OAKLAND NOTES

- **Matt Joyce** extended his hitting streak to seven games with a double in the sixth inning...is 16-for-40 (.499) over his last 13 games... has eight hits and four walks in his last 16 plate appearances.
- **Adam Rosales** extended his hitting streak to four games...he is batting .308 (8-for-26) in 13 games in June.
- Including his double in the sixth inning, **Jed Lowrie** now has 23 doubles on the season...he entered the game ranked second in the American League with 22...he is batting .319 (36-for-113) with 13 doubles and 16 RBI over his last 28 games.

HOUSTON NOTES

- **Carlos Correa** snapped a seven-game hitting streak in which he was hitting .370 (10-for-27)...the first time he went hitless since 6/9/17 vs. LAA.
- With tonight's fifth inning home run, **Jake Marisnick** has hit home runs in back-to-back games for the second time this season (last occurrence was 5/25-5/26/17 vs. DET)...he has hit three home runs in his last four games.
- **Marisnick** has already surpassed his home run total from 2016 (five in 311 plate appearances) with nine in 108 plate appearances.
- Houston's starting pitcher **Brad Peacock** has allowed three earned runs or less in 15 of his last 18 starts in the Majors Leagues dating back to 2014.
- Since his Major League debut on Wednesday (6/14 vs. TEX), **Derek Fisher** has hit two home runs in four games (last was in his Major League debut game)...became the 6th player in club history to home run in his MLB debut.
- The Astros improved their record to 47-24, the club's best 71-game start in franchise history.
- With three home runs in last night's game against Boston, Houston has now hit three home runs in back-to-back games.
- Houston has now won seven straight games and 12 of their last 13 overall at the Oakland Coliseum.
- The Astros challenged a ruling on the field in the first inning...the ruling on the field was overturned...time of the review was 1:55... Houston is 8-for-18 in challenges.
