### BOSTON RED SOX (21-18) at OAKLAND A'S (17-23)

Thursday, May 18, 2017 • 7:05 p.m. PT (10:05 p.m. ET) • Oakland Coliseum • Oakland, CA RHP Hector Velázquez (MLB Debut) vs. RHP Sonny Gray (0-1, 3.78)

**STATE OF THE SOX:** The Red Sox have won each of their last 2 games, as well as 3 of their last 4...They are the only team without a losing streak of longer than 2 games in 2017.

- The Red Sox have come from behind in each of their last 3 wins: 5/13 vs. TB, 5/16 at STL, and 5/17 at STL.
- The Sox are in the midst of a stretch in which they will play 30 of 44 games on the road (5/5-6/21).

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Red Sox defeated the Cardinals in STL last night, 5-4, in 13 innings...BOS trailed, 4-0, before scoring 2 runs in the 7th, 2 in the 8th, and 1 in the 13th.

- 9 Red Sox pitchers combined to hold the Cardinals scoreless in the final 11 innings.
- Chris Young broke the 4-4 tie with a 2-out, pinch-hit, RBI single...It was the 1st go-ahead, pinch-hit RBI by a Red Sox hitter as late as the 13th inning since David Ortiz hit a pinch-hit HR in the 14th on 4/27/03 at ANA.

**EXTRA, EXTRA!:** The Red Sox have won each of their 3 extra-inning games this season: 4/5 vs. PIT (12), 4/20 at TOR (10), and 5/17 at STL (13).

**NO NEED TO PANIC:** Last night marked the Sox' 3rd win this season when trailing after 7 innings...In 2016, their 3rd such win didn't come until 6/24 at TEX, their 73rd game.

- The Sox have 7 wins when tied or trailing after 7 innings; the Angels (7) and Blue Jays (8) are the only other teams in the majors with as many such wins.
- BOS is 4-0 when tied after 8 innings, tied for the most such wins in the majors...The only other team without a loss in that scenario is NYY (1-0).

**EIGHT MEN OUT:** The Red Sox used 8 relief pitchers last night, marking only the 21st time since 1913 a team had as many as 8 pitchers record at least 1 out and allow 0 runs (1st such game for BOS)...SEA was the 1st team to accomplish that feat (9/25/92 at TEX, 8 pitchers, 16 innings).

**RELIEF EFFORTS:** Red Sox relievers pitched 10.0 scoreless innings in the club's 2-game series at STL, recording 3.0 IP on Tuesday and 7.0 IP last night...The last time the Sox' bullpen threw 7.0+ scoreless innings in a game was 9/25/11 at NYY (8.0), a 7-4 win over the Yankees (14 inn.).

The Sox' bullpen ranks 3rd in the majors with a 2.74 ERA; 18 teams have a bullpen ERA of 4.00+, and 5 have an ERA above 5.00...BOS relievers have thrown 125.0 innings, 10th-fewest in the majors.

**THREE'S COMPANY:** Xander Bogaerts recorded 2 triples last night; his 4 triples on the season lead the AL...He became the 1st Red Sox SS in nearly 70 years with multiple triples in a game (last: Johnny Pesky on 7/20/47-G2).

Only 10 AL players have recorded multiple triples in a game in 2016 and 2017, 4 of whom are Red Sox: Mookie Betts (4/22/16 at HOU), Jackie Bradley Jr. (4/30/16 vs. NYY), Blake Swihart (5/25/16 vs. COL), and Bogaerts.

**LINE 'EM UP:** The top of the Red Sox' batting order has been the same in each of the club's last 10 games (beginning 5/6): Mookie Betts, Dustin Pedroia, Xander Bogaerts, and Andrew Benintendi...In that time, BOS leads the majors in OPS (.851) and ranks 2nd in runs per game (6.6).

In that 10-game span, the Sox' first 3 hitters—Betts, Pedroia, and Bogaerts—hit a combined .321 with a .403 OBP (42-for-131, 17 BB, HBP).

**GOOD, BETTER, BETTS:** Mookie Betts is batting .366 (15-for-41) with 5 HR and 5 2B in his last 9 games...In that span, he leads the majors in HR (tied), RBI (14), and XBH (10).

Betts has reached base safely in each of his last 39 games vs. AL West opponents (beginning 7/20/15), hitting safely in 37 of his last 38.

- In 5 starts with Triple-A Pawtucket this season, Velázquez is 2-1 with a 1.55 ERA (5 ER/29.0 IP)... He threw 21.1 consecutive scoreless innings over a span of 4 starts from 4/19-5/13, tossing 6.0 perfect innings on 4/30 vs. Gwinnett.
- The only other Red Sox pitcher ever to make his ML debut as a starter in OAK is Brian Denman (8/22/82).

**BAY AREA VS. BAY STATE:** The Red Sox have won 9 of their last 10 games against the A's since 5/13/15.

- In 2016, the Red Sox became the first team in AL history to score more than 10 runs in 5 consecutive games vs. a single opponent when they defeated the A's by scores of 14-7, 13-5, 13-3, 16-2, and 11-2 in the clubs' first 5 meetings of the season (source: Elias).
- The Sox totaled 40 runs on 48 hits in their 3-game series vs. OAK from 5/9-11/16, scoring 13+ runs in 3 straight games for the 1st time in franchise history.

**STRAIGHT A'S:** Dustin Pedroia has hit safely in each of his last 20 games vs. OAK...The only Red Sox with hit streaks as long against the A's since the franchise moved to Oakland in 1968 are Jim Rice (22, 1979-81) & Jerry Remy (20, 1978-81).

- During his streak, which began on 7/14/13, Pedroia has posted a .397/.478/.590 batting line against the A's (31-for-78, 6 2B, 3 HR, 12 BB, 9 SO).
- Pedroia owns the majors' longest active hitting streak against the A's...In fact, the only player with a longer active hitting streak against any single opponent is Marcell Ozuna (21 games vs. TB).

**POWER SURGE:** The Red Sox have hit 19 HR in May, already surpassing their April total (15)...They have hit 15 HR in their last 10 games.

**YOU GO, WE GO:** Jackie Bradley Jr. has homered and recorded 2 hits in each of his last 2 games, both BOS wins...He has 3 HR in his last 7 games and is 6 for his last 15 (.400).

BOS is 35-7 (.833) all-time when Bradley homers, 57-21 (.731) when he records 2+ hits, and 36-3 (.923) when he scores 2+ runs...During Bradley's 29-game hitting streak in 2016, the Sox had MLB's best record (21-8).

**GOLDEN GLOVE:** Dustin Pedroia has not committed an error in his last 72 games (last: 8/19/16 at DET), totaling 255 chances in that time...In that span (since 8/20/16), all other 2nd basemen have combined to make 202 errors.

**CLOSING TIME:** Craig Kimbrel leads the AL and ranks 2nd in the majors with 16.9 SO/9.0 IP (min. 10.0 IP)...He has struck out 35 of 65 batters faced this season (53.8%), including 15 of his last 21.

- Kimbrel has retired 46 of his last 49 batters faced (15.1 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 30 SO), including 26 of his last 27.
- Right-handed hitters are 0-for-32 (2 BB) vs. Kimbrel.
- Kimbrel leads the AL and ranks 2nd in MLB in saves (12).

**K-ZONE:** Red Sox pitchers rank 4th in the majors in SO/9.0 IP (9.57); BOS starters lead MLB with 9.93 SO/9.0 IP.

Red Sox hitters are averaging 5.9 PA/SO on the season, the highest mark in MLB.

**GREAT SCOTT:** Robby Scott struck out the only batter he faced last night...ln 25 career ML appearances, he has a 0.55 ERA and a 0.92 WHIP (16.1 IP, 10 H, 1 ER, 5 BB, 14 SO)...He has allowed only 1 hit and 1 BB in his last 9 games (6.0 IP).

- Is making his Major League debut after being selected to the 25-man roster from Triple-A Pawtucket earlier today.
- ♣ Will be the oldest pitcher (28 years, 173 days) to start for the Red Sox in their ML debut since Daisuke Matsuzaka (28 years, 230 days on 4/5/07 at KC).
- Leads the International League and ranks 10th among all qualified minor league pitchers with a 0.79 WHIP.
- His 1.55 ERA is the 2nd-lowest in the International League and 4th-lowest in Triple-A.
- Has limiting opposing hitters to a .180 AVG this season...Allowed 4 or fewer hits in each of his first 4 starts with Pawtucket.
- Has allowed 2 ER in 24.1 IP (0.74 ERA) over his last 4 starts with Pawtucket, including 21.1 consecutive scoreless IP from 4/19-5/13.
- Tossed 6.0 perfect IP on 4/30 against Gwinnett.
- Has issued 2 or fewer BB in each of his 5 outings with the PawSox this season, issuing 0 BB over 6.0+ IP in 2 of his last 3 starts (6.0 IP on 4/30 vs. GWN & 7.0 IP on 5/13 vs. ROC).

Last start: Received the loss on 5/13 vs. ROC despite allowing 2 ER over 7.0 IP (7 H, 3 SO).

#### **2017 SPRING TRAINING:**

Went 0-3 with a 9.00 ERA (11 ER/11.0 IP) in 5 appearances (2 starts) for BOS.

#### 2016 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Went 5-1 with a 2.47 ERA (36 ER/131.1 IP), 120 SO, and 16 BB over a career-high-tying 22 starts for Monclova of the Mexican League while on loan from Campeche.
- Allowed 4 or fewer ER in each of his outings, including 2 or fewer in 15 of them.
- Made 1 postseason appearance for Monclova, starting Game 2 in the opening round against Tijuana...Allowed 2 hits over 5.0 scoreless innings and left the game with a 2-0 lead in an eventual 4-2, 11-inning loss.
- Following the season, named Mexican Pacific League Pitcher of the Year...Made 14 starts for Navojoa, leading the league in wins (9-3), SO (87), and W-L % (.750)...Also ranked among leaders in ERA (2nd, 2.32).
- unde 2 starts for Mexico in the Caribbean Series...Earned the win on 2/2 vs. the Dominican Republic (5.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R, ER, 3 BB, 7 SO)...Pitched 6.0 scoreless IP in the championship game vs. Puerto Rico on 2/7, a 1-0, 10-inning loss (5 H, 4 SO).

- The Red Sox purchased his contract from Campeche (Mexican League) on 2/18/17.
- ln 7 seasons in the Mexican League with Campeche (2010-15) and Monclova (2016), went 43-29 with a 3.76 ERA (287 ER/687.1 IP) in 136 appearances (120 starts)...Also pitched in the Mexican Pacific Winter League following each of those 7 seasons, posting a 4.07 ERA (189 ER/417.2 IP) in 101 games (75 starts) for Obregon (2010-11) and Navojoa (2012-16).
- 4 157 of his 158 regular season appearances between the Mexican League, Mexican Pacific Winter League, and Pawtucket since the start of 2012 have been starts.
- Named Mexican Pacific Winter League Pitcher of the Year in the 2016-17 and 2013-14 offseasons.
- 🖊 Honored as the 2010 Mexican League Rookie of the Year, posting a 2.93 ERA (30 ER/92.0 IP) in 29 games (14 GS).

- Has hit .303 (61-for-201) with an .873 OPS in 227 career PA vs. RHP...25 of his 26 XBH, and 61 of his 73 hits overall, have come off of right-handers.
- 🦶 Over his career with RISP, has hit .333 (20-for-60) with a .954 OPS, including a .368 clip (14-for-38) with a 1.072 OPS with RISP and 2 outs.
- 🦶 Has reached base in 30 of 38 games played this year...Was the 1st rookie to lead the Red Sox in hits and RBI through April since Fred Lynn in 1975 (source: Elias).
- Entered the season ranked by Baseball America as baseball's No. 1 prospect...In 72 ML games, has hit .286/.356/.447 with 38 runs, 18 2B, 3B, 7 HR, and 37 RBI.
