**A.L. WEST CHAMPIONS:** The Rangers clinched the 2016 American League West Division title on Friday night, the club's 2nd straight and 7th A.L. West championship overall, most of any A.L. West team since 3-division play began in 1994 (6--LAA and OAK; 3--SEA)...the only other A.L. clubs with at least 7 division titles since 1994 are NYY with 11 and CLE with 7 (entering 2016).  
 • Overall, it will be the Rangers' 8th trip to the postseason, the 5th in the last 7 years (2010-16)...STL (5) is the only other team with as many as 5 playoff appearances since 2010 with DET and NYY both with 4 entering 2016...this is Texas' 4th division title in the last 7 years and only DET (4) has as many in that span...LAD has 3 entering 2016.

**THE CLINCH:** Texas clinched the A.L. West title on Friday in its 154th game of 2016, matching 2010 for the fewest games in team history ever to clinch either a division title or playoff spot...it was the 3rd time the Rangers have clinch a postseason berth on the road, the 2nd in OAK (2010)...Texas joins the Cubs (N.L. Central champs) and Nationals (N.L. East champs) as teams to clinch division titles in 2016.

**WINS AND LOSSES:** The Rangers conclude the road portion of their regular season schedule today...Texas has won 2 straight and 4 of the last 5 games...club is 12-9 in September and has won 17 of 26, 19 of 29, 23 of 36, and 29 of the last 45 games...team is 37-21 (.638) since 7/23, 2nd-best in ML to CHC at .678 (40-19), and is 70-44 since 5/20...at **92-63 (.594), Texas has the best record and most wins in the A.L., 2nd-best in MLB in both categories** to only the Cubs (98-56, .636)...current record matches the best 155-game start in club history (see charts)...92 wins rank 5th most in club history (96--2011; 95--1999; 94--1977; 93--2012)...2016 is Texas' 7th winning season in last 8 years (beginning 2009 every year but 2014), one of just 4 ML clubs to accomplish that feat to date (LAD/NYY/STL).

**HIGH WATER MARK:** At 92-63, the Rangers are 29 games over the .500 mark, their best record since 9/24/12 (91-62)...this is just the 4th season in club history to reach 29-over at any point (also 1999, 2011, 2012)...Texas has not been as many as 30 games over .500 since the end of 2011 (96-66).

**ON THE ROAD:** At 42-38 (.525), Texas has the A.L.'s 3rd best away winning percentage...this will be the 2nd straight and 5th time in the last 6 seasons that the Rangers have posted a winning road record...club has won 6 of its last 8 away from home and is 16-11 on the road beginning 7/23.

**SERIES STUFF:** This marks the 4th time in the last 5 series, all 3-game sets, that Texas has won the 1st 2 games...club has dropped game 3 in the previous 3 series, 9/11 at LAA; 9/14 at HOU; and 9/21 vs. LAA...club has won all games of a series 9 times in 2016, last 8/29-31 vs. SEA.

**IN THE LEAD:** The Rangers enter play on Sunday with a 10.5-game lead in the A.L. West, matching a season high (9/3) and the **2nd-largest league/division lead on any date in franchise history** to 11.0 games, 9/30/10 after a win vs. LAA...this is just the 4th season in club history to have a lead of 10+ games (1999, 2010, 2011)...the club has gained 2.0 games in the standings in the last 3 days and has led by at least 8.5 games for 26 consecutive days...current 10.5-game lead is largest in A.L. and 2nd-best in baseball to the Cubs (+17.0 GA in N.L. Central)...Texas has had share of 1st for 142 days, sole possession for 133 days...club has held 1st for 118 consecutive days beginning 5/29.

**VS. OAKLAND:** Texas has won the 1st 2 games of this series to take a 10-8 lead vs. the A's in 2016, just the 2nd time in the last 5 years that the club has won the season's series vs. OAK...Rangers have captured 6 of 8 and 10 of 14...Texas is 5-4 at the Coliseum in 2016, winning the last 5 since a defeat on 6/13...this is Texas' longest winning streak in this park since 8/12-9/21/11 (5)...the Rangers lead all-time series, 353-340 overall with the A's holding a 177-169 advantage in OAK.

**SETTING IN THE WEST:** Today marks the Rangers' regular season finale vs. the A.L. West Division and concludes a string of 25 straight intra-divisional games (15-9)...Texas is 47-28 (.627) vs. the A.L. West, a winning pct. that will be 3rd best in club history to 2011 (.702, 40-17) and 2013 (.697, 53-23)...Texas has a winning record vs. all 4 A.L. West clubs.

**BACK-TO-BACK BLANKINGS:** Texas has posted consecutive shutouts for the 1st time since 2014: 6/11 vs. MIA and 6/13 at SEA...it is the 1st time the Rangers have pitched back-to-back road shutouts since 4/2-3/13 at HOU...staff has 6 shutouts overall in 2016, 4 in the last 28 games...all are combined SHO...last CG SHO--Lewis on 9/11/15 vs. OAK.  
 • Rangers' pitchers have not allowed a run in the last 22.0 IP dating back to 6th inning on 9/22 vs. LAA...it is the club's longest scoreless streak since 23.0 IP, 6/10-14/14.  
 • Cole Hamels and Yu Darvish have turned in back-to-back outings of 7.0 scoreless innings, the 1st time starters have had consecutive games with 7.0+ scoreless frames since 9/22-23/13 (Alexi Ogando and Derek Holland).  
 • The Texas bullpen has not allowed a run in its last 11.0 IP of work with 1 unearned run in 18.1 IP since 9th inn. on 9/18.

**ELVIS LEAVES THE BUILDING...TWICE:** Elvis Andrus hit 2-run homers in the 2nd and 6th innings (span of 3 AB) on Saturday for the 1st multi-HR game of his ML career...he had never hit 2 HR in fewer than an 8 AB span...it marked the 1st multi-HR game for a Texas shortstop since Michael Young on 4/11/07 vs. TB (2)...it was Andrus' 2nd career 4 RBI game (6/12/15 vs. MIN)...he has career highs of 8 HR and 68 RBI.  
 • Andrus leads **ML qualifiers with a .380 batting average with RISP**...current mark would be 6th best in club history (100+PA), best since Ian Kinsler's .413 team mark in 2008.

**YU DARVISH** recorded his 43rd career game of 9+ strikeouts on Saturday, 2nd in club history to Nolan Ryan (45)...Darvish is averaging 11.45 K/9.0 IP) in 2016, 2nd best ever for a Ranger (90.0+ IP) to his 11.89 mark in 2013.

**FINAL HOMESTAND:** The Rangers close the regular season with a 6-game homestand against Milwaukee and Tampa Bay...the 3-game series with the Brewers starts Monday...Texas and MIL split home and home 2-game series (2-2) in 2013, the last meeting on 8/14 at Arlington...the Rangers are 50-25 (.667) at home, 3rd pct. in the majors and 2 wins shy of club record for home wins in a season (1978 and 2011).

**SHORTS:** The Rangers are 24-21 in day games this season, ending a 4-game losing streak yesterday with 1st win since 9/3 vs. HOU...team is 12-14 on the road in day contests...Saturday was 15th time a Ranger has had 2 HR in a game in 2016, 3rd at OAK (Chirinos, Odor, Andrus).

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#48 Colby Lewis, RHP**  
**(6-3, 3.40)**

**TODAY:** The 36-year-old Bakersfield native is scheduled for his 18th start in today's series finale, his 2nd straight outing vs. the A's and 3rd start since returning from a 2-month stint on the disabled list...is 0-2, 5.06 (6 ER/10.2 IP) in 2 starts since returning, raising season ERA from 3.21 to 3.40, w/ Texas scoring 4 total runs in those losses...opponents batting .244 (10-41) in the 2 outings, but 4 of the 10 hits allowed are HR along with 7 BB/9 SO...took loss last Sun. vs. OAK as Rangers dropped the rubber game in Arlington...has lost each of last 3 starts (also 6/21 vs. CIN, pitching thru injury)...his **1.66 road ERA is lowest in MLB** (min. 8 road starts)...was on the DL for over 2 months from 6/22-9/10 with a right latissimus dorsi strain...posted a 8.18 ERA (10 ER/11.0 IP) over 3 rehab starts with Double-A Frisco and Short-Season Spokane...through his 1st 14 starts through 6/16, ranked among A.L. leaders in quality starts (1st, 12), pitches per inning (4th, 14.5), WHIP (4th, 1.01), opponent average (7th, .222), and BB/9 (7th, 1.74)...opened season 6-0 start for 1st time in his career, matching the longest win streak of his career (6, 9/9/11-4/28/12)...has left a game in line for the victory 9 times this season, but only has 6 wins in such games...earned his 100th career victory between MLB and Nippon Professional Baseball (74-67 in MLB, 26-17 in NPB) on 5/20 at HOU...Rangers are 10-7 in his starts.

**LAST START:** Took loss on Sun. vs. OAK in that series finale, a 5-2 Texas defeat (5.1 IP, 3 H, 3 R-ER, 5 BB, 4 SO, 1 HR, 92 pitches/48 strikes)...with Texas holding a 2-1 lead through 5 innings, Lewis came out for the 6th and allowed 4 of 5 BF to reach (3 BB, 1B) before his exit, including a game-tying bases-loaded walk to Marcus Semien on his final batter faced...Alex Claudio allowed an inherited runner to score, and Keone Kela gave up the 2nd Kris Davis HR of the day in the 8th inning for the final margin...issued 5 BB, most since 9/25/14 vs. OAK (5), and tied for his most in any start since his return from Japan in 2010 (4th 5-walk game in that span)...in each of 2 starts since return from the DL, has allowed each of game's 1st 2 batters to reach before whiffing 3 straight to end the opening frame.

**VS. OAKLAND:** Loss in last start (see above) snapped 5-G win streak vs. A's, and also ended run of 7 straight QS vs. OAK...only other start vs. OAK in '16 was his near no-hitter here at the Coliseum on 6/16 (see below)...is 12-5, 2.87 (56 ER/175.2 IP) in 29 G/27 GS in career vs. A's, including 10-2, 2.55 (34 ER/120.0 IP) last 18 G/GS since 9/26/10...**more career wins (12) and starts (27) vs. OAK than any other club**...all 12 wins have come w/ Texas, T9th-highest total by any Texas pitcher vs. one opponent in club history.

**--At the Coliseum:** Has won 4 straight starts at the Coliseum since 6/16/14, and is 7-2, 2.65 (23 ER/78.0 IP) in 12 G/GS at this park since his return to the U.S. in 2010 (10 QS).

**NEAR-PERFECT:** Retired the 1st 23 batters faced on 6/16 at Oakland (2-out BB in 8th), and pitched 8.0 no-hit innings in his CG, 2-hit, 5-1 victory (9.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R-ER, 1 BB, 4 SO, 0 HR, 109 pitches/75 strikes)...lost the perfect game on a 4-pitch walk of Yonder Alonso in the 8th and allowed 1st hit when Max Muncy led off the 9th with a double...Lewis' 23 batters retired to begin the game were 3rd-most ever by a Texas starter to only Kenny Rogers (27 in his perfect game 7/28/94 vs. CAL) and Darvish (26 on 4/2/13 at HOU).

**DISABLED LIST:** Was on 60-day disabled list from 6/22-9/10 w/ a right latissimus dorsi strain...originally placed on DL 6/25 (retro to 6/22)...3 rehab starts w/ AA Frisco (2) and Short-A Spokane (1) - see game log in right-hand column.

**ON THE ROAD:** Is 4-1, 1.66 (10 ER/54.1 IP) in his 8 road starts in '16, nearly 3 1/2 runs lower than his home ERA (5.13) despite equal home/road innings pitched (54.1)...the **1.66 away ERA is lowest in MLB among pitchers with 8+ road starts**...only road loss came in last away start on 9/11 at LAA, snapping a career-best 5 straight road wins dating to 9/23/15...last 5 road starts beg. 5/20: 3-1, 1.27 (5 ER/35.1 IP) w/ 5 BB/20 SO.

**2016:** Rangers are 10-7 in his starts, 2 of the losses coming in games with blown saves...has left with the lead and in position to win in 9 of his 17 starts, recording 6 wins...has 3 wins lost (exit in position to win, take L or ND) this season...23 of 42 runs against Lewis this season have come on 17 HR allowed, and 11 of his 17 HR allowed have come in 9 starts in Arlington...opposition batting .257 (36-140) in first PA; .196 (29-148) in 2nd PA; .243 (25-103) in 3rd PA; .100 (1-10) in 4th PA...opponents batting .212 (14-66) with runners in scoring position...leadoff batter has reached in 34 of 111 frames...Bryan Holaday (2.16 ERA) caught 4 starts, Brett Nicholas (3.75) caught 2 starts, Bobby Wilson (2.89) caught 8 outings, and Robinson Chirinos (6.89) has caught 3 starts...opponents are batting .233 on balls in play...pitched at least 7.0 innings in a career-high 5 consecutive starts, 4/29-5/20, matching longest streak by a Ranger in the past 2 seasons (also Hamels, 8/28 - 9/19/15)...completed at least 6.0 innings in each of his first 9 starts, longest streak by a member of the Texas season-opening rotation since Alexi Ogando (12) in 2011...had 6 straight QS, 4/23-5/20, only Ranger since start of 2014 w/ streak of 6-or-more (also 6 straight, 6/2 - 6/30/15).
