OAKLAND NOTES

- **Andrew Triggs** tied his career-high for walks (3); all three walks came in the first inning...in six innings, he threw a career-high 105 pitches...leads the Athletics pitching staff in wins (5).
- **Khris Davis** has now struckout at least once in a career-high 21 consecutive games (33 strikeouts total), a franchise record for a non-pitcher...he snapped an 0-for-12 hitless streak with a single and RBI in the eighth inning.
- In his second game after being recalled, **Mark Canha** recorded his first multi-hit game of the season...he had two singles (second and fifth inning)...his last multi-hit game was 10/4/2015 vs Seattle (2).
- **Chad Pinder** hit his second home run of the season in the fifth inning...he recorded the go-ahead RBI, his first of the season.
- The Athletics are now 12-6 when out-homer the opponent (versus 1-7 when going homerless)...have hit 11 home runs in the last five games and have 45 for the season.
- The Athletics bullpen did not allow a run in the three game series, tossing 11 scoreless innings...the bullpen has tossed 14 straight scoreless innings since Ryan Dull allowed a two-run homer on Sunday afternoon.
- **Rajai Davis** recorded one steal in the contest...he now has 120 and needs one more to tie M. Davis for eighth most steals in Oakland history.
- Adam Rosales snapped a seven game hitting streak in which he went 8-for-26 (.308) with four RBI.
- Oakland has now won two consecutive series for the second time this season...the last time the A's won back-to-back series was 4/17-4/23/17 (Texas, Seattle).

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- Danny Espinosa extended his hitless streak to 34 at-bats, the longest hitless streak of his career.
- **Yunel Escobar** (0-for-3) snapped a three-game hitting streak.
- **Jesse Chavez** recorded his first career start against Oakland (eighth career game vs Oakland) after appearing in 101 games for the Athletics from 2012-2015...in eight games versus Oakland, he is 2-1 with a 1.98 ERA (13.2 innings, 3 earned runs).
- The Angels have dropped their third straight series after winning three in a row entering the month of May...they are 3-6 in the month of May and in that span.
