FISH BITES

The Marlins conclude a six-game West Coast road swing with the finale of this quick two-game set against the Oakland Athletics at 3:35 p.m. EST. RHP **Edinson Volquez** (0-6, 4.87) has faced Oakland six times in his career with a 3-3 record and 4.88 ERA. Volquez is going up against RHP **Sonny Gray** (1-1, 3.97), who has no record and a 9.00 ERA in one prior start against the Fish. Miami opened their current road trip by dropping three of four games against the Los Angeles Dodgers. The Fish wrapped up a nine-game homestand last Wednesday against St. Louis (0-3), Atlanta (1-2), and Houston (0-3). On Friday, the Marlins will open a 10-game homestand with the first of three games against the Los Angeles Angels (May 26-28), followed by three against the Philadelphia Phillies (May 29-31), and four vs. the Arizona Diamondbacks (June 1-4).

LAST NIGHT IN OAKLAND

Miami jumped out to a 7-1 lead after three innings, and ended up coming away with an 11-9 win over the home-standing Oakland Athletics, recording a season-high 19 hits in the process. **Dee Gordon** started the night for Miami with an infield single, stole second and moved to third on an error, and scored on **Giancarlo Stanton's** RBI single to left. In the second, **Ichiro Suzuki** pulled a two-out, two-run single to right field to put the Fish up 3-0, then scored on a RBI triple by Gordon. Following a second-inning Oakland run, the Marlins plated three more to take a 7-1 lead after three. With the score 7-4 in the fifth, **Derek Dietrich** laced an RBI single to center to extend Miami's lead to 8-4. **Justin Bour** continued his run at the plate, belting his team-leading 12th home run to lead off the seventh. Bour finished the night with a career high-tying four hits. Gordon and Stanton contributed three hits each, while **J.T. Realmuto**, Dietrich and **JT Riddle** each had two-hit affairs. **José Ureña** (2-2) allowed a season-high six runs over 5.0 innings, giving up four hits and two walks while striking out three.

AGAINST THE ATHLETICS

The Marlins and Athletics last squared off in 2014 when the A's swept the Fish in a three-game series from June 27-29 at Marlins Park. This series will mark the third time the Marlins have visited the Coliseum. The Marlins dropped two of three from June 20-22, 2008, and took two of three from June 28-30, 2011.

FULL BOUR

Prior to collecting a career-high four hits on April 30, **Justin Bour** was batting .184 (14x76) with two doubles, three home runs, nine RBI and a .267 on-base percentage. Since April 30, the big lefty has hit at a .378 clip (28x74) with four doubles, nine home runs, 21 RBI, and a .459 OBP. In that time, he is tied with Oakland's Yonder Alonso for the Major League lead in home runs and ranks third in the Majors in RBI. Among NL first basemen in that same span, he leads in hits, average, home runs and RBI. Last night, Bour homered for the eighth time in his last 12 games, tying **Giancarlo Stanton** (eight times), Dan Uggla (six times), Cliff Floyd, and Gary Sheffield for the most home runs in a 12-game span in Club history, according to *Stats LLC*.

INTERLEAGUE NOTES

The Marlins have gone 3-8 in Interleague Play this season, facing off against Seattle (1-2), Tampa Bay (1-3), Houston (0-3) and Oakland (1-0). Last year, Miami was 6-14 against the American League, playing the Central and Tampa Bay. The Fish have an overall record of 178-183 against the AL all-time. Miami leads all National League teams in hits (3,258), doubles (644), runs scored (1,642) and RBI (1,558) since the inception of Interleague Play.

MARLINS AND THE DH

Marlins designated hitters have combined for a .245 (179x730) mark, with 19 home runs in 182 Interleague games all time; the 179 hits are the second-most among NL teams, behind only St. Louis (191). This season, Miami's designated hitters are 7x26 (.269), with the most hits of any NL club, including one home run (**Giancarlo Stanton**, April 19 in Seattle). Last year, Marlins' designated hitters combined for a .298 average, fifth-best among NL teams, with one home run - by Stanton on June 28 at Detroit. The Marlins have used four different players at DH this season: Stanton (.500; 4x8), **Marín Prado** (.200; 1x5), **J.T. Realmuto** (.250; 1x4) and **Marcell Ozuna** (.111; 1x9). In 11 career games as DH, Stanton has posted a .311 average (14x45) with three home runs and 11 RBI.

UP NEXT

The Marlins return to South Florida after today's contest and will open a three-game series against the Los Angeles Angels on Friday. The series will mark the Angels first time at Marlins Park, as they are the last Major League team to visit the venue. The last time the Marlins and Angels faced off was from August 25-27, 2015, as the Fish dropped two of three in Anaheim. Miami trails the all-time series, 4-8, and have gone 2-4 against the Halos in South Florida.

NOT THE STREAK TO BEAT

Edinson Volquez has started his Marlins career with six consecutive losses, marking the longest single-season skid of his career. For streaks spanning multiple seasons, his current run of seven losses, dating back to September 15, 2016, is also a career long. His six-game slide to open the season is tied with Vladimir Núñez for the second-longest such streak to open a season in Marlins' history. Joe Fontenot owns the Club record with seven consecutive losses to open his 1998 campaign.

THREE DEEP

Miami's **Justin Bour** (12), **Marcell Ozuna** (11) and **Giancarlo Stanton** (11) have combined to hit 34 home runs this season. Among team trios in the Majors, that is tied for the fourth-highest total, with Oakland's **Chris Davis** (13), **Yonder Alonso** (13) and **Ryon Healy** (8). Washington's 36 from **Bryce Harper** (14), **Ryan Zimmerman** (13), and **Daniel Murphy** (9) lead MLB, while Cincinnati's **Scott Schebler** (13), **Joey Votto** (12), and **Eugenio Suarez** (10), and Colorado's **Mark Reynolds** (12), **Nolan Arenado** (12), and **Charlie Blackmon** (11) are tied for second with 35. - *Stats LLC*

THE REAL DEAL

J.T. Realmuto has recorded at least one hit in each of his last 15 road games, marking the longest active road hitting streak in the Majors. His current road hitting streak is the longest in Club history by a catcher, besting his own 11-game streak from July 4-26, 2015. Miami's longest road hitting streak by any player in Franchise history is 27 games by Luis Castillo from May 5-July 16, 2002. - *Stats LLC*

SERIES NOTES

- The last time the A's and Marlins met in South Florida, in 2014, Oakland came away with a three-game sweep, including one-run wins in the final two meetings. The second game was an extra-inning contest, which Oakland won 7-6 thanks to Josh Donaldson's RBI single in the top of the 14th inning. Miami loaded the bases in the bottom of the frame, but the A's held on for the win. **Giancarlo Stanton** went 3x6 with an RBI and a run scored in the game.
- Miami won the first game between the two franchises, 13-2, on June 3, 2003. Six hitters in the Marlins' starting lineup had multiple hits, including starting pitcher Brad Penny, who went 2x4 with three RBI.

THIS DAY IN MARLINS HISTORY

MAY 24

Kevin Millar (#GotHeeem) drove in the game-winning run in the top of the ninth with a three-run inside-the-park home run to push the Fish past the Cubs in **1999**. The Marlins found themselves down 5-3 entering the ninth at Wrigley Field, but answered with four runs to take the 7-5 victory. The ITP home run by Millar was the first of two in his career and seventh in Marlins history at the time.

Volquez is making his ninth start with Miami, and is looking to snap a six-game losing streak to start 2017. Has posted a season record of 0-6 with a 4.87 ERA (40.2 ip/22 er) in his eight starts. Missed one start after landing on DL following May 2 start against Pittsburgh with a right thumb blister. Reinstated prior to last start on May 13 vs. Atlanta.

Current six-game losing streak the longest in-season skid of his career. For streaks spanning multiple seasons, his current seven-game streak is also a career-long.

Is making his seventh career start against the Athletics. After dropping his first two career starts against them, both in 2006, he went on a three-start winning streak, from Sept. 7, 2007 through April 15, 2016. Posted a 0.95 ERA (19.0 ip/2 er) in that time and held the A's to a .125 (8x64) average, with just three extra-base hits (1r, 2 2b). That winning streak was snapped the last time he faced Oakland, however, as he allowed nine runs (eight earned) on seven hits over 3.1 innings in a 1-5 loss with Kansas City on Sept. 15, 2016.

Prior to his last start, on May 18 at the Dodgers, was holding right-handed batters to a .208 (10x48) average, with no home runs. Allowed LA righties to go 3x6 with a home run against him, however, upping season mark to .241 (13x54).

Left-handed batters, meanwhile, are hitting .293 (29x99) against him this season, with four home runs.

Career marks in 28 games (25 starts) vs. AL West opponents are 9-12 with a 6.39 ERA. Has been saddled with a loss in three straight games against the AL West, and has not completed the fourth inning in his last two.

In Marlins debut on Opening Day, tossed 5.0 scoreless innings against Washington, surrendering four hits and a walk while striking out six in no decision. Was fifth career Opening Day start. Opening Day record held at 1-2 while ERA dropped to 5.04 (25.0/14) from 6.30. In addition, went 2x2 at the plate, marking first career multi-hit game.

Took loss in second start of season, April 9 at Citi Field, allowing season-high five runs (four earned) on seven hits, while striking out a season-best seven over 6.0 innings.

Dropped second decision of season on April 19 at Safeco Field against Seattle, allowing four runs on five hits and four walks, with three strikeouts, over 3.0 innings.

Went just 4.1 innings on May 2 vs. Tampa Bay, after being removed due to a blister on his right thumb. Took loss after allowing three runs on three hits and a career-high eight walks, while striking out a season-high nine. Placed on 10-day disabled list on May 3 with a right thumb blister.

In that start, became only pitcher in modern era (since 1900) to record eight walks and nine strikeouts in fewer than 5.0 innings. - Elias
