#### OAKLAND NOTES

- A's hurler **Kendall Graveman** collected his fifth quality start of the season, throwing six innings, allowing two runs on six hits...his five quality starts are second on the team behind Andrew Triggs.
- A's bullpen has not allowed a run in 21 straight innings at home... the last run they allowed was in the sixth inning on May 7 vs. Detroit.
- **Trevor Plouffe** extended his hitting streak to 10 games, first double digit hitting streak since 2015...is batting .405 (15-for-37) during that span.
- **Ryon Healy** has hit safely in each of his last 12 starts when playing a position on the field...is batting .417 (20-for-48) with four homers and 10 RBI during that span.
- **Mark Canha** recorded his third multi-hit game of the season with a 3-for-4 night...since being recalled on 5/9, he is batting .476 (10-for-21)...tallied his first triple since 10/3/15 at Seattle in the fifth inning.
- In the 10th inning, **Mark Canha** recorded his first career Walk-Off homer, his second career game-ending RBI (last, August 2, 2015 vs. Cleveland).
- In the seventh inning, **Josh Phegley** threw out Mookie Betts, recording his third straight caught stealing...on the season, he is 4-for-9.

#### BOSTON NOTES

- **Chris Sale** extended his double digit strikeout streak to eight games with 10 strikeouts on the night, matching his own single-season modern day MLB record from 2015, which he shares with Pedro Martinez (1999)...he leads the MLB with 95 punch outs.
- With a double in the second inning, **Andrew Benintendi** snapped an 0-for-26 hitless streak...he recorded his first hit since May 9.
- **Mookie Betts** doubled in the third, extending his on base streak against AL West opponents to 41 games, which started on 7/20/15... has hit safely in 39 of his last 40 games against the division.
- **Mitch Moreland** hit homers in consecutive games for the first time this season, he accomplished the feat four times last year.
- **Dustin Pedroia** has hit safely in each of his last 22 games vs Oakland...during the streak, which began on 7/14/13, Pedroia has posted a .390 batting average (34-for-87), six doubles and three home runs.
- **Pedroia** owns the majors' longest active hitting streak against the A's at 22 games...he matched Jim Rice for the longest hitting streak by a Red Sox vs. Oakland.
- The Red Sox challenged a play in the seventh inning in which Mookie Betts was called out at second...the call stood...the review took 1:56.
