### ON THIS DATE

**2000** - A fifth inning, two-run home run gives Edgar Martinez career RBI's 800 & 801 making him the third Mariner to reach 800+ RBI (also Jay Buhner and Ken Griffey Jr.). **2009** - Ichiro hits a leadoff home run in a 1-0 win over the Rays... was the 2nd time in Mariners history and 22nd time in MLB history that a leadoff home run decided the game. **2014** - **Kyle Seager** hit a pair of home runs (his first 2 of the season), including a walk-off 3-run home run in the bottom of the 9th inning to lead the Mariners to a 5-3 win over the Astros, snapping an 8-game losing streak.

**TODAY'S TILT**...the Mariners continue a 10-game, 11-day, 3-city road trip tonight with the final of four games vs. the Oakland Athletics (0-3)...have an off day tomorrow before traveling to Detroit (3 G) and Cleveland (3 G) during the second road trip of the season...Seattle was 6-3 on its just concluded season-opening 9-game homestand vs. Houston (1-2), Texas (3-0) and Miami (2-1)...today's game will be televised live in HD on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...Seattle has lost 3 straight...have won 5 of last 9 and 6 of last 12 after opening the season 1-6...are 6-3 at home, but 1-9 on the road...17 of the club's first 26 games - and 23 of the first 38 - will be played on the road.

- **In the Nick of Time** - in his last 4 appearances (5.2 IP), **Nick Vincent** has retired each of the 17 of the last 18 batters he has faced, including 8 via strikeout...during that span, he has also stranded all 5 of his inherited runners.
- **Active Streaks** - **Nelson Cruz** (.455/5x11, 2 R, RBI, 5 BB, SB) and **Jarrod Dyson** (.375/6x16, 2 R, 2 RBI, BB, SB) each have current 4-game hit streaks.
- **A Pitcher's Best Friend** - the Mariners rank 1st in the Majors with 26 double plays turned...have turned at least 1 double play in 15 games of their 19 games, including 9 games with at least two double plays.
- **#Mariners40** - during the 2017 season, the Mariners will commemorate the 40th anniversary of the club's inception in 1977, celebrating four decades of team and individual accomplishments.

**FEELING BETTER**...shortstop **Jean Segura** (AA Arkansas) and RHP **Steve Cishek** (AA Arkansas) are both currently on rehab assignment...**Segura**, who was placed on the 10-day DL on April 11 with a strained right hamstring, is 1-for-6 with 1 run and 1 walk in 2 starts with the Travelers...**Cishek**, who was placed on the 10-day DL on March 31 recovering from surgery to repair left hip labrum tear on Oct. 12, 2016, made his 2nd rehab appearance, has his rehab assignment transferred from AAA Tacoma to AA Arkansas yesterday...overall he has made 2 rehab starts: April 17 at San Antonio with Arkansas (1.0,0,0,0,0) and April 21 at El Paso with Tacoma (0.2,1,0,0,2,0).

**HE JUST HITS**...**Mitch Haniger** has hit safely in 15 of his last 16 games (4/6-current), batting .339 (21x62) with 14 runs scored, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 4 home runs, 16 RBI, 2 HBP, 9 walks and 1 stolen base...during this stretch he leads the American League in runs scored and RBI, while also ranking, T2nd in hits, 3rd in slugging percentage (.645), 5th in on-base percentage (.438), T6th in home runs and 9th in average (.339).

**ROOKIE RECORDS IN APRIL**...**Mitch Haniger** is currently batting .297 (22x74) with 16 runs scored, 6 doubles, 1 triple, 4 home runs, 16 RBI and 12 walks in 19 games during his rookie campaign...among all Mariners rookies in the month of April (min. 50 PA), Haniger currently ranks T1st in walks (also: Jeremy Reed in 2005 & Danny Tartabull in 1986), while also ranking 2nd in extra-base hits (1. Alvin Davis-12 in 1984), doubles (1. Rich Amaral-7 in 1993), on-base percentage (1. Davis-.453 in 1984), slugging percentage (1. Davis-.769 in 1984) and OPS (1. Davis-1.223 in 1984), T2nd in RBI (1. Davis-17 in 1984), 3rd in runs (T1st. Ken Griffey Jr. in 1989 & Ichiro Suzuki in 2001 with 17), T3rd in home runs (1. Alvin Davis-7 in 1984; 2. Greg Pirkel-5 in 1994) and 6th in hits (1. Ichiro-39 in 2005).

**ROAD WARRIOR**...dating back to Aug. 16, 2016, **Robinson Canó** has reached base safely in 27 of his last 32 road games, including 25 games with at least 1 hit, batting .331 (43x130) with 21 runs scored, 6 doubles, 9 home runs, 20 RBI and 9 walks...during this stretch **Canó's** .331 average is the 5th-highest in the American League (min. 100 PA), while also ranking 2nd in hits, T4th in home runs and runs scored, T7th in extra-base hits (along with teammate Nelson Cruz) and 9th in OPS (.953) and slugging percentage (.585)...overall in his career, he is batting .310 (1166x3757) with 554 runs scored, 270 doubles, 16 triples, 133 home runs, 526 RBI and 252 walks in 945 career road games...since making his debut in 2005, **Canó** leads the Major League on the road in hits, doubles, while also ranking 3rd in runs scored and 4th in average and RBI.

**LET THERE BE LIGHT**...Seattle is 3-2 this season during day games and have won 10 of their last 13 day games, dating back to Sept. 10, 2016...overall this season, the Mariners are batting .299 (50x167) with 36 runs scored, 14 doubles, 5 home runs, 33 RBI, 6 HBP, 22 walks and 5 stolen bases in 5 day games in 2017...Seattle has averaged 7.20 runs per game and has recorded at least 10 hit in 3 of 5 games...**Guillermo Heredia** (.500/4x8, 3 R, 2B, HR, RBI), **Robinson Canó** (.474/9x19, 6 R, 2 2B, 2 HR, 6 RBI, 4 BB), **Nelson Cruz** (.471/8x17, 2 R, 2B, 5 RBI, 4 BB), **Kyle Seager** (.429/6x14, 1 R, 3 2B, 1 3B, 7 RBI, 2 BB), **Mitch Haniger** (.400/8x20, 8 R, 3 2B, 2 HR, 10 RBI, 3 BB) and **Jarrod Dyson** (.385/5x13, 3 R, 1 2B, 1 BB, 1 HBP, 2 SB) are each hitting above .385 during day games this season.

**WALKING ON SUNSHINE**...**Nelson Cruz** is batting .344 (67x195) with 30 runs scored, 10 doubles, 11 home runs, 40 RBI, 3 HBP and 25 walks in 53 day games, dating back to the start of the 2016 season...**Cruz's** .344 average during this stretch is the highest in the American League in day games...he also ranks among the AL leaders in OPS (3rd/.983), slugging percentage (5th/.564) and on-base percentage (5th/.419) during day games since last season.

**AGAINST THE A'S**...**Nelson Cruz** currently has an 11-game hitting streak vs. the Athletics dating back to Aug. 13, 2016...during this stretch he is batting .390 (15x40) with 6 runs scored, 4 doubles, 3 home runs, 9 RBI, 5 walks and 2 stolen base...Cruz has also reached base safely in 20 consecutive games vs. the A's, including at least 1 hit in 19 games...during this stretch, dating back to April 9, 2016, he is batting .427 (32x75) with 11 runs scored, 5 doubles, 5 home runs, 14 RBI, 9 walks and 2 stolen bases.

**AS YOU KNOW**...**Kyle Seager** recorded a two out RBI pinch-hit triple in the top of the 8th inning yesterday at the Oakland Coliseum...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...**Seager** became the 21st Mariners player (done 23x) to record a pinch-hit triple in a game?...the last player to record a pinch hit triple was Alex Liddi in the 9th inning on May 20, 2012 vs. the Colorado Rockies...overall in his career as a pinch-hitter, Seager is batting .300 (3x10) with 2 doubles, 1 triple and 2 RBI.
