OAKLAND NOTES

- Jed Lowrie matched a career high with four RBI today...it is the eighth time in his career that he has driven in four runs in a game (last: 9/6/2015 vs. Minnesota).
- Khris Davis singled in the seventh inning, ending a 15-at bat hitless
- Ryon Healy collected three-or-more extra-base hits in a game for the first time in his career (two home runs, two doubles)...it was his first four-hit game of his career.
- Healy's four extra-base hits tied a franchise record (last: Matt Holliday on 7/20/2009 vs. Minnesota with two doubles, two home runs).
- Healy aslo hit multiple home runs in a game for the first time of his
- The Athletics scored a season-high 10 runs (previous: nine runs four
- Today marks the second time in Oakland history the Athletics had two players with two doubles and a homer (Jackson and Bando, 7/20/1969).
- The Athletics challenged a play at third in the seventh inning...the ruling on the field was overturned and the runner was called out advancing...the time of review was 42 seconds.
