WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost five of their last seven games as they continue Cactus League play this afternoon against the Oakland Athletics at Hohokam Park ... today's game will be broadcast in Chicago on CSN.
- RHP Zach Putnam will start today's game in place of LHP Carlos Rodón, who was scratched due to tightness in his upper left biceps.
- The White Sox have outscored their opponents, 88-76, over the last 15 games ... the Sox are hitting .284 (266-935) this spring, the sixth-best average in baseball.
- The White Sox have three games remaining in Glendale (two as the home team) and five on the road this spring, including two exhibition games vs. Milwaukee from 3/31-4/1 at Miller Park.
- Chicago went 17-13-1 last spring, its first winning record since 2004 (15-13-1) ... the Sox are 115-145-21 in Glendale since 2009 and 56-79-9 all-time at CR-G (47-72-6 as the home team).

OPENING WITH Q

- José Quintana will be the White Sox 2017 Opening Day starter on 4/3 vs. Detroit ... he will be the second Colombian to start on OD, joining Atlanta's Julio Teheran (2014-16).
- Quintana has gone 46-46 with a 3.41 ERA (360 ER/951.0 IP) and 781 strikeouts in 154 appearances (151 starts) over five career seasons with the White Sox.
- He ranks seventh among major-league pitchers since 2013 with an 18.1 fWAR.

RODÓN SCRATCHED

- LHP Carlos Rodón was scratched from his scheduled start today at Oakland after feeling tightness in his upper left biceps ... team doctors found no structural damage in their initial examination ... Rodón is scheduled to undergo an MRI today.
- Rodón has made one start this spring, earning the win on 3/19 at the Angels after tossing 4.0 scoreless IP with five strikeouts.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP VS. CINCINNATI

- The White Sox snapped a three-game losing streak as they defeated Cincinnati, 4-2, at Camelback Ranch-Glendale.
- Starter Jose Quintana, who made his first appearance since returning from the World Baseball Classic, earned the win, tossing 7.0 scoreless IP ... Quintana retired the first 17 batters he faced ... Brian Clark (1.2 scoreless IP) recorded his second save of the spring, making his seventh scoreless appearance.
- Nicky Delmonico went 2-4 with a double, home run and three RBI ... Matt Davidson was 1-1 with a RBI.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

- Leury García ranks among American League spring training leaders in batting average (.347) and ranks among Cactus League leaders in hits (4th, 17).
- Peter Bourjos and Jacob May are tied for second in triples (3) among AL spring leaders.

WHITE HOT SOX

- Tyler Saladino is hitting .366 (15-41) with two doubles, one triple, three home runs and nine RBI in 14 games this spring.
- Danny Hayes has gone 12-33 (.364) with three doubles, one homer and nine RBI over 20 spring games.
- Peter Bourjos is batting .333 (14-42) with three doubles, three triples and two RBI in 17 Cactus League games.
- Leury García is 17-49 (.347) with five doubles and 10 RBI in 22 spring appearances.

ON THE MOUND

- Matt Purke has made six scoreless appearances (7.0 IP) with eight strikeouts this spring.
- Cory Luebke has posted a 0.96 ERA (1 ER/9.1 IP) with six strikeouts in eight spring outings.
- Brian Clark owns a 2.16 ERA (2 ER/8.1 IP) with eight strikeouts and two saves in eight appearances this spring.

ROSTER MOVES

- The White Sox Thursday made the four following roster moves: optioned OF Adam Engel and RHP Tommy Kahnle to Class AAA Charlotte and reassigned LHP Jace Fry and C Roberto Peña to minor-league camp.
- The White Sox have 37 players remaining in major-league camp: 17 pitchers, three catchers, 11 infielders and six outfielders.

MANAGER RICK RENTERIA

■ Rick Renteria enters his second season with the White Sox and first as the manager ... served as the Sox bench coach during the 2016 season ... is the only current Latino manager in Major League Baseball ... brings nine seasons of managerial experience to the position, including eight in the minor leagues, as well as the 2014 campaign with the Chicago Cubs ... joins Hall-of-Famer Johnny Evers as the only managers of both the White Sox and the Cubs ... Evers managed the Sox in 1924 and the Cubs in 1913 and 1921 ... was named the 53rd manager in Cubs history on 11/7/13 and guided the Cubs to a 73-89 record in 2014 ... spent six seasons on the San Diego Padres coaching staff, serving as bench coach from 2011-13 and first base coach from 2008-10 ... also managed Team Mexico in the 2013 World Baseball Classic ... appeared in 184 games over parts of five major-league seasons with Pittsburgh (1986), Seattle (1987-88) and Florida (1993-94), batting .237 (100-422) with four home runs and 41 RBI.
