BOSTON RED SOX (21-20) at OAKLAND A'S (19-23)

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Red Sox were dealt a 3-2, 10-inning, walk-off loss to the A's last night...It was the Sox' 1st loss in extra innings (3-1), their 1st setback when tied after 8 (4-1), and their 2nd walk-off defeat (also 5/5 at MIN).

STATE OF THE SOX: The Red Sox have lost each of their last 2 games, following a 2-game series sweep at STL from Tuesday-Wednesday...BOS is the only team without a losing streak of longer than 2 games in 2017; in fact, 19 teams have had at least 1 losing streak of 4+ games in 2017.

☛ The Sox are in the midst of a stretch in which they will play 30 of 44 games on the road (5/5-6/21).

RISE & SHINE: The Red Sox are 12-5 in day games this season, including 10-2 in their last 12...Their .706 winning percentage in day games ranks 3rd in the majors.

IT'S ALL RIGHT: The Red Sox are scheduled to face a left-handed starting pitcher today for only the 6th time this season...The Sox have faced a right-handed starter in 22 of their last 23 games, including each of their last 5.

☛ BOS batters have only 256 PA vs. LHP, fewest in the AL and 3rd-fewest in MLB...The Sox own the AL's highest OBP (.357) and 2nd-highest AVG (.269) vs. LHP.

LAST ON THE LIST: Drew Pomeranz has faced every MLB team other than OAK in his career...He pitched for the A's in 2014 and 2015, going 10-10 with a 3.08 ERA (53 ER/155.0 IP) in 73 appearances (19 starts).

GETTING DEFENSIVE: The Red Sox have not committed an error in their last 4 games, their longest such streak of the season...BOS has made only 1 error in its last 6 games.

THIS LAND IS MORELAND: Mitch Moreland has homered in each of this series' 2 games...He has 13 HR in only 44 career games at Oakland Coliseum, tied with Mike Trout for the most by a visitor since the start of 2010...Moreland has 11 HR in 29 games here since 2013.

☛ Moreland has 16 doubles, most in the AL and tied for most in the majors...He also ranks T-5th in the AL in XBH (20) and is T-8th in BB (23).

POWER SURGE: The Red Sox have hit 21 HR in May, already surpassing their April total (15).

BAY AREA VS. BAY STATE: The Red Sox have lost each of their last 3 games against the A's, on the heels of a 9-game winning streak vs. OAK from 2015-16.

☛ In 2016, the Red Sox became the first team in AL history to score more than 10 runs in 5 consecutive games vs. a single opponent when they defeated the A's by scores of 14-7, 13-5, 13-3, 16-2, and 11-2 in the clubs' first 5 meetings of the season (source: Elias).

WEST COAST KIDS: Three players on the Red Sox' active 25-man roster were born in CA: Joe Kelly (Anaheim), Noe Ramirez (Los Angeles), and Dustin Pedroia (Woodland).

STRAIGHT A'S: Dustin Pedroia has hit safely in each of his last 22 games vs. OAK...During the streak, which began on 7/14/13, he has posted a .391/.465/.563 batting line against the A's (34-for-87, 6 2B, 3 HR, 12 BB, 10 SO).

☛ Pedroia owns the majors' longest active hitting streak against the A's...In fact, last night he took sole possession of the longest active hitting streak for any player against any single opponent, passing Marcell Ozuna (21 games vs. TB).

SALE-ING ALONG: Chris Sale leads MLB with 95 SO, a 0.79 WHIP, and a .480 opponent OPS...He has struck out 10+ batters in each of his last 8 starts, tied for the longest such streak in a single season since 1900 (source: Elias).

K-ZONE: Red Sox pitchers rank 3rd in the majors in SO/9.0 IP (9.69); BOS starters lead MLB with 9.96 SO/9.0 IP.

☛ Red Sox hitters are averaging 5.8 PA/SO on the season, the highest mark in MLB.

CLOSING TIME: Craig Kimbrel leads the AL and ranks 2nd in the majors with 16.47 SO/9.0 IP (min. 10.0 IP)...He has struck out 36 of 68 batters faced this season (52.9%).

☛ Kimbrel has retired 49 of his last 52 batters faced (16.1 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 31 SO), including 29 of his last 30.

☛ Right-handed hitters are 0-for-35 (2 BB) vs. Kimbrel.

☛ Kimbrel leads the AL and ranks 2nd in MLB in saves (12).

CHRISTIAN VALUES: Christian Vázquez has thrown out each of the last 3 runners attempting to steal against him... Among catchers with at least 100 starts since 1987, he owns the highest caught stealing percentage (44.6, 29 of 65).

REHAB NEWS: David Price, who began the season on the 10-day disabled list with a left elbow strain, made his 1st rehab start last night with Triple-A Pawtucket at Buffalo (2.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 1 BB, 4 SO)...He threw 65 pitches (41 strikes).

☛ Pablo Sandoval (10-day DL, right knee sprain) also began a rehab assignment last night with the PawSox, going 0-for-3 as the DH.

☛ Brock Holt (10-day DL, vertigo) continued his rehab assignment with the PawSox last night, going 1-for-4 with a BB in 9 innings as the LF...In 12 rehab games between Pawtucket and Double-A Portland, he is 9-for-39 (.231) with 1 HR (4 R, 3 RBI, 4 BB).

GOLDEN GLOVE: Dustin Pedroia has not committed an error in his last 74 games (last: 8/19/16 at DET), totaling 262 chances in that time...In that span (since 8/20/16), all other 2nd basemen have combined to make 208 errors.

GOOD, BETTER, BETTS: Mookie Betts is batting .340 (17-for-50) with 5 HR and 5 2B in his last 11 games...In that span, he leads MLB in RBI (14) and XBH (11) and is T-2nd in HR.

☛ Betts has reached base safely in each of his last 41 games vs. AL West opponents (beginning 7/20/15)... He has hit safely in 39 of his last 40 games against the division, including each of his last 11.

RELIEF EFFORTS: The Red Sox' bullpen ranks 4th in the majors with a 2.84 ERA; 17 teams have a bullpen ERA of 4.00+, and 4 have an ERA above 5.00.

CUP OF JOE: Joe Kelly recorded a perfect 8th inning last night at OAK (2 SO)...Each of his first 41 appearances with the Red Sox came as a starter, but in 34 outings in relief—including the postseason—since 7/25/16, he is 4-0 with a 1.29 ERA and a 0.98 WHIP (42.0 IP, 27 H, 6 ER, 14 BB, 37 SO).

GREAT SCOTT: In 25 appearances since his ML debut on 9/2/16, Robby Scott has a 0.55 ERA and a 0.92 WHIP (16.1 IP, 10 H, 1 ER, 5 BB, 14 SO)...Among pitchers to appear in 25+ games in that time, Scott owns the majors' lowest ERA.

TODAY'S START:

- Has allowed 2 or fewer ER in 23 of his 36 starts since the beginning of 2016.
 - His 10.32 SO/9.0 IP ratio ranks 8th in the AL and 15th in the majors (min. 30.0 IP).
 - Since making his Red Sox debut on 7/20/16, holds the 9th-highest SO/9.0 IP ratio (9.64) in the AL and 15th-highest in the majors (min. 90.0 IP).
 - Opponents are 4-for-27 (.148) with RISP against Pomeranz this year...Trails only Yu Darvish (.135) and Kyle Barraclough (.154) for the lowest opponent AVG with RISP (.153; 23-for-150) since the start of the 2016 season (min. 100 AB with RISP).
 - Has allowed only 3 HR to his last 230 LHB faced, dating back to 4/14/16.
 - Is 7-9 with a 3.19 ERA (37 ER/104.1 IP) over 18 road starts since the start of 2016...Ranks among ML qualifiers in that time with a .210 opponent AVG (7th).
 - His 14 road starts with 2 or fewer ER since the beginning of 2016 are tied for the 3rd-most in the majors...Has allowed 2 or fewer ER in 7 of his 9 road starts with BOS.
 - Has posted a 4.02 ERA (28 ER/62.2 IP) with 76 SO and 21 BB over 11 day starts since 4/14/16...Allowed 3 or fewer R in 9 of those outings...Holds a 4.24 ERA (70 ER/148.2 IP) in 29 career day starts.
- Last start:** Received the loss on 5/14 vs. TB, exiting the game prior to the 4th inning with left triceps tightness...Allowed 2 R on 3 H and 3 BB with 2 SO.
- Snapped a career-long streak of 2 or fewer BB in 15 consecutive starts (22 BB, 81 SO).

VS. THE ATHLETICS:

- Has faced every MLB team other than OAK in his career...Pitched for the club in 2014 and 2015, going 10-10 with a 3.08 ERA (53 ER/155.0 IP) over 73 appearances (19 starts).
- Is 5-6 with a 3.61 ERA (39 ER/97.1 IP) and a .229 opponent AVG in 38 career appearances (13 starts) vs. AL West opponents.

2016 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Went 11-12 with a 3.32 ERA (63 ER/170.2 IP), 186 SO, and a .217 opponent AVG over a career-high 30 starts and 1 relief appearance between SD and BOS.
- Was selected by Manager Terry Collins to replace Noah Syndergaard on the National League All-Star roster, his 1st career selection.
- Ranked among ML leaders in opponent AVG (9th, .217), SO/9.0 IP (10th, 9.81), and ERA (20th, 3.35), as well as opponent OBP (17th, .290) and SLG (18th, .368).
- Made 6 starts with 0 ER and 3 or fewer hits allowed in 2016, tied for the 3rd-most in MLB (Kershaw-8, Arrieta-7, Hellickson-6).
- Allowed 2 or fewer ER in 20 of his 30 starts, including 7 GS with 0 ER allowed...Surrendered 3 or fewer ER in 9 of his 13 starts with BOS (14 total appearances).
- His 1.70 ERA (10 ER/53.0 IP) through 5/23/16 was the 3rd-lowest through 9 starts in Padres history behind Randy Jones (1.54 ERA in 1975) and Jake Peavy (1.64 ERA in 2007)...His 31 SO through 4 starts was the 3rd-highest total by a Padre behind Jake Peavy (34 in 2005) and Stan Spencer (32 in 2000).
- At the time of his trade on 7/14/16, led NL starters with a .184 opponent AVG and ranked among ML leaders with a 2.47 ERA (7th) and a .555 opponent OPS (5th)...Was 1 of 4 ML starters with an opponent AVG under .200 and more than 10.0 SO/9.0 IP (10.2), joining Clayton Kershaw, Danny Salazar, and Max Scherzer.
- Allowed 3 or fewer runs in each of his 7 starts from 8/4-9/5/16, a career-long streak...Went 2-2 with a 2.76 ERA (13 ER/42.1 IP) over that stretch (44 SO, 14 BB).

- Is tied for the ML lead with 6 games with 3+ hits this season...Recorded multiple hits and at least 1 RBI in 5 straight road games from 4/23-5/9, going 15-for-24 (.625) with 6 runs, 3 2B, 2 HR, and 8 RBI...The last Red Sox hitter with multiple hits and multiple RBI in 3 straight games was David Ortiz in 2013 (4/27-30).
- Has hit .307 (63-for-205) with an .882 OPS in 232 career PA vs. RHP...26 of his 27 XBH, and 63 of his 75 hits overall, have come off of right-handers.
- Over his career with RISP, has hit .328 (20-for-61) with a .948 OPS, including a .368 clip (14-for-38) with a 1.084 OPS with RISP and 2 outs.
- Has reached base in 31 of 39 games played this year...Was the 1st rookie to lead the Red Sox in hits and RBI through April since Fred Lynn in 1975 (source: Elias).
- Entered the season ranked by *Baseball America* as baseball's No. 1 prospect...In 73 ML games, has hit .290/.361/.452 with 38 runs, 19 2B, 3B, 7 HR, and 37 RBI.
