#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Athletics' outfielders committed two errors in a game for the first time since 9/23/2015 (Josh Reddick was charged with both).
- Adam Rosales picked up his first hit of the season in his first at bat...
  he singled in the third inning and scored on an error by Mike Trout.
- Ryon Healy went 1-3 today with a home run...he is a career .354 (17-for-48) hitter against the Angels with four home runs and 11 RBI in 13 games.
- Khris Davis, Marcus Semien and Yonder Alonso reached base safely in all four games of the opening series.
- Khris Davis doubled in the sixth inning and now has three extra-base hits in his first 12 at bats.
- Trevor Plouffe drove in Khris Davis in the sixth inning, recording his first RBI as an Athletic.
- Mark Canha went hitless, extending his hitless streak to 19 at bats dating back to 4/27/2016.
- Andrew Triggs earned the victory in is second career start against the Angels...he walked three batters after walking just one in his career as a starter

### LOS ANGELES NOTES

- Andrelton Simmons has hit safely in nine straight games, dating back to 9/27/2016 vs. Oakland... he is batting .414 (12-for-29) with five RBI during that span.
- Simmons has hit safely in six straight vs. OAK, dating back to 9/27/2016 vs. Oakland...he is batting .356 (32-for-90) with 11 RBI in 25 career games against the Athletics.
- Mike Trout committed an error in third inning, his first error since 6/27/2016 (vs. Houston).
- Tyler Skaggs' scoreless streak in his first start of a season came to an end at 28.0 innings...he also took a loss in his first start of a season for the first time and is now 4-1.
- The Angels did not hit a home run for just the third time in the last 20 games against the Athletics.
