TODAY'S MEDIA AVAILABILITY

The Astros clubhouse will be open at 4:00 p.m... manager **AJ Hinch** will be available in the Astros dugout at approximately 4:50 p.m.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Tonight is the 2nd game of this 4-game set here at Ricky Henderson Field at the Oakland Coliseum...rookie **RHP Francis Martes (1-0)** will make his 2nd career start as he takes on A's RHP Sonny Gray (2-2).

MARVELOUS MARTES: RHP Francis Martes earned his 1st ML win in what was his 1st ML start on 6/14 vs. TEX in a 13-2 Astros victory (5 IP, 3 H, 1 ER, 2 BB, 7 SO).

ROSTER MOVES: Effective today, the Astros have reinstated **OF Josh Reddick** from the 7-day Concussion DL...Reddick had been on the DL since 6/13...following last night's game, **OF Derek Fisher** was optioned to Triple A Fresno.

ROAD WARRIORS: Tonight is the 2nd game of a 7-game road trip during which the Astros visit OAK (4g) and Seattle (3g, Fri-Sun), respectively...the Astros were 8-2 on their last road trip (5/29-6/8) and have a ML-best 24-8 (.750) record overall on the road in 2017.

AT THE COLISEUM: The Astros have won 7 straight games here at the Oakland Coliseum and 12 of their last 13 overall vs. the A's...**Role Reversal:** The A's won 15 of the 1st 16 matchups vs. the Astros when the two clubs first began play in 2002.

BEST RECORD IN BASEBALL: The Astros have the best record in baseball at 47-24 for a .662 winning pct... the Rockies (46-26) are second with a .639 winning pct.

BEST START EVER: At 47-24, the Astros are off to their best 71-game start in club history...previous record of 43-28 occurred in 1980, 1998 & 1999.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP: The Astros took Game #1 of the current series in OAK last night, 4-1...**RHP Brad Peacock** (4-1) earned the win (5.2 IP, 1 ER, 2 BB, 8 SO)...a 2-run HR by **Jake Marisnick** (#9) snapped a 0-0 tie in the 5th...**George Springer** (#20) and **Derek Fisher** (#2) also added homers...**RHP Ken Giles** retired the side in order in the 9th to earn his 17th save.

PEACOCKKKK: RHP Brad Peacock has been punching out batters at a remarkable rate in 2017...his 8 K's in last night's win increased his season total to 66 in just 44.2 IP...in his previous start on 6/13 vs. TEX, he tallied 10 K's in just 4.2 IP, becoming the 1st pitcher in club history to record 10 K's in an outing less than 5.0 IP...**his 13.30 SO/9IP ratio is tops in the Majors among hurlers with at least 40 IP this season.**

SPRINGER'S DINGERS: Last night, **George Springer** became the 1st Astros hitter to reach 20 HR prior to the A.S. Break since **Carlos Lee** (21) and **Lance Berkman** (22) in 2008...the franchise record for HR in a season prior to the break is 29 set by Berkman in 2002.

ALL-STAR UPDATES: In the updated All-Star fan voting results released today by MLB, **Jose Altuve** (1st), **Carlos Correa** (1st) and **George Springer** (3rd) all continue to hold starting positions...the Astros have not had three All-Star starters elected via the fan vote in a single All-Star Game...HOU did have 3 All-Star starters in 2004, all but one (**RHP Roger Clemens**) was elected via the fan vote...**OF Lance Berkman**, **2B Jeff Kent** were the other 2 starters in that '04 game which was played at Minute Maid Park.

STEERING THE SHIP: With a win Sat. night vs. BOS, Astros Manager **AJ Hinch** (217-177, .550) surpassed **Jimmy Williams** (215-197) for 9th place in franchise history in managerial wins...next on the list in eighth-place is **Terry Collins** (224-197), who managed the Astros from 1994-96.

YOUNGBLOODS: The Astros have used eight rookie pitchers this season, which ties as the 4th-highest total in the Major Leagues...Houston currently carries four rookie pitchers, two starters in **RHP David Pulino** and **RHP Francis Martes** and two relievers in **RHP James Hoyt** and **RHP Dayan Diaz**...**OF Derek Fisher** and **IF Yuli Gurriel** are also rookies.

SLUGGERS: As a club, the Astros lead the AL in slugging pct. (.476) and HR (112) and are T-1st in runs scored...the Astros 112 HR are the most in franchise history through 71 games.

LAST APP - 6/14 VS. TEX: made his first Major League start, in what was his second career appearance, last Wednesday opposite the Rangers...held Texas to 1 run on 3 hits, while fanning 7 and allowing 2 walks in the Astros 13-2 win.

- became the first Astro to strike out 7 batters in his first start in the Majors since **LHP Carlos Hernandez** did so on Aug. 18, 2001 vs. PIT...at 21 years, 202 days old, Martes became the youngest Astros pitcher to earn a win since **RHP Jordan Lyles** (20 years, 305 days old) on Aug. 20, 2011 vs. SF.
- this marked his first win of the 2017 season, including his 8 starts at the Triple A level...marked his first professional win since Aug. 26, 2016, while pitched for Double A Corpus Christi in a start vs. Midland.

ABOUT MARTES: Rookie right-hander is set to make his second career Major League start tonight...at 21 years, 209 days old, Martes is the youngest player in the AL, besting Rays **LHP Jose Alvarado** (22.031)...he's the third-youngest in the Majors, older than only two Padres players: **C Luis Torrens** (21.050) and **IF Allen Cordoba** (21.197).

- is rated by multiple outlets as Houston's top prospect, and one of the best prospects in baseball...per MLB.com, is the No. 15 overall prospect in the game (No. 3 right-handed pitcher)...in their May update, *Baseball America* rated Martes as the No. 17 prospect in baseball, and No. 2 pitcher behind only **RHP Alex Reyes** of St. Louis.

- was selected to the Major League roster on June 8...added to the Astros rotation after an injury to **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.**

AT TRIPLE A: made his Triple A debut this season, beginning the year at Triple A Fresno of the Pacific Coast League...went 0-2 with a 5.29 ERA (19ER/32.1IP), 28 walks and 38 strikeouts in 8 starts.

- began the season by tossing 9.1 scoreless innings...over his last 3 starts at the level, struck out 18 batters in 13.1 innings pitched.
- was the 2nd-youngest pitcher in the PCL (only Dodgers **LHP Julio Urias** was younger at 20 years old).

THIS SPRING: was a non-roster invitee at Astros Spring Training...appeared in 4 Major League games (1 start) and went 1-1 with a 3.86 ERA (3ER/7IP) and 6 strikeouts.

ABOUT LAST SEASON: spent the entire year with Double A Corpus Christi, posting a 9-6 record and a 3.30 ERA (46ER/125.1IP) in 25 games (22 starts)...struck out 131 with 47 walks, posting a .222 opponent average.

- was a Texas League All-Star, MiLB.com Organizational All-Star and Arizona Fall League All-Star...spent the season as the youngest pitcher in the Texas League.

QUICK RISER: pitched at 3 levels in Houston's system in 2015: Class A Quad Cities, Class A Advanced Lancaster, Double A Corpus Christi...this was after never pitching above the Rookie Level Gulf Coast League.

TRADE WINDS: was acquired by the Astros as part of a 2014 trade-deadline deal with the Marlins...was sent to Houston along with **OF Jake Marisnick**, **IF Colin Moran** and a Competitive Balance Round A pick (**OF Daz Cameron**) in exchange for **RHP Jarred Cosart**, **IF Kiké Hernandez** and **OF Austin Wates**.

- snapped his 9-game hitting streak at Oakland Coliseum last night...has gone hitless in 6 of 41 career games in Oakland...is a career .351 (61x174) hitter with 10 doubles, 2 HR, .850 OPS at Oakland Coliseum...leads MLB in road batting (.402, 47x117) after leading the Majors in batting on the road in 2016 (.372).
- last night also halted his 35-game streak of reaching base safely on the road.
- prior to last night, had recorded multiple hits in 4 straight games, his longest streak since a 5-game run in 2016...had also doubled in 4 straight games, which tied his career-long streak.
- tonight will be the 900th game of his career...set to become 20th position player to play in 900 games with the Astros...only 31 players in MLB history recorded more hits within their first 900 games than Altuve...1,133 hits are more than **Ted Williams** (1,117), **Albert Pujols** (1,114), **Lou Gehrig** (1,113) and **Pete Rose** (1,100) recorded within their first 900g in the Majors.
- ranks among the top AL players in hits (3rd, 87), average (3rd), OBP (3rd, .397), doubles (T-4th, 20), runs (6th, 46), steals (T-7th, 12) and OPS (8th, .925).
- ranks 10th on the club's all-time hits list (1,133)...trails **Bill Doran** by 6 hits for 9th place (1,139)...his 211 career steals rank 6th in club history, trailing **Terry Puhl** by 6 for 5th place (217)...ranks 14th in runs (495), 1 behind **Ken Caminiti** (496) for 13th...224 doubles rank 9th, 2 behind **Puhl** for 8th (226).
