OAKLAND NOTES

- Stephen Vogt connected for his first homer of the season in the second inning... his second career Opening Day home run, last was a 3-run homer on 4/6/15 vs. Texas... he is one of 8 Oakland Athletics with two or more career Opening Day homers ...
- Vogt has hit safely in all three of his Opening Day starts... he is batting .385 (5-for-12) with two homers and four RBI in those starts.
- Khris Davis connected for his first career Opening Day homer in the six inning, and tallied his second homer in the eighth... he became the second Oakland Athletic to record a multi-homer game on Opening Day, last was Jason Giambi on 4/3/2010.
- Davis recorded his 12th career multi-homer game, first against the Angels and fourth at the Oakland Coliseum... his last multi-homer game was on 9/18/2016 at Texas.
- Davis is the first Oakland player with three hits on Opening Day since 2002 (David Justice and Jeremy Giambi).
- Davis joined Madison Bumgarner atop the home run leader board, as they both recorded multi-homer contests in the 2017 opener.
- Kendall Graveman improved his mark to 2-1 vs the Los Angeles Angels...he owns a 3.32 ERA (40.2 IP/15 ER) vs. the Angels, and has recorded 5 of 7 quality starts against the Halos...
- Athletics belted three dingers on the night, last season they tallied 46 multi-homer games... 16 of those 46 multi-homer games at home.
- Santiago Casilla recorded his second career Opening Day save, last was 4/6/2015 at Arizona as member of the San Francisco Giants... he is 0-0 with a 6.00 ERA (3 IP/2ER) in four Opening Day appearances.
- With the save, Casilla is just the second Athletic with an Opening Day save over the last 24 years (Arthur Rhodes, 2004).

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- Ricky Nolasco made his fourth career Opening Day start... He is 1-3 with a 5.70 ERA (23.2 IP/18 ER) in four career Opening Day starts
- Mike Trout clubbed his third career Opening Day homer in the top of the third inning, tying Joe Rudi and Tim Salmon for the franchise record (3) ...
- Since the beginning of 2012, Mike Trout has clubbed 13 homers at the Oakland Coliseum, most by any visiting player in that time.
- With a start in center field, Trout became the first player in Angels history to make five Opening Day starts in CF.
- With a 2-for-4 night, Yunel Escobar tallied his 13 multi-hit game vs. Oakland... he owns a lifetime .295 (52-for-176) batting average vs. Oakland
- Escobar improved his career batting average to .333 (5-for-15) with a double vs Graveman.
- Andrelton Simmons tallied his 27th career hit against the A's in the second inning... he is a career .346 (27-for-78) lifetime hitter against Oakland.
