# BOSTON RED SOX (21-21) at OAKLAND A'S (20-23)

Sunday, May 21, 2017 • 1:05 p.m. PT (4:05 p.m. ET) • Oakland Coliseum • Oakland, CA LHP Eduardo Rodriguez (2-1, 3.05) vs. RHP Andrew Triggs (5-2, 2.12)

**STATE OF THE SOX:** The Red Sox have lost each of their last 3 games, following a 2-game sweep at STL from Tuesday-Wednesday...Prior to this series, BOS had been the only team without a losing streak of longer than 2 games in 2017.

- At 21-21, the Sox are an even .500 for the 1st time since they were 5-5 at the end of play on 4/14...BOS has not been below .500 at any point this season.
- The Sox are in the midst of a stretch in which they will play 30 of 44 games on the road (5/5-6/21).

**CONNECT FOUR:** The Red Sox have been swept in only 2 of their last 75 four-game series: 7/17-20/2015 at LAA and 8/18-21/2014 vs. LAA.

This is the 30th series of 4+ games the Red Sox and A's have played since the franchise moved to Oakland in 1968...The Sox have been swept by the A's in a series of 4+ games only once: 8/10-12/1971 at Fenway Park (4 G).

**RISE & SHINE:** The Red Sox are 12-6 in day games this season, including 10-3 in their last 13...Their .667 winning percentage in day games ranks T-2nd in the majors.

**STEADY EDDIE:** Eduardo Rodriguez has allowed 8 ER in his last 35.1 IP (2.04 ERA)...He has recorded 5 consecutive quality starts, the longest such streak of his career.

- In 22 games (21 starts) since the 2016 All-Star break, Rodriguez has posted a 3.18 ERA and held opponents to a .209 AVG (119.0 IP, 90 H, 42 ER, 126 SO).
- Rodriguez's only career start against the A's came on 9/4/16, when he did not allow a hit until surrendering an infield single to Marcus Semien with 2 outs in the 8th inning...He finished with 1 hit allowed over 8.0 scoreless innings in the Sox' 1-0 loss.

**GETTING DEFENSIVE:** The Red Sox have committed only 1 error in their last 5 games.

**THIS LAND IS MORELAND:** Mitch Moreland has homered in each of his 2 games played in this series...He has 13 HR in only 44 career games at Oakland Coliseum, tied with Mike Trout for the most by a visitor since the start of 2010... Moreland has 11 HR in 29 games here since 2013.

 Moreland has 16 doubles, tied for the ML lead...He also ranks T-6th in the AL in XBH (20) and T-9th in BB (23).

**POWER SURGE:** The Red Sox have hit 22 HR in May, already surpassing their April total (15).

**BAY AREA VS. BAY STATE:** The Red Sox have lost each of their last 4 games against the A's, on the heels of a 9-game winning streak vs. OAK from 2015-16.

In 2016, the Red Sox became the first team in AL history to score more than 10 runs in 5 consecutive games vs. a single opponent when they defeated the A's by scores of 14-7, 13-5, 13-3, 16-2, and 11-2 in the clubs' first 5 meetings of the season (source: Elias).

**STRAIGHT A'S:** Dustin Pedroia has hit safely in each of his last 23 games vs. OAK...During the streak, which began on 7/14/13, he has posted a .396/.466/.560 batting line against the A's (36-for-91, 6 2B, 3 HR, 12 BB, 10 SO).

Pedroia owns the majors' longest active hitting streak against the A's...In fact, on Friday he took sole possession of the longest active hitting streak for any player against any single opponent, passing Marcell Ozuna (21 games vs. TB).

SALE-ING ALONG: Chris Sale leads MLB with 95 SO, 65.2 IP, a 0.79 WHIP, and a .480 opponent OPS...He has struck out 10+ batters in each of his last 8 starts, tied for the longest such streak in a single season since 1900 (source: Elias).

\*Martinez recorded 10+ SO in each of his final 8 starts of 1999 and in his first 2 starts of 2000. In between, he made 1 relief appearance on 10/2/99.

**K-ZONE:** Red Sox pitchers rank 2nd in the majors in SO/9.0 IP (9.73); BOS starters lead MLB with 10.02 SO/9.0 IP.

 Red Sox hitters are averaging 5.7 PA/SO on the season, the highest mark in MLB.

**CLOSING TIME:** Craig Kimbrel leads the AL and ranks 2nd in the majors with 16.47 SO/9.0 IP (min. 15.0 IP)...He has struck out 36 of 68 batters faced this season (52.9%).

- Kimbrel has retired 49 of his last 52 batters faced (16.1 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 31 SO), including 29 of his last 30.
- Right-handed hitters are 0-for-35 (2 BB) vs. Kimbrel.
- Kimbrel has 12 saves, tied for most in the AL.

**CHRISTIAN VALUES:** Christian Vázquez has thrown out 3 of the last 4 runners attempting to steal against him... Among catchers with at least 100 starts since 1987, he owns the highest caught stealing percentage (43.9, 29 of 66).

**GOLDEN GLOVE:** Dustin Pedroia has not committed an error in his last 75 games (last: 8/19/16 at DET), totaling 267 chances in that time...In that span (since 8/20/16), all other 2nd basemen have combined to make 211 errors.

**GOOD, BETTER, BETTS:** Mookie Betts is batting .315 (17-for-54) with 5 HR and 5 2B in his last 12 games...In that span, he leads MLB in RBI (tied, 14) and XBH (tied, 11).

Yesterday, Betts (0-for-4) snapped a streak of reaching base in 41 consecutive games vs. AL West opponents (began 7/20/15)...He had hit safely in 39 of his previous 40 games against the division, including in each of his previous 11.

**CUP OF JOE:** Joe Kelly recorded a perfect 8th inning Friday night at OAK (2 SO)...Each of his first 41 appearances with the Red Sox came as a starter, but in 34 outings in relief—including the postseason—since 7/25/16, he is 4-0 with a 1.29 ERA and a 0.98 WHIP (42.0 IP, 27 H, 6 ER, 14 BB, 37 SO).

**GREAT SCOTT:** In 25 appearances since his ML debut on 9/2/16, Robby Scott has a 0.55 ERA and a 0.92 WHIP (16.1 IP, 10 H, 1 ER, 5 BB, 14 SO)...Among pitchers to appear in 25+ games in that time, Scott owns the majors' lowest ERA.

In 2017, left-handed hitters are 1-for-17 (.059) against Scott (1 BB, 5 SO)...He has not allowed an XBH to a lefty in his ML career (4-for-29, 1 BB, 8 SO).

**REHAB NEWS:** David Price, who began the season on the 10-day disabled list with a left elbow strain, made his 1st rehab start with Triple-A Pawtucket at Buffalo on Friday (2.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 1 BB, 4 SO)...He threw 65 pitches (41 strikes).

- Pablo Sandoval (10-day DL, right knee sprain) has gone 1-for-6 in 2 rehab games with the PawSox, 1 as a DH and 1 at 3B.
- Brock Holt (10-day DL, vertigo) is 9-for-42 (.214) with 1 HR in 13 rehab games between Pawtucket and Double-A Portland (4 R, 3 RBI, 5 BB).

- ls appearing in his 50th career game (all with BOS)...His 245 career SO are the 3rd-most by a Sox pitcher within their first 50 career games since 1913 (Clemens-314, Matsuzaka-287)
- ♣ Has won each of his last 2 decisions (4/23 at BAL & 5/16 at STL)...Has won 3 consecutive decisions once in his career (8/18-9/6/15).
- ♣ Has tossed 5 consecutive quality starts (2-0, 2.40 ERA, 1.03 WHIP)...Is both his longest career streak of quality outings and longest career streak of starts with 6.0+ IP.
- Has allowed only 8 ER in his last 35.1 IP (2.04 ERA).
- His .207 opponent AVG (30-for-145) ranks 7th in the AL and 12th in MLB (min. 150 BF). Has given up only 22 hits to his last 142 batters faced (22-for-124, .177 AVG, 13 BB, 41 SO).
- RHB are 20-for-113 (.177) vs. Rodriguez this year...Trails only teammate Chris Sale (.168) for the lowest mark among ML southpaws (min. 100 RHB faced).
- Has not given up a HR to the last 106 LHB faced (last Brett Gardner on 7/16/16).
- Has allowed 4 or fewer hits in 11 of his last 16 starts dating back to 8/11/16.
- Ranks 7th in the AL and 13th in MLB (min. 35.0 IP) with a 10.23 SO/9.0 IP ratio.
- Over 22 appearances (21 starts) since the 2016 All-Star break, has posted a 3.18 ERA (42 ER/119.0 IP) and a .209 opponent AVG...Ranks among ML leaders in that time (min. 100.0 IP) in opponent AVG (8th), opponent SLG (8th, .346), ERA (13th), and SO/9.0 IP (14th, 9.53).
- In 14 road appearances (13 starts) since the 2016 All-Star break, has posted a 2.44 ERA (22 ER/77.1 IP), a .177 opponent AVG (48-for-271), and a 0.94 WHIP.
- Has the 6th-most IP (77.1) on the road among all AL pitchers since the 2016 All-Star break...His 79 SO on the road during that time are tied for the 7th-most in the AL.

- His 6 road starts with 3 or fewer hits since the beginning of 2016 are the 2nd-most in the AL (Hector Santiago-8) and tied for the 5th-most in the majors.
- In his last 4 road starts, is 2-0 with a 2.63 ERA (7 ER/24.0 IP), a .193 opponent AVG (16-for-83), and a 1.00 WHIP.
- Ranks among AL qualifiers on the road this year with a .204 opponent AVG (10th).

Last start: Earned the win on 5/16 at STL, allowing 3 R on 5 H and 2 BB with 5 SO...Recorded 5+ SO in his career-long 10th consecutive start (25 BB, 74 SO).

♣ Was his 4th consecutive road start with 6.0+ IP, tying a career-long streak (also 5/28/15-6/30/15).

- 4 Carried a no-hitter through 7.2 IP before allowing an infield single to Marcus Semien in his only career start vs. the Athletics on 9/4 at OAK (8.0 IP, H, 2 BB, 5 SO).
- In 5 career starts vs. AL West opponents, is 1-1 with a 2.83 ERA (9 ER/28.2 IP), a .183 opponent AVG (19-for-104), and a 1.05 WHIP.

#### **CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:**

- ls 14-2 with a 1.92 ERA, a .191 opponent AVG, and a 0.92 WHIP in 26 starts when pitching at least 6.0 innings (169.0 IP, 116 H, 36 ER, 137 SO)...Allowed 3 earned runs or fewer in each of those 26 outings, 2 earned runs or fewer in 22, and 1 or 0 earned runs in 16.

- Snapped a 26-AB hitless skid with a 2-for-4 performance Friday night...In the 25 games prior to the skid, had hit .376 (38-for-101) with 19 R, 7 2B, 4 HR, 18 RBI, and a .989 OPS...Ranks among AL leaders with 44 hits (T-17th) and 12 multi-hit games (T-13th).
- Is tied for 2nd in the majors with 6 games with 3+ hits this season...Recorded multiple hits and at least 1 RBI in 5 straight road games from 4/23-5/9, going 15-for-24 (.625) with 6 runs, 3 2B, 2 HR, and 8 RBI...The last Red Sox hitter with multiple hits and multiple RBI in 3 straight games was David Ortiz in 2013 (4/27-30).
- Has hit .304 (63-for-207) with an .874 OPS in 234 career PA vs. RHP...26 of his 27 XBH, and 63 of his 75 hits overall, have come off of right-handers.


