OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** snapped a five-game losing streak, which matched their second-longest such streak this season...finished 34-47 (.420) at home, which matches their second worst home record in Oakland history (also: 2015)...snapped an eight-game home losing streak, which matched the longest such streak by an A's team over the last 34 years (May 3-22, 1994 and April 8-May 1, 2001)...despite the win, lost the season series with Texas 9-10...are 49-46 agaisnt the Rangers over the last five years...finished 1-5 on the final homestand of the season against Houston (0-3) and Texas (1-2)...leave following the game today for the final road trip of the season, a seven-game trip to Los Angeles-AL (three games) and Seattle (four games).
- · The A's scored seven runs after tallying a total of eight runs over the previous five contests.
- **Jharel Cotton** is 2-0 with a 1.44 ERA (4 er in 25.0 ip) in four starts since being recalled from Triple-A Nashville September 7...is the first A's pitcher since the earned run became an official stat in 1913 to start his career with four consecutive outings of five innings or more and one earned run or fewer...had his scoreless streak of 10.0 innings dating back to his last start snapped, which was the longest scoreless streak of his career.
- Yonder Alonso (2-for-4, 2b) is batting .316 (18-for-57) with seven doubles in September...collected his 25th multi-hit game this season.
- Ryon Healy (3-for-4, r, hr, 2 rbi) is now batting .352 (51-for-145) over his last 37 games...is batting .354 (17-for-48) with 10 runs and six multi-hit games in 12 games against Texas...is batting .341 (30-for-88) with six home runs and 16 RBI in September...collected his fourth three-hit game and 21st multi-hit game.
- Bruce Maxwell (3-for-4, r, rbi) is batting .395 (17-for-43) in 15 games in September...collected his second career three-hit game.
- Matt Olson (1-for-3, r, bb, so) collected his first Major League hit with a single in the third inning.

TEXAS NOTES

- The **Texas Rangers** had their two-game winning streak snapped, but have still won four of their last six games...at 92-64 (.590), have matched their second-best record after 156 games in club history (also: 2012)...fell to 42-39 (.519) on the road and 47-29 (.618) against AL West competition...despite the loss, won the season series against the A's 10-9 and are 353-341 all-time against Oakland...finished 2-1 on their final road trip, a three-game road trip to Oakland...return home following the game tomorrow for the final homestand of the season, a six-game stand against Milwaukee (three games) and Tampa Bay (three games).
- Colby Lewis is 0-3 with a 9.75 ERA (13 er in 12.0 ip) in three starts since returning from the disabled list...is 2-3 with a 5.45 ERA (23 er in 38.0 ip) in seven starts during the day...is 1-2 with a 6.32 ERA (11 er in 15.2 ip) in three starts against Oakland this season...tossed a career-low tying 1.1 innings, the third time in his career he has done so (last: June 11, 2011 at Minnesota).
- Adrian Beltre (2-for-3, r, hr, rbi) collected hit number 2,936 of his career, moving him past Barry Bonds for 35th on the all-time hits list...extended his hitting streak to six games (9-for-21, .429)...is batting .375 (33-for-88) over his last 23 games.
- Jonathan Lucroy (1-for-2, 2b, so) is batting .320 (24-for-75) over his last 23 games.
