THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY:

APRIL 16

1964 - Texas Governor **John Connally** tosses out the first pitch for the Colts' 45th home opener, a 6-5 loss to the Milwaukee Braves... Connally throws left-handed as his right arm is still healing from gunshot wounds suffered in the assassination of **John F. Kennedy**.

TODAY'S MEDIA AVAILABILITY

The Astros clubhouse will be open from 10:10-11 a.m...manager **A.J. Hinch** will be available in the Astros dugout at approximately 11 a.m.

TODAY'S FINALE: The Astros and Athletics will play the final game of this three-game series today in a 1:07 p.m. PT matinee at the Oakland Coliseum...today's pitching matchup will feature veteran Major League starter **RHP Charlie Morton** (0-1) opposite a rookie in **RHP Jharel Cotton** (1-1).

ABOUT MORTON: **RHP Charlie Morton** (0-1), who the Astros signed to a two-year contract this offseason, is coming off an injury-shortened 2016 season that saw him go 1-1 with a 4.15 ERA (8ER/17.1IP) in four starts with the Phillies...Morton is a 10-year Major League veteran, having spent seven (2009-15) of his 10 (2008-17) seasons with the Pirates.

SWAP MEET: Today's game also features a matchup of **OF Josh Reddick** and **RHP Jharel Cotton**, who were involved in the same trade last July...Reddick, then with the Athletics, was traded along with **LHP Rich Hill** to the Dodgers in exchange for Cotton, **RHP Frankie Montas** and **RHP Grant Holmes**.

RIGHT WING: The Astros will get a brief respite from facing a left-handed starter for at least the next five games opposite the A's today and the Angels next week...the Astros have faced seven left-handed starters this season (3-4) compared to five right-handed starters (5-0).

BEST START SINCE 2006: At 8-4, the Astros are off to their best 12-game start since also going 8-4 in their first 12 games in 2006...a win today would move the club to 9-4, which would match their best 13-game start to a season in franchise history, done so six previous seasons: 2006, 2004, 1988, 1986, 1979 and 1972.

STARTING BLOCKS: At 8-4, the Astros have already posted more wins this month than they did in April of 2016 (7-17)...through 12 games last season, Houston was 4-8, whereas in 2015, the Astros last playoff season, Houston started 6-6 through 12 contests.

STRAIGHT A'S: The Astros have won their last nine games vs. the A's, which is Houston's longest winning streak against the A's in club history and the Astros second-longest winning streak in franchise history against an AL opponent (LAA, 11g, 2016)...a win today would give the Astros just their third franchise sweep at the Coliseum, accomplished once in each of the last two seasons.

YESTERDAY'S WIN: The Astros posted their second five-run comeback in their last three games, this time storming back from a 5-0 deficit to drop the A's by a score of 10-6 at the Coliseum...the Astros had heroes throughout their lineup, including **LF Norichika Aoki** (2x4, 2RBI) and **RF George Springer** (1x4, HR, 2RBI), who tacked on insurance runs late in the game.

ELIAS SAYS: The Astros, who were held hitless until the 7th inning yesterday, came back from a 5-0 deficit to defeat the Athletics, 10-6...the last Major League team to reach a double-digit run total in a game in which it didn't have a hit over the first 6.0 innings was the Tigers, in a 10-4 win at CLE on July 19, 1969.

ROLLING 7'S: The Astros have scored 34 runs in their last four games, scoring at least seven runs in each contest...the last time they posted seven-plus runs in four straight games came in 2015, a streak of five straight with at least seven runs from April 25-29.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE: The Astros have recorded eight-or-more hits in six of their last seven games to raise their team batting average from .217 (after game five), to .266 entering today...Houston now leads the Majors in hits (111) and leads the AL in OBP (.347), while ranking tied for first in the AL in runs (55) and second in batting average (.266)...AL rankings below:

LEADOFF SHOTS: **OF George Springer** became the first player in MLB history to hit four leadoff homers in his club's first nine games of a season, besting **OF Brady Anderson**, who hit four leadoff homers in the Orioles first 17 games of 1996...Anderson was also the quickest player to reach five leadoff homers in a season, doing so in the Orioles first 27 games of 1996...Springer now has 13 career leadoff homers, which ranks tied for second in Astros history with **Terry Puhl** (13), trailing only **Craig Biggio** (53).

SIX IN 12: **OF George Springer**, who ranks tied for first in the Majors in home runs, is the fifth player in Astros history to total six home runs in the club's first 12 games of a season...he joins **Lance Berkman** (6 in 2006), **Chris Truby** (6 in 2001), **Glenn Davis** (6 in 1988) and **Jimmy Wynn** (6 in 1973) in that group.

THE 200 CLUB: **2B Jose Altuve** recorded two steals yesterday and now has 204 career steals, which ranks sixth in Astros history.

CORREA UPDATE: **SS Carlos Correa** left yesterday's game with a right hand contusion, sustained on a hit by pitch in the 9th inning...X-rays came back negative and Correa is considered day-to-day.

PITCHING PROWESS: The Astros pitching staff has posted a 3.55 ERA (45ER/114IP) this season, which ranks fourth in the AL...the Astros also rank first in the AL in strikeouts (111) and innings pitched (114.0), and third in opponent OBP (.297).

HISTORIC START: **LHP Dallas Keuchel** has opened his season with three straight 7.0-inning starts, while allowing one-or-fewer runs in each outing...the only other player in Astros history to open a campaign like this was **RHP Roger Clemens** in 2005...prior to Keuchel this season, the last Major Leaguer to open a season with three straight 7.0-inning starts, while allowing one-or-fewer runs and four-or-fewer hits was **RHP Matt Harvey**, in his first four starts of 2013.

LAST START - 4/10 AT SEA: took the loss in Houston's 6-0 defeat to LHP James Paxton and the Mariners...allowed 3 runs on 7 hits in 5.0 innings, striking out 6 with 2 walks...was his 2nd consecutive start against the Mariners...had never faced the club prior to 2017.

PUMP IT UP: 33-year-old right-hander signed a 2-year deal with Houston this offseason as a free agent.

- has been showcasing the velocity that was present during 2017 Spring Training and his 4-game stint with Philadelphia in 2016 (prior to his hamstring injury).
- in his 2 starts this season, his sinker has had an average velocity of 94.87 mph, while his curveball has averaged 80.79 mph...his sinker averaged 91.94 mph in 2014, 92.38 mph in 2015 and 94.83 in 2016...curveball averaged 78.99 mph in 2014, 79.23 mph in 2015 and 81.32 mph in 2016 (all velocities from Brooks Baseball).

GROUND CHUCK: has been one of the top starters in the game at inducing ground balls...among all active pitchers with at least 800.0 career innings, ranks 3rd in groundball to flyball ratio (2.46) behind only LHP Dallas Keuchel (2.87) and LHP Jaime Garcia (2.46).

- altered his delivery at the onset of the 2011 season, which produced a huge uptick in his ground ball to fly ball ratio...has posted a 2.97 groundball to flyball ratio since 2011, which leads all Major League pitchers in that span (min. 500IP).
- prior to altering his delivery, posted a 1.64 GB/FB ratio from 2008-10.

VS. OAK: is facing the A's for the first time in his career.

NEW TO THE JUNIOR CIRCUIT: prior to signing with Houston, spent the first 9 seasons of his Major League career pitching in the National League...spent the 2008-15 seasons with Pittsburgh and the 2016 season with Philadelphia.

- in 16 career starts against AL opponents, has gone 3-9 with a 4.58 ERA (46ER/90.1IP).
- in his last 8 starts against AL foes (dating back to 6/25/14), has gone 2-4 with a 3.35 ERA (18ER/48.1IP) and 42 strikeouts.

SPRING FLING: had a dominant 2017 Spring Training, going 2-0 with a 1.04 ERA (2ER/17.1IP) and 17 strikeouts...his ERA ranked 2nd in the Majors among pitchers with at least 15.0 innings pitched...ranked behind only RHP Masahiro Tanaka (0.38).

IN 2016: made just 4 starts with Philadelphia before suffering a left hamstring strain on April 24 while running to first base after bunting...following the injury, spent the entire season on the Disabled List.

- went 1-1 with a 4.15 ERA (8ER/17.1IP) and 19 strikeouts in his 4 starts with Philadelphia...tossed consecutive quality starts leading up to his final outing of the season (1.0IP).

- yesterday, surpassed **Jeff Bagwell** (202 SB) for 6th place on the club's all-time stolen base list (204 SB)...is 13 steals shy of tying **Terry Puhl** (217) for 5th place.
- had his streak of reaching base safely snapped at 11 consecutive plate appearances yesterday...became the first Astros player to reach base in 11 consecutive plate appearances since **Bill Spiers**, who set a franchise record by reaching in 13 consecutive PA's in 1997.
- became the 7th player in club history to reach base safely 5 times in 2 consecutive games on Wednesday and Friday...also **George Springer** (2016), **Carlos Lee** (2008), **Lance Berkman** (2008), **Ken Caminiti** (2000), **Rick Wilkins** (1996) and **Jeff Bagwell** (1995).
- owns a career .341 (310x909) batting average against left-handed pitchers...is the 2nd-highest career batting average against lefties produced by a Major Leaguer since 1974 (the year splits were first tracked), trailing only **Freddy Sanchez** (.342).

- is just 26 hits away from 2,000 career hits between the Major Leagues (690) and Nippon Professional Baseball in Japan (1284)...his 690 hits in the Majors rank 4th all-time among Japanese-born players, trailing only **Ichiro Suzuki** (3,030), **Hideki Matsui** (1,253) and **Dave Roberts** (721).
- became the 2nd Japanese-born player in club history to start on Opening Day, joining **Kazuo Matsui**, who started on Opening Day in 2009 and 2010.

- is the franchise leader in home runs by a shortstop with 42...surpassed **Adam Everett** (35 HR) last season.
