 6/13...club is 16-10 here beginning 2014...Texas leads all-time series, 351-340 overall with the A's holding a 177-167 advantage in OAK.

• With 3 games remaining, the Rangers are 45-28 (.616) vs. the A.L. West, a winning percentage that would be 3rd best in club history to 2011 (.702, 40-17) and 2013 (.697, 53-23)... Texas has gone 13-9 vs. West in current span of 25 straight division games thru 9/25.

**ONE-RUN DEFEAT:** Wednesday's 5-4 loss was Texas' 3rd straight game decided by a single run and snapped the team's 5-game winning streak in one-run contests...the Rangers have played one-run games in 8 of their last 12 contests, going 6-2 in that span with each of their last 5 and 5 of 6 wins coming by a single run...Texas is an MLB-best 36-11 (.766) in one-run games...according to Elias Sports Bureau, the best win pct. ever in a season in one-run games was a 29-9 (.763) mark by the 2012 Orioles...the Rangers' 36 one-run wins lead MLB, are 2nd-most in club history (37 in 1990), and most in the A.L. since KC in 1993 (38).

**THE BULLPEN:** The Texas bullpen has not allowed a run in its last 7.0 IP of work and has permitted just one unearned run in the last 14.1 IP beginning with 9th inning on 9/18...relievers have 2.70 ERA (15 ER/50.0 IP) last 14 G to drop from 4.79 to 4.58...Texas relievers now have club's last 7 wins and are 15-1 in team's last 43 G...the bullpen's club-record 39 relief wins are 7 more than any other club (NYY-32)...the 39 relief wins are T3rd-most in MLB history...just 2 teams have had 40-or-more: 41-1953 Dodgers and 40-2009 Yankees.

**TOP 15:** The Rangers begin play on Friday with 3 of the A.L.'s top 15 qualifiers in batting average, all at .299: Carlos Beltran, 12th at .299; Elvis Andrus, 14th at 2988; and Adrian Beltre, 15th at .2987...Boston is the only other team with 3 in the top 15 as Dustin Pedroia, Mookie Betts, and David Ortiz are 2nd, 3rd, and 4th, respectively.

• Beltre has the 5th most RBI (126) and is tied with Carlton Fisk for the 6th most HR (36) lifetime vs. OAK (1968-2016).

**HIGH IN ROOKIE RANKINGS:** Nomar Mazara is 6-for-10 with 2 HR and 5 RBI in his last 3 games and is hitting .476 (10-21) with 3 HR and 7 RBI in his last 7 contests to go from .268 to .277, **2nd among ML qualifying rookies** to a .315 mark for LAD's Corey Seager...Mazara's current average would be 3rd highest ever for a qualifying Texas rookie behind .289 for Bump Wills in 1977 and .278 for Mike Lamb in 2000...Mazara also leads all A.L. rookies in hits (137), TB (216), runs (57), HR (20), and RBI (64) and is 2nd in BB (37)... he is just the 4th Ranger rookie to hit 20 HR in a season, the 1st since Mark Teixeira (26) in 2003.

**ROSTER MOVE:** LHP Andrew Faulkner (#58) has been recalled from Triple-A Round Rock, his 3rd stint with the Rangers this season (4/4-15, 5/10-18)...Faulkner has been working out at the Surprise, AZ complex since 9/12...he was 5-3, 3.97 in 41 G at Round Rock and has a 7.94 ERA in 8 appearances with the Rangers in 2016.

**SHORTS:** Only 2 managers have ever won division titles (since start of 3-division play in 1994) in each of 1st 2 seasons as a major league manager: MIN's Ron Gardenhire (2002-04) and ARI's Bob Brenly (2001-02)...Jered Weaver's win on Wednesday was his 18th vs. Texas, T5th most all-time by an opponent...Rangers lead the majors with 180 DP, 2nd most in club history (191 in 2008)...Texas has signed LHP James Jones to a 2017 minor league contract...acquired from SEA in November 2015, Jones made the conversion from the outfield in mid-season and had Tommy John surgery on his left elbow on 8/24.

**TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#35 Cole Hamels, LHP**  
**(14-5, 3.42)**

**TONIGHT:** The 32-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his 31st start of the season in tonight's opener against the Athletics in Oakland...Hamels was the winning pitcher in the Rangers' division-clinching victory on 10/4/15 vs. LAA, throwing a complete game to help Texas win game no. 162 by a 9-2 score (9.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R-ER, 2 BB, 8 SO, HR, 108 pitches/73 strikes)...has allowed 21 R-ER in 18.0 IP his last 4 starts to raise season ERA from 2.67 to 3.42...will be his second straight start against the Athletics after he received no-decision on Fri. against Oakland, a 7-6 Rangers win...has still posted quality starts in 8 of his 12 second 'half' starts...has already bested his win total from last season, and his last season with more than 14 wins was 2012 (career-high 17)...was the 1st pitcher in Rangers history to have at least 12 wins and fewer than 4 losses in one season at the end of July (Elias)...is 21-6, 3.49 (105 ER/271 IP) in 42 G/GS with Texas since being acquired at last year's trade deadline...Rangers are 22-8 in his 30 starts this season, including 6-2 in his last 7...will be pitching on extended 5 days' rest with Thursday's off day...recorded 2000th career SO on 6/12 at SEA (Leonys Martin), the 7th active player to reach that mark.

**ON THE LEADERBOARD:** Ranks among A.L. leaders in numerous categories, including win pct. (6th, .737), SO (7th, 187), QS (8th, 20), GB% (8th, 49.9), win (T9th, 14), and SO/9 (8th, 9.02), ERA (12th, 3.42), road ERA (4th, 2.57) and night ERA (4th, 3.08).

**LAST START:** Will be his second straight start against the Athletics after he received no-decision on Fri. against Oakland, a 7-6 Rangers win (6.0 IP, 7 H, 6 R-ER, 3 BB, 6 SO, 2 HR, 96 pitches/64 strikes)...was on the verge of back-to-back quality starts, but allowed a two-out three-run HR to Brett Eibner in the sixth...also allowed a three-run inning in the 4th, allowing a HR to Khris Davis, but got out of the frame with a strike-out-caught stealing, whiffing Renato Nunez, while Lucroy threw out Eibner at second.

**VS. OAKLAND:** Is 0-0, 6.39 (9 ER/12.2 IP) in 2 starts against Oakland this season...his lone start in Oakland this season came on 5/17, a Rangers 8-5 loss (6.2 IP, 9 H, 4 R, 3 ER, 2 BB, 6 SO, 3 HR, 100 pitches/58 strikes) th all 3 runs coming on HR...is 1-1, 3.71 (11 ER/26.2 IP) in 4 career starts against the A's, including 1-0, 2.13 (3 ER/12.2 IP) in 2 starts at the Coliseum.

**SINCE THE BREAK:** Hamels had a productive span over his 1st 8 starts after the All-Star break from 7/17-8/25: 5-2, 1.59 (10 ER/56.2 IP) w/ 14 BB/58 SO and a .212/.261/.298/.559 slash...ranked among MLB leaders from All-Star break thru 8/25 in ERA (T2nd), wins (T6th), and SO (7th)...opened start on 8/19 at TB w/ 5.1 no-hit innings...did not allow an ER in 13.1 IP over 1st 2 starts after break 7/17 at CHC and 7/23 at KC...whiffed 1st 6 Cubs batters to open start 7/17 at Wrigley, a club record for a Texas starter to begin a game (previous 5 by Nolan Ryan, 5/9/92 vs. ML)...only other Texas pitcher to record each of a game's 1st 6 outs via strikeout is Darvish, twice: 4/19/13 vs. SEA and 8/11/13 vs. ARI (STATS LLC).

**ON THE ROAD:** Is 9-3, 2.57 (29 ER/101.2 IP) over 16 road starts this season, ranking among the A.L.'s road leaders in both ERA (4th) and wins (T1st)...his ERA is also 6th-lowest in the ML...opponents are batting .214/.287/.328/.615 on the road compared to .272/.357/.438/.795 in Arlington...has posted a quality start in 13 of 16 road outings, but allowed more earned runs on 9/10 at SEA (7 R-ER) than he had permitted in his 1st 5 post-break road starts (8 R-6 ER).

**ALL-STAR:** Worked a scoreless 3rd inning in the A.L.'s 4-2 win over the N.L. on 7/12 in his hometown of San Diego...had runners and second and third with 2 outs, but whiffed Kris Bryant to end the frame...was 4th career All-Star selection and 1st since 2012.

**ALL I DO IS WIN:** Is 21-6 (.778) over 42 starts since the 7/31/15 trade to the Rangers, T2nd-best win pct. in A.L. (min. 20 decisions) in that span (J.A. Happ, 20-4, .833) and T4th in MLB...according to STATS LLC, he was one of just 5 pitchers since 1913 to win at least 19 of his 1st 22 decisions with a single club, joining Vida Blue as only pitcher to do it for an A.L. club...won a career-high 12 consecutive decisions from 8/23/15-5/22/16 before loss on 5/27/16 vs. PIT...it was 4 games longer than his previous career best (8 G, 4/15 - 5/28/12)...it matched the longest win streak by a starter in Rangers history (Bobby Witt - 12 G in 1990) and was the longest by a left-hander...Rangers' loss in Hamels' start on 5/1 vs. LAA (Hamels took ND) ended a streak of team wins in 14 consecutive regular season starts, 8/17/15-4/20/16, T2nd-longest streak in club history (15 straight Ferguson Jenkins starts in 1978-79 - STATS LLC).

**2016:** LH batters hitting just .204 (30-147), 9th-lowest in A.L...his 49.9% groundball percentage would be the T2nd-highest of his career (career-high 53.7 in 2011)...has induced 16 GIDP, 3 shy of a career high (19 in 2010 and 2015), but has not induced one in his last 5 starts...opponents swing and miss on 27.5% of pitches, 5th-highest rate in the A.L...opponents batting .217 (33-152) w/ RISP (8th in A.L., 13th in MLB), including 11-for-61 (.180) in last 12 outings...has allowed 8 HR in last 17 starts after allowing 15 in his 1st 13 starts of the season...his 8 hit batters are T9th in A.L., and his career-high 75 BB are T1st-most in A.L and T5th in the ML...has left team-high 7 starts in position to lose, only to see a Texas comeback, T2nd-most in the A.L. (7-SEA/BAL's Wade Miley & KC's Edinson Volquez)...opponents by PA in game: batting .219 (54-247) in first PA; .222 (52-234) in 2nd PA; .282 (57-202) in 3rd PA; .308 (8-26) in 4th PA...Lucroy (4.89 ERA) has caught each of last 9 starts, while Chirinos (1.39 ERA) has caught 7, Wilson (3.52) caught 11, and Holaday (3.79) caught 4...went 4-0, 1.51 (7 ER/41.2 IP) over 6 starts in June, ranked among A.L. June leaders in ERA (2nd, 1.51), wins (T2nd)...12 K's/728 vs. KC, most by a Ranger in '16...allowed career-high 14 hits on 8/13 vs. DET, when he became 1st ML starter to take a loss in a game of allowing as little as 2 runs on 14+ hits since Tigers' Frank Lary on 9/11/55 at WSH against the original Senators...on 8/30 vs. SEA, retired 9 of the 1st 10 batters he faced before 10 of the final 14 hitters reached via hit or walk.
